### RIDERS BLANKED IN GAME TWO:

The Frisco RoughRiders were shut out for just the second time on the season in a 7-0 loss to the Midland RockHounds on Wednesday night from Momentum Bank Ballpark. Frisco (12-11) was held to just two hits on the offensive side. **Luisangel Acuña** lined a single in the third and **Scott Kapers** added a double in the eighth, but they could not push a run across. The RockHounds (12-11) scored two in the first, one in the second and four in the fifth for their seven runs with six of them coming against Frisco starter **Tekoah Roby** (1-3). Roby allowed the six runs on eight hits over his 4.1 innings. **Nick Starr** ceded a run over his 1.2 innings in relief. Ryan Cusick (1-1) earned the win for Midland in his start, shutting out the Riders over 6.1 innings. In his 2023 Frisco debut, **Juan Mejia** threw two scoreless innings out of the bullpen. Mejia pitched in one game for the Riders in 2021.

### MAKE THOSE HITS COUNT:

The RoughRiders have shown up where it counts with runners in scoring position this season. In those situations, they are hitting .259/.363/.429/.792 with a league-best in both home runs (nine) and RBIs (108). This compares to a regular slashline of .247/.362/.402/.764. **Evan Carter** is seventh in all of MiLB (min. 25 PA) with a .478 average with runners in scoring position this season.

### ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .320 (32-for-100)/.367/.440/.807 through the first 22 games while ranking second in the Texas League in hits (33), tied for eighth in doubles (7) and ninth in total bases (45) and second in stolen bases (13). Over his last 19 games, he is batting .353/.411/.494/.905. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (116).

### LOAD UM UP:

The RoughRiders have had a league-high 32 RBIs with the bases loaded this year, which is also second most in Double-A (Biloxi, 34). As a team, they are hitting .385 (10-for-26)/.375/1.000/1.375 with four grand slams and 32 RBIs. They are one of two teams in Minor League Baseball with four grand slams this season already (Triple-A Norfolk) as **Trevor Hauver** hit one on Opening Day, **Dustin Harris** added another in San Antonio, **Luisangel Acuña** blasted one against Arkansas and **Jax Biggers** slugged one in Amarillo. The Riders have had one grand slam in each of the four series they have played this season.

### DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The RoughRiders have just committed nine errors through 23 games. The team's .989 fielding percentage is the best in Minor League Baseball. Their nine errors are the fewest in the minors.

### WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 135 walks lead all non-Triple-A teams while their .362 team OBP is first in Double-A. **Evan Carter** has the Double-A lead with 23 walks and **Dustin Harris** is fourth with 20 (second in the Texas League) while Carter is first in OBP (.471) in the league and in Double-A.

### I LIKE BIG WINS AND I CANNOT LIE:

The RoughRiders 12 wins this season have come by eight, six, seven, seven, 10, four runs, eight runs, three runs, four runs, six runs, five runs and nine runs, respectively, while their 11 losses have come by a combined 39 runs. That gives Frisco a +38 run differential through 23 games, which is second in the Texas League despite being 12-11 in the South Division. The only team with a +20 run differential in the league is Tulsa, which is 14-9 (+39). The RoughRiders have scored at least six runs 12 times (11-2) and scored four or fewer runs eight times (0-9). Frisco's pythagorean record (what their record projects as based on run differential) is 15-8, which would be tied for the best record in the league with Arkansas.

### EVAN ALMIGHTY:

Outfielder **Evan Carter** has reached safely in 18 of his 20 games this season, batting .308 (24-for-78)/.471/.487/.958 with two doubles, four home runs, 23 walks, 20 RBIs and three stolen bases. Carter is first in the Texas League in OBP (.471), tied for fourth in RBIs (20), first in walks (23) and 10th in OPS (.958). The No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system won a MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove in 2022. The reigning Tom Greive Rangers Minor League Player of the Year, Carter joined the RoughRiders for the last week of the 2022 season and the playoffs. Carter also opened the season as the second-youngest player in the Texas League this season, trailing on 19-year-old Deyvison De Los Santos of Amarillo. Since going 0-for-4 for the first time this season on Saturday in San Antonio, Carter has walked 18 times to seven strikeouts over 12 games with a .484 OBP.

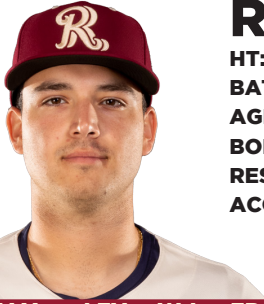

### ABOUT RYAN

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

### 2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

### 2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

### 2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

### 2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
