NEWS AND NOTES

PANNONE BUMP DAY: Southpaw Thomas Pannone will make his 13th appearance and 12th start of the season on Tuesday night against the Jumbo Shrimp. Pannone faced Jacksonville during Nashville's road series there on June 5, tossing 5.2 scoreless innings with three strikeouts and four hits allowed.

BACK LIKE HE NAVA LEFT: Andrick Nava made his return to the Nashville lineup for the first time since April 16. The 24-year-old homered in his first at-bat to get the Sounds on the scoreboard in the bottom of the second of Sunday's resumed game from Saturday, June 27. The 424-foot, three-run blast was his first career Triple-A home run and jumped to the fourth farthest homer hit for a Nashville player this season. He added a single in the bottom of the sixth to earn his first Triple-A multi-hit game to go along with a multi-RBI performance. He has reached base in all 13 games he has played in this season with High-A Wisconsin (10 G) and all three appearances with the Sounds.

YO BRO: Brewers no. 26-rated prospect Craig Yoho made his first appearance with the Sounds since June 10 on the road in Durham and extended his streak without an earned run with the Sounds to 15 straight games dating back to April 29, and 19.2 IP overall since he allowed back-to-back home runs on April 25 in Charlotte. Yoho tossed two scoreless and hitless innings with a strikeout. In 75 career appearances

with Nashville, Yoho owns a sparkling 0.96 ERA across 84.0 IP with 107 strikeouts and 34 walks. For his professional career, Yoho owns a 1.11 ERA in 112 appearances; his ERA is the second-best among any minor league pitcher with at least 35 games since 2005. Michael Mediavilla owned a 0.72 ERA across 38 appearances in the lower level of the Brewers farm system from 2018-19 and is the only pitcher with a lower ERA than Yoho that meets the criteria.

HENDO: Right-hander Logan Henderson made his return to the mound for Nashville on Sunday night. Henderson last appeared in a game on May 22 when he tossed five scoreless innings against the Dodgers to earn his fifth career Major League win. He was added to the Injured List with a lower back strain the next day. In his first rehab appearance, he allowed one hit across three scoreless pitching to two batters in the top of the fourth. His lone hit allowed came via a leadoff single before issuing a walk to end his night. Henderson struck out seven straight batters in his start to get his third straight start of 7+ strikeouts dating back to May 16 on the road against the Minnesota Twins. Henderson made five appearances (3 GS) with Nashville between March 31-April 26, going 2-0 with a 1.02 ERA. After his three scoreless on Sunday, he owns a 0.87 ERA across 20.2 IP (2 ER) with 33 strikeouts. The Sounds are now 4-0 in his starts this season and 15-4 when he takes the ball since the start of last season.

BLACK JACK: Tyler Black ended his series hitting .263 (5-for-19) with two homers, a triple, 10 RBI, three walks, and six runs scored. His second home run of the week was a solo shot to right field in the bottom of the fifth in game two Sunday night. He entered the series with just three multi-RBI games in his first 38 games played this season with Nashville and tied his career-high with five RBI on game one of the series and capped his week with another four-RBI game on Sunday night. He doubled his season home run total last week as well, entering the week with two on the season and has now homered in three of his last eight games.

HOMER HAPPY: Nashville is up to 34 home runs in the month of June through 24 games. The 34 home runs are tied for the 14th-most the Sounds have hit in any single month since 2005 and the most since hitting 42 in June of 2023. For June, the Sounds are tied for the fourth-most HR hit in the International League with one game remaining this month. St. Paul leads the league with 43 home runs hit in June with one fewer game. Luke Adams is tied for the second-most home runs in the International League this month behind Joshua Baez (MEM) and Matt Wallner (STP) who each have 10. Adams also ranks second in the Brewers farm system behind Andrew Fischer (9) for the month. Akil Baddoo (5), Brock Wilken (4) and Jett Williams (4) follow Adams on Nashville's home run leaderboard for the month.
