The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the Springfield Cardinals 12-8 on Sunday evening from Riders Field. Springfield (28-17, 65-49) started the scoring in the top of the first inning against **Emiliano Teodo**, using back-to-back doubles from Bryan Torres and Nathan Church Frisco (24-21, 68-46) evened the score in the bottom of the first when **Abimelec Orti**z singled home **Alejandro Osuna**, tying the game at 1-1. In the bottom of the second, **Aaron Zavala** and **Keyber Rodriguez** each singled before scoring on a two-run double by **Cooper Johnson** that made it a 3-1 advantage for Frisco. After allowing a run in the first, Teodo did not allow another hit. The righty finished after 4.0 innings of one-run ball, surrendering just two hits and four walks while striking out five. Springfield erupted in the top of the fifth inning against a rehabbing **Jacob Latz**. The lefty induced a flyout before allowing five straight batters to reach before **Skylar Hales** took over on the mound. Latz finished after recording one out and was charged with five runs. The Cardinals manufactured six runs on seven consecutive hits after sending 11 to the plate, taking a 7-3 lead. The Riders added a pair of runs in the bottom of the sixth on a two-run single by Zavala, plating **Maximo Acosta** and to bring the Frisco deficit to 7-5. Acosta belted a two-run, game-tying homer to left in the bottom of the seventh against Leonardo Taveras. Nick Krauth, who had tossed three scoreless frames, stayed on the hill for the top of the ninth. A leadoff walk and back-to-back singles with the latter being from Torres gave Springfield an 8-7 lead and chased Krauth from the game. **Damian Mendoza** allowed a three-run double to Jimmy Crooks. Crooks later scored on a wild pitch to make it a 12-7 game. In the bottom of the ninth inning, Tucker Mitchell scored from second on an RBI single by Ortiz, but the Riders' threat fell short as Springfield took the series finale 12-8. Offensively, the Riders were paced by a three-hit night from Ortiz as Osuna, Acosta and Zavala each tallied two hits.

PLEASE DON'T HIT ME ONE MORE TIME:

The Riders pitching staff has been a strenghth this season, but the Cardinals dominated last series on the offensive side. Last week, Springfield hit .350 (82-for-234)/.402/.482/.885 with 17 doubles, four home runs and averaging 7.3 runs per game on the offensive side, taking five of six games. Frisco's bullpen had a 9.93 ERA and has allowed 47 hits over 25.1 innings this series while blowing leads in four of their five losses. The Riders have lost back-to-back series for the first time all season now and are 3-9 in their last 12 games.

On Friday, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with Luis Mieses capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. The RoughRiders hit seven home runs in the last three games, with those seven home runs being tied for the third-most in the Texas League this week (Northwest Arkansas led with 10). Frisco is still just seventh in the Texas League in home runs this season with 81 across their 114 games (on pace for 98, which would be tied for the fourth-fewest in the 21 seasons of the franchise).

Over the last 24 games, the Riders are fourth in the Texas League with a .723 OPS, third with a .261 batting average and are sixth with 4.3 runs per game. Holding them back, Frisco is just batting just .199 (43-for-216) with runners in scoring position over their last 24

RoughRiders starting pitcher Kumar Rocker has been fantastic in his four starts with the RoughRiders since returning from his "Tommy John" surgery rehab this season. In the four starts, he has pitched 15.0 innings, allowing just one run on six hits and two walks with 21 strikeouts. Additionally, he has been incredibly efficient, averaging just 12.2 pitches per inning with the Riders. Rocker, who was selected by the Rangers as the No. 3 overall pick in the 2022 draft, is the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers organization and the No. 1 pitching prospect.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 36-20 at Riders Field this season. The Riders lost three home games in a row this series for the first time since September 7-9, 2023. At home this season, Frisco has a +63 run differential, a 4.08 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .759 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 32-26 with a 3.22 ERA, but a +21 run differential while averaging 3.9 runs per game and owning a .638 OPS (10th in the league). Cody Freeman has nine of his 13 home runs at home while Abimelec Ortiz has hit eight of his nine homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is batting .310/.396/.520/.916 at home as opposed to .138/.202/.204/.406 on the road.

WFRE GOING DANCING:
The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a lat Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out thee side.

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.
