EARLY IN THE WEEK? EARLY WINS: With a win on Thursday night, the Biloxi Shuckers have won the first two games in each of their past four series, dating back to June 11-12 against the Mississippi Braves... This week, the Shuckers have outscored the M-Braves 16-9, including 11 unanswered runs between the sixth inning on Wednesday and the third inning on Thursday... The Shuckers are also 10-28 (.357) with runners in scoring position this week, tied for the fourth-most hits in the situation in Double-A.

THAT TASTES LIKE PROMOTION: RHP Justin Jarvis was promoted to Triple-A Nashville earlier today, becoming the sixth Shuckers player to be promoted to Triple-A in 2023... Over 14 starts in 2023, Jarvis currently ranks second in the Southern League with 92 strikeouts, tied for second with six wins and ranks fourth with a 3.33 ERA... In 18 Double-A starts, Jarvis owns a 3.20 ERA.

MORE FOR THE CLUB: After eighth strikeouts on Thursday, RHP Justin Jarvis joined teammate RHP Carlos Rodriguez and Reds prospect RHP Connor Phillips as the only three Southern League pitchers to reach 90 strikeouts in 2023... Jarvis currently ranks second in the Southern League with 92 strikeouts.

RUNNING PAST 40: INF Tyler Black became the second player in Shuckers' franchise history (since 2015) to tally 40 stolen bases in a season, doing so on Sunday... Black enters today 13 away from breaking BLX SINGLE-SEASON SB LEADERS OF Johnny Davis' record of 52, set during the 2017 season in 133 games... He enters 1 Johnny Davis 52 SB 133 GP (2017) today with the most out of any player in Double-A, and the fifth-most in Minor League 2. Tyler Black, 40 SB, 60 GP (2023) Baseball... Black's 16 stolen bases in June are the fourth-most out of any player in MLB

THE FUTURE IS NOW: On Monday night, C Jeferson Quero and INF Jackson Chourio were both selected to the 2023 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, set to be held in Seattle, Washington on Saturday, July 8... The pair are the ninth and 10th Shuckers players selected for the event... The pair also continues a streak that's seen a Shuckers player selected in every year of the franchise's history (since 2018).

IN A LEAGUE OF HIS OWN: With a two-run home run and a stolen base on Friday night, OF Jackson Chourio became the third teenager since 2005 to reach 20 stolen bases and 10 home runs in a single-season in the high minors and the first since OF Ronald Acuna Jr. did so in 2017... OF Delmon Young with the Montgomery Biscuits is the only other player to achieve the feat since 2005, doing so during the '05 season.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP JAMES MEEKER (3-2, 2.41): RHP James Meeker makes his second start of the season, and his fourth career start... In his only start of the year, Meeker tossed three scoreless innings against the Chattanooga Lookouts on June 23 at MGM Park... Meeker's 2.7% walk rate this year is the lowest in Minor League Baseball (min. 30.0 IP)
