## Heading to Jersey

The Fightin Phils begin a six-game series on the road at the Somerset Patriots tonight. The series begins with three games in Somerset, then it shifts to Reading from Thursday-Saturday. It's the seventh-of-18th matchups between the teams this season and first-of-nine in Somserset. After this week, Reading returns to Somerset from Aug. 27-Sept. 1. The Fightin Phils won their first matchups of the season 4-2 over Somerset from Apr. 23-28. Reading leads the season-series 4-2

Dropped the Series to Bowie
The Fightin Phils fell in both games on Sunday to the Bowie Baysox and ultimately fell in the series $4-2$. Reading dropped the resumptions of the suspended game 2-1, in 11 innings. Bowie took a 1-0 lead in the top of the sixth on a TT Bowens home run and Reading tied it up in the bottom of the sixth on a Trevor Schwecke RBI double. Bowie took the lead in the 10th and held Reading scoreless in the bottom of the frame. The Fightin Phils then fell 6-3 in the originally-scheduled Sunday game. Reading got home runs from Otto Kemp and Bryce Ball. Kemp hit a solo home run in the fourth inning, then Ball hit a two run shot in the bottom of the seventh. Efrain Contreras was strong out of the bullpen, going 3.2 innings, and allowing one run on two hits, with five strikeouts.

## Home Run Streak Snapped

After not homering in Saturday's game, the Fightin Phils snapped their season-best home run streak at 13 games in a row, lasting from June 13-28. The 13 games in a row with home runs matched Reading's most, dating back to the 2005 season. The only other time in that stretch that Reading homed for 13 games in a row was from June 21-July 3, of the 2016 season. The Fightin Phils ultimately homered in 21 of their last 23 games, dating back to June 4 . Reading now sits second in the Eastern League in home runs with 79 this season. Somerset is the only team ahead of Reading with 83 on the year. The Fighitn Phils also lead all of Double-A with 37 home runs hit during the month of June.

Into the Wishing Well
Lachlan Wells gets the start tonight for the Fightin Phils. Wells last pitched last Tuesday and went a season-high with seven innings pitched. He allowed three runs and struck out five, while earning his fifth win of the season. It was the first time Wells pitched at least seven innings in an affiliated game since going nine innings on May 17, 2017, with Fort Myers at Clearwater. Wells has now pitched at least six innings in his last four outings and five of his last six. Additionally, Wells hasn't issued a walk in four-straight outings and six of his last seven outings. Wells has not issued more than one walk in a game since his first start on Apr 10, against Portland. Wells owns the best strikeout-to-walk ratio in Double-A at 8.83 , which ranks 12th in all of Minor League Baseball.

## June Recap

The Fightin Phils ultimately finished the month of June with a 13-12 record, marking their first month an over . 500 record this season. It marks the first month that Reading has had a .500 or better record since going 13-12 in August of last season. The Fightin Phils hit .253 in June, which ranked fifth in the Eastern League. On the mound, Reading posted a 3.50 ERA, which was third in the league for the month.

## Wonderful Wilson

Ethan Wilson homered on Friday night for the second-straight game. Prior to his first home run of the season on Thursday night, Wilson had gone 53 -straight games without hitting a home run, with his last coming on Aug. 31, 2023, at home against New Hampshire.

Somerset enters tonight after finishing in fourth place in the Eastern League's Northeast Divison for the first half with a 32-37 record. They are first in the Northeast Division with a $5-1$ record in the second half of the season. Somerset most recently took five-of-six on the road at the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Following this week, Somerset remains on the road for a six-game series at Erie. Selvidge the Somerset Southpaw
Lefty, and Yankees' No. 10 Prospect, Brock Selvidge makes the start tonight for Somerset. This season, Selvidge is 7-5, with a 3.75 ERA over 14 starts ( 74.1 IP, 64 H, 36 BB, 72 SO). He earned a win in his last outing on June 26 at Richmond. Selvidge went six innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on seven hits, with two walks and a pair of strikeouts. He earned the win on Apr. 27 at Reading, going seven-shutout innings, while allowing two hits and striking out a season-high 11 hitters. Selvidge split 2023 between between Single-A Tampa and High-A Hudson Valley and combined to go 8-5, with 3.45 ERA over 24 appearances and 23 starts. The Yankees selected the 21-year old out of Hamilton High School in Chandler, Arizona, in the third round of the 2021 draft.
