Today: In their 27th season in the Midwest League, the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, open their final regular season homestand with the first of a six-game series against the West Michigan Whitecaps, High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The Lugnuts are 6-9 against the Whitecaps this season, splitting a six-game series at home in April. Tonight is also Tacos and Tallboys Night, featuring \$4 tacos and \$4 cervezas.

Last Game, Sunday: Lugnuts 4, Dragons 0. The Nuts won their fourth straight game at Day Air Ballpark, winning their second consecutive series, behind a combined seven-hit shutout from Mitch Myers and a trio of relievers, a two-run first-inning double from Colby Thomas and a pair of RBI singles in the sixth inning from Brennan Milone and Daniel Susac.

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Voice of the CMU Chippewas Adam Jaksa call the action on Bally Live and MiLB.TV, with an audio-only call available via StreamGuys. Adam is 100% certain that Central Michigan is going to win at Spartan Stadium on Friday.

Off the Field: Tomorrow is White Claws and Paws, with dogs welcome to the park and specials on White Claws; Thursday is the final Coors Light Thirsty Thursday, featuring \$2 domestic drafts and \$5 craft drafts; Friday is the final Copa night of the year, with the Lansing Locos in action; Saturday is Fan Appreciation Night; and Sunday is Accessibility Day.

Congratulations: Yesterday, 23-year-old right-hander Gunnar Hoglund was named the Midwest League's Pitcher of the Week, honoring his remarkable High-A debut on Saturday night in Dayton: 64 pitches: 5 innings, 0 hits, 0 runs, 0 walks, 7 strikeouts, 1 HBP. In that game, the Lugnuts brought a no-hitter one out into the bottom of the eighth before settling for a 3-2 victory. Hoglund joins Blake Beers (Pitcher of the Week, May 9-14) and Danny Bautista, Jr. (Player of the Week, July 25-30) as Lugnuts to receive weekly awards this year.

Congratulations, Part II: Last night, Drew Millas pinch-hit unsuccessfully in the ninth for the Washington Nationals in a 6-3 loss at the Toronto Blue Jays, thus becoming the 182nd former Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues and the ninth this season alone. (See "Big League Nuts" below.)

First Blood: In their six-game series against Great Lakes, the Loons scored the first run in every game – but the Lugnuts won four of six. In their six-game series at Dayton, the Lugnuts scored the first two runs in every game, the Nuts again won four of six.

Dragon Slayers: How did the Lugnuts beat the Dragons? Outstanding pitching. The Lugnuts' six starters, Jose Dicochea (5 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 2 K), Jacob Watters (4 IP, 2 H, 4 R, 8 K), James González (5 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 7 K), Jake Garland (6 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 4 K), Gunnar Hoglund (5 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 7 K) and Mitch Myers (5 IP, 6 H, 0 R, 7 K), combined to allow 17 hits and 7 runs while striking out 35 batters in 30 innings.

Turnaround: CF Junior Pérez opened the year batting .082 (5-for-60) in his first 20 games, including a streak of 32 consecutive hitless at-bats. Since then, he is hitting .272 (88-for-323). His slash line by month: April - .089/.192/.089, .281 OPS; May - .238/.295/.438, .733 OPS; June - .256/.326/.372, .698 OPS; July - .262/.361/.393, .754 OPS; August - .292/.387/.542 .929 OPS. Junior has reached base 54 times in the last 28 games, thanks to 35 hits and 19 walks.

Roll Call: The Lugnuts have used 25 position players this year and 25 pitchers (not including Danny Bautista, Jr., who tossed one inning as a position-player-pitching). 16 players have hit at least one home run, 16 players have stolen at least one base, 14 pitchers have made at least one start, 19 pitchers have won at least one game, and 13 pitchers have recorded at least one save.

Jerome Holtzman, Represent: The Lugnuts have been playing closer and closer games as the season has gone on. By month: seven saves in 20 games in April (35%), nine in 27 games in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), and 19 in 24 games played in August (79%).

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster has three current first-rounders: the A's last two first-round selections in catcher Daniel Susac, taken 19th overall out of Arizona last year, and shortstop Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall pick this year from Grand Canyon University, plus the Blue Jays' 2021 first-round selection, Gunnar Hoglund, acquired via trade for Matt Chapman. The A's 2021 first-round selection, shortstop Max Muncy, opened the year on the Lugnuts' roster and is now with Double-A Midland.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2016: 1st-rounder T.J. Zeuch (the 21st overall pick in the June draft) arrived with the Lugnuts from Vancouver, and the Lugnuts supported him with a ten-run 3rd inning (the first 10-run inning since June 15, 2008) on their way to a 12-6 win at Lake County. Zeuch struck out seven in three innings, allowing seven singles and leaving with the bases loaded in the fourth. All three runners scored against future Major Leaguer Daniel Young, charging Zeuch with five runs. The Lugnuts also had their defensive play of the year, a behind-the-back glove flip from shortstop Ryan Metzler that started a 6-4-3 double play in the seventh.

2018: The Lugnuts drew 4,182 on a Wednesday night to Cooley Law School Stadium, surpassing the 300,000 attendance mark for the 23rd consecutive season. Ryan Noda's first-inning RBI triple and fourth-inning home run gave the Nuts all that they would need in a 2-1 victory over the Great Lakes Loons. It was Noda's 19th home run of the year.

2019: It was beat-the-rain with the Lugnuts, in a two-hour, 24-minute 7-3 victory over West Michigan before a massive storm showed up at Cooley Law School Stadium. Fitz Stadler gave up one run in six innings and LJ Talley, Johnny Aiello, Rafael Lantigua and Griffin Conine all homered off Whitecaps starter Chance Kirby in the win.

 Home Cooking: Also from Tucson: Alex Verdugo, four-time All-Star Ian Kinsler, two-time All-Star J.J. Hardy, Cardinals All-Star catcher Tom Pagnozzi and Ron Hassey... in all, Tucson ranks second behind Phoenix in producing Major Leaguers from the Grand Canyon State.

Glory Days: Boasting a 96 mph fastball, Dicochea was highly regarded coming out of Sahuarita High School, ranked the No. 1 prep prospect in Arizona by Baseball America entering the 2019 draft... twirled a no-hitter in the state semifinals... signed for \$400,000... signing scout: Scott Cousins... signed away from commitment to University of Arizona... senior year stats: 1.30 ERA, 54 IP, 24 H, 10 ER, 11 BB, 86 K... in addition to pitching, also starred at shortstop.

Minor League Path: Dicochea opened his professional career in the 2019 Arizona League after signing, but his 2021 campaign was halted in Single-A Stockton due to injury on June 6 after only six appearances, five starts... returned from Tommy John surgery on August 12, 2022, and made two appearances in the Arizona Complex League before returning to Stockton on August 26, 2022... finished the year with three appearances for the Ports.

Bagels in April: Opened 2023 as the Ports' No. 4 starter, firing four scoreless innings at Fresno on April 11... that was the start of three consecutive scoreless outings to begin the year, finishing April with 13 2/3 scoreless innings... didn't allow first run until May 3 vs. Fresno, entering in relief in the fifth inning and allowing two runs in the fifth and two more in the seventh in a 5-4 Ports win... in total with Stockton, posted a 2.42 ERA with a .132 average against in five road starts (22 1/3 IP) compared to 4.24 ERA, .200 avg. in four home appearances (17 IP)... lefties hit .111/.243/.175 compared to righties' .205/.279/.308... base stealers went 2-for-2.

Rave Reviews: Dicochea was promoted from Single-A Stockton to Lansing on June 13 to replace Jack Perkins, who was transferred up to Double-A Midland... coincidentally, an article about Dicochea had just been written by MLB.com A's beat writer Martín Gallegos a day earlier, quoting A's GM David Forst in including Dicochea's name among the top pitching prospects in the system (Royber Salinas, Gunnar Hoglund, J.T. Ginn and Joey Estes). Wrote Gallegos about Dicochea, "Dicochea, an eighth-round selection by the A's in the 2019 MLB Draft out of Sahuarita (Ariz.) High School, ranks just outside Oakland's Top 30 Prospects list. But his inclusion in that group from Forst speaks volumes about how highly he is viewed. In nine games (seven starts) for Single-A Stockton this season, Dicochea holds a 3.20 ERA with 47 strikeouts against 17 walks in 39 1/3 innings. He has held opposing batters to a .163 average, which ranks lowest among all California League pitchers with at least 30 innings pitched. Dicochea's development hit a snag early in his pro career after he underwent Tommy John surgery in 2021. Since his return from injury, the 22-year-old right-hander is taking a big step forward this season, showing off a fastball that consistently hits 95 mph along with a solid slider and a changeup he's recently added to his mix. A's assistant general manager and director of player personnel Billy Owens added, "He's off to a promising start. Averaging well over a strikeout per inning. Overall, his command has taken a step forward. He's definitely an interesting arm on the horizon."

Life in Lansing: This is Dicochea's third start on Tuesday; he has made one start on Wednesday, three starts on Thursday, three starts on Friday, one start on Saturday and one relief appearance on Sunday.
