**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels shut out the SeaWolves, 5-0, to open the series. **Hayden Birdsong** pitched a career-high six innings and struck out six batters with no walks. **Nick Swiney** threw two hitless innings and **Tyler Myrick** worked a 1-2-3 ninth inning to end the game. **Jairo Pomares** opened the scoring with a two-run double in the fourth inning and **Vaun Brown** added a sac fly later in the inning to open a 3-0 lead. In the fifth, **Victor Bericoto** hit a solo homer, his fourth of the season, to extend the Flying Squirrels' lead to 4-0. In the bottom of the seventh, **Andy Thomas** hit an RBI single to open a 5-0 lead.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, in the second of a sixgame series at The Diamond. The week marks Erie's only visit to Richmond this season. The Flying Squirrels were swept in six games at UPMC Park from May 7-12. Richmond returns to Erie for a six-game series from August 27-September 1.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 11-2 in their last 13 games after going 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on the last road trip to Akron and Erie. They have won five-of-six in each of their last two series, including at home against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie last week.

**THE SEAWOLVES** are in third place in the Southwest Division, two games behind first-place Akron. Erie has dropped five-of-its-last-six games dating back to last Wednesday. This season, Erie has the second-lowest team ERA (3.14) in the Eastern League. Erie's roster includes three of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Troy Melton (No. 10), INF Hao-Yu Lee (No. 13) and OF/INF Trei Cruz (No. 29). Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes two Erie players, including Melton (No. 10) and Lee (No. 12).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his ninth start of the season and his second against the Sea-Wolves. Last time out, Bertrand threw six hitless innings last Thursday at Bowie, his second hitless start against the Baysox this year. On Monday, Bertrand was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for the second time this season. He last faced the SeaWolves on May 10 at UPMC Park and allowed a season-high five runs over 4.2 innings. In the Eastern League, Bertrand ranks tied for first in groundball percentage (55.6%), fourth in WHIP (1.04), fifth in ERA (2.25), tied for fifth in innings pitched (48.0), sixth in BB/9 (2.25) and seventh in HR/9 (0.38). Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two. more on Bertrand, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Troy Melton makes his ninth start of the season. He last pitched on Thursday against the Curve and allowed a season-high six runs (four earned) over 11 innings in a loss. After going 1-2 with a 2.88 ERA in his first six starts of the season, Melton is 0-2 with a 12.00 ERA (8 ER/6.0 IP) in his last two starts since May 17. He faced the Flying Squirrels on May 10 at UPMC Park and threw five scoreless innings in a win. He split last year between Low-A Lakeland and High-A West Michigan, going 3-1 with a 2.74 ERA in 23 outings (22 starts). Following the season, he was named a Midwest League Post-Season All-Star. Melton was selected by the Tigers in the fourth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of San Diego State.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked third among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: Over the last 13 games since May 14, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .261 (109-for-418), second-best in the league, and have scored 81 runs, an average of 6.2 runs per game. Over the previous 13 games from April 28-May 12, the Richmond offense hit a league-worst .171 (69-for-407) and averaged 1.7 runs per game (22 runs/13 games). In winning 11-of-their-last-13, the Flying Squirrels have outscored Reading and Bowie, 81-41.

SETTING THE TABLE: Carter Howell is batting .296 (21-for-67) over his last 19 games since May 3 with three doubles, a homer, six RBIs, 12 walks and 10 runs scored. On May 16 in the second game of a doubleheader against the Fightin Phils, he hit a goahead, two-run homer in the fifth inning in a 3-1 win. In his 14 games batting first in the lineup, Howell is batting .291 (16-for-55) with two doubles and nine walks. When leading off an inning, Howell is batting a team-best .389 (14-for-36). On Friday, Howell second a carror high four rule. scored a career-high four runs.

GRANTING WISHES: In his last 13 games since May 15, Grant McCray is batting .475 (19-for-40) with two homers, six doubles, three triples, eight walks, nine RBIs and 15 runs scored, raising his season batting average from .135 to .229. He picked up a season-high three hits last Tuesday night at Bowie and matched it last Friday night. For the season, McCray is batting .135 (14-for-104) when batting first in the lineup compared to .475 (19-for-40) when batting third, fifth or sixth in the order. McCray is tied for first in the Eastern League in triples (3), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (20) and tied for seventh in doubles (11). On Monday, he was named Eastern League Player of the Week after he hit .550 (11-for-20) with a homer, three doubles, two triples, four walks, eight runs scored and five RBIs for the series in Bowie.

AWARDS SEASON: Along with Grant McCray being named Eastern League Player of the Week, John Michael Bertrand was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday. He pitched six hitless innings on Thursday night at Bowie. He also threw seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and has combined for 13 hitless innings when facing Bowie this season. Bertrand became the second pitcher in team history to win two Pitcher of the Week awards in the same season, joining Eric Surkamp (2011). Along with Surkamp, Bertrand is the fourth pitcher in team history to win the Pitcher of the Week award multiple times, joining Matt Frisbee and Matt Gage. Last week marked the fourth time the Flying Squirrels have swept the league's weekly player and pitcher awards, joining Daniel Mayora and Justin Fitzgerald (July 9-16, 2012), Steven Duggar and Andrew Suarez (July 18-24, 2016) and Brett Auerbach and Wil Jensen (August 1-7, 2022).

**THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:** Andy Thomas is batting .317 (13-for-41) over his last 11 games since May 15 with a homer, three doubles and 12 RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .233. Thomas has picked up two hits in four-of-his-last-nine games played dating back to May 16 and has picked up three doubles in that same stretch. On Friday, he clubbed his first homer of the year, a grand slam, and finished the game with six RBIs, tying his career high.

Last Tuesday, he went 1-for-4 with a two-run homer. He followed with a 2-for-5 performance last Wednesday and added a solo home run. Last Thursday night, Wilson went 0-for-1 but walked three times. He picked up three hits and a walk last Friday night. In his last six games, Wilson is hitting .364 (8-for-22). Wilson is now ranked seventh in Flying Squirrels franchise history with 26 career homes. with 26 career homers.

PROSPECT WATCH: Seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25), Ryan Murphy (No. 28) and José Cruz (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), Victor Bericoto (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

# THIS DATE IN SQUIRRELS HISTORY

In 2022, the Flying Squirrels beat the Hartford Yard Goats, 22-9, setting the franchise record for runs, hits (24) and RBIs (22) in a game. Richmond hit seven homers, which was then a team single-game record. Tyler Fitzgerald and Jacob Heyward each had five hits, tying the franchise single-game record. Fitzgerald also set the team single-game record for total bases (13) and runs scored (5). Fitzgerald and Sean Roby both homered twice.

"It's awesome to see it come together. We've worked hard. We grinded through that two-week road trip that felt like it was a month-and-a-half long. We got back home and we got to work and I think that work is starting to show. ... I think this offense is special. It's not just one person doing it all. It's one through nine. Then you've got guys who can come in late in the game, pinch hit and get a big hit for us. I think it's awesome when you don't have to feel the pressure on yourself if somebody's raking really well.
