# RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (40-25)





LHP Boston Bateman (5-3, 3.72 ERA) vs. LHP Sterling Patick (1-2, 5.13 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field! The Quakes continue a six-game series as they host the Lake Elsinore Storm (Padres) in game three of a six-game series. Tonight is Thirsty Thursday, with drink specials throughout the night including \$3 Pepsi products and \$5 16-ounce domestic drafts, all thanks to GeoVera! Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

**VS THE STORM:** Today's game is the sixth of 24 head-to-head games, with 15 of those taking place here at LoanMart Field. The Quakes are 5-0 against the Storm this year after two straight wins to open this series. Last season, the Quakes went just 10-20 against the Storm, 7-8 here at home.

**LAST GAME:** The Quakes raced to an early lead, then held off a ninth-inning rally by the Storm for a 5-3 win on Wednesday afternoon at LoanMart Field. Dilan Figueredo earned his first save as a Quake, after allowing a run in the ninth, but stranding the tying run at the plate. Christian Zazueta (7-2) was incredible on Wednesday, allowing one hit and one walk, while striking out a career-best ten hitters over five innings. Storm starter Kash Mayfield (0-3) took a tough-luck loss, allowing one unearned run over three hitless innings, while setting a new career-high with eight strikeouts. The win for Rancho is their seventh straight, while the Storm have now dropped five in a row.

**THE END AND THE BEGINNING:** This six-game set against the Storm marks the end of the 66-game first half (tonight) and the beginning of the 66-game second half (Friday night). The Quakes have already clinched their best first-half mark since the entire Cal League moved to the Low-A level in 2021. With a win tonight, the Quakes would match their longest winning streak of the half (eight) and would finish the first half with a mark of 41-25.

**SAN JOSE CLINCHES UP NORTH:** The San Jose Giants clinched a playoff berth for the sixth straight year, after scoring four times in the ninth inning of Wednesday night's 5-2 win at Modesto over the two-time defending Champion Modesto Nuts. San Jose has won ten Cal League titles, with their last coming back in 2021.

ROSTER MOVES: Rancho activated INF Oswaldo Osorio from the IL and transferred INF Roger Lasso to the ACL FIRST HALF SOUTH DIVISION CHAMPS: After stumbling a bit over a two-week stretch with an eight-game losing streak while both Visalia and Lake Elsinore were in the middle of seven-game win streaks, respectively, the Quakes put all doubt behind them by wrapping up the First Half South Division with last Friday's win over the 66ers in San Bernardino. The Quakes will now return to the playoffs for the first time since 2023, when they made it to the Championship Series, where they were swept by Modesto. The Quakes will have qualified for the playoffs in nine of the 14 seasons (2011, 2013, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2023 and 2025) of affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers. Ran cho has won three Championships in franchise history (1994, 2015 and 2018) with the last two coming as a Dodgers' affiliate. This will mark the second time in five seasons they'll make it to the playoffs under Manager John Shoemaker. STERLING PATICK: 19-year-old Sterling Patick makes his eighth start and 12th appearance, his first against Lake Elsinore. Patick's last start was on June 13th against Inland Empire, where he allowed two runs on six hits over four innings, in a no-decision. He's allowed just four runs on ten hits over his last 13 innings and three starts. Patick was a 2023 18th-round selection for the Dodgers out of South Hills High School in West Covina.

**BOSTON BATEMAN:** 19-year-old left-hander Boston Bateman makes his 11th start of the year for the Storm and his first against the Quakes. In his last outing overall, he allowed two runs on seven hits over 5.2 innings in a win against Visalia on June 12th. Bateman was selected in the second round (52nd overall) by San Diego in the 2024 draft out of Camarillo High School in Camarillo, California. He's ranked by MLB Pipeline as San Diego's fifth best prospect. **BROADCAST HOME:** Catch all the 2025 action with the "Voice of the Quakes" Mike Lindskog, from the ease of your phone, smart device or computer.
