#### RIDERS, HATCHER DROP NATURALS TO WIN FOURTH-STRAIGHT GAME:

The Frisco RoughRiders took their fourth-straight game over the Northwest Arkansas Naturals, winning 7-1 on Saturday night from Arvest Ballpark. For the second night in a row, the RoughRiders (6-2) showed off offensively in the first inning. **Alejandro Osuna** tripled to start the game off of Naturals (4-4) starter Ben Kudra (0-1) before **Cam Cauley** plated him with an RBI single to make it 1-0. The same thing happened in the third with Cauley tripling and **Luis Mieses** singling him home to make it 2-0. The Naturals put up their lone run in the fourth when Peyton Wilson doubled to score Brett Squires against **Trey Supak** (1-0). Supak was superb, allowing just one run over five innings on four hits while striking out five and walking one. **Tucker Mitchell** then blasted his first home run of the season, a two-run shot in the sixth to push the lead to 4-1. In the seventh, **Josh Hatcher** lifted the first pitch he saw for a solo homer, his third of the series and the season, to increase the advantage to 5-1. **Hatcher** collected four more hits on Saturday, giving him 18 through his first seven games (see below). **Frainyer Chavez** capped the Frisco scoring in the eighth with a two-run single, scoring Mieses and Hatcher and finalizing the score at 7-1. **Peyton Gray** and **Robby Ahlstrom** both fired two scoreless innings apiece out of the Frisco bullpen.

#### **HATCHIN' HITTIN':**

Josh Hatcher was incredible for the RoughRiders in 2024 and he has picked up right where he left off in 2025. Hatcher hit .300/.350/.448/.798 over 107 games with Frisco last season. He was one of just three qualified hitters in all of Double-A baseball to hit .300 or better. To start 2025, he has hit safely in all seven games he's played in, batting .529 (18-for-34)/.529/.853/1.382 with two doubles, three home runs, nine RBIs, a stolen base and eight runs scored over his first seven games. His 18 hits are the most among Double-A, High-A and Low-A players and tied for eighth in all of MiLB. His .529 batting average leads all of Minor League Baseball. Hatcher already has six multi-hit games and is 6-for-6 when putting the first pitch of an at-bat in play with two home runs. Hatcher's 18 hits are the most by a Texas Leaguer through the first eight team games since five-year Major Leaguer Jesus Guzman had 19 with Midland in 2008.

#### THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

The Frisco bullpen has been a bright spot for the Riders in the beginning of the season. While the pitching staff has had a 3.55 ERA overall (4th-best in the Texas League), the bullpen pitchers have been even better. If you remove **Ben Anderson**'s long relief as a normal starting pitcher on Opening Night, Frisco's bullpen pitchers have combined to allow just five earned runs over 33.0 innings (1.36 ERA). The bullpen overall has a 2.15 ERA overall, which is still 4th in the Texas League, but their 1.36 ERA would be first in the circuit.

#### **POWER BRINGS WINS:**

The RoughRiders have shown off their punch to begin the season and have been amazing on offense during their four-game winning streak. Frisco's 10 home runs through eight games are first in the Texas League, while they are also first in BA (.299), OBP (.398), SLG (.465) and OPS (.863). **Josh Hatcher** is second in the league with three home runs. Over this four-game winning streak, the Riders are hitting .346/.443/.560/1.003 as a team while scoring 39 runs on 55 hits. During this streak, they are second in MiLB in runs and hits.

#### **VERSUS THE NATURALS**:

A season ago, the RoughRiders went 7-5 against Northwest Arkansas. **Maximo Acosta** dominated on the offensive side (.421/.532/.658/1.190 over 10G), but **Abimelec Ortiz** and **Josh Hatcher** were the two best returners against the Naturals. Ortiz hit three home runs in 11 games while slashing .341/.449/.610/1.059 while Hatcher collected 17 hits in 10 games, including a five-hit game, to hit .405 with a 1.039 OPS against the Royals affiliate. Including this season, Hatcher is now hitting .413 (33-for-80)/.453/.638/1.091 in his career against the Naturals across 18 games with four home runs and 17 RBIs.

#### ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz ended the year on fire for the RoughRiders. In his last 48 games, Ortiz hit .321/.413/.592/1.005 with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 38 RBIs, 37 runs scored and 28 walks. After July 10th, in those 48 games, he is fourth in average (.321), first in OPS (1.005), tied for first in RBIs (38) and first in home runs (13). During that span, he paced all of Double-A in OPS as well. In his last 29 games, he batted .364 (40-for-110)/.470/.710/1.170 with five doubles, 10 home runs, 30 RBIs, 21 walks, 24 strikeouts and 27 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. After, he hit: 307 with a .954 OPS, raising his batting average to .243 and a .760 OPS. Ortiz is hitting .233 (7-for-30)/.324/.300/.624 through the first seven games of the season in 2025.

#### WE'RE GOING PROSPECTING:

The RoughRiders have nine players in MLB Pipeline's Rangers Top 30 Prospects rankings to start 2025. **Sebastian Walcott** (No. 1) headlines the bunch and is the only member of the top 100 as well (No. 17). On the mound, **Winston Santos** (No. 5), **Kohl Drake** (No. 13), **Mitch Bratt** (No. 21) and **Josh Stephan** (No. 22) all slot into the starting rotation while **Skyler Hales** (No. 25) will work from the bullpen. On offense, outfielder **Alejandro Osuna** (No. 8) and first baseman/outfielder **Abimelec Ortiz** (No. 14) round out the nine players.
