#### FROM THE CROWS NEST

**HOME SWEET HOME:** The Bradenton Marauders begin their home season tonight with the first of six versus the Palm Beach Cardinals. This matchup marks the first between these two for a home opener at LECOM Park in franchise history. In 2024, the Marauders finished 33-33 while playing in the Friendly City. Bradenton hasn't had a losing season at home since 2018 when they finished 28-41. Since 2019, they're 181-141 in the regular season at LECOM Park.

SCOUTING THE REIGNING CHAMPS: The Palm Beach Cardinals come to town fresh off their second FSL Championship in franchise history and first since 2005 (also made it in 2017, but series wasn't played due to Hurricane Irma), beating the Lakeland Flying Tigers in three games. Their 2025 roster features 18 returning players from last year's club and six members of the Cardinals' 2024 draft class. Last weekend, they took two of three games from the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels at home. Cade McGee was named FSL Player of the Week after going 4-for-11 with 2 HR, including a walk-off blast on Sunday afternoon's 11-10 victory.

**DAYTONA RECAP:** After a 6-2 win on Friday's season opener, The Marauders dropped their final two games in Daytona against the Tortugas. On Saturday, the Marauders jumped to an early 3-0 lead over the first three innings, but a four-run fifth helped lift Daytona past them 7-3. On Sunday, **Zander Mueth** was stellar over his first three innings, retiring the first nine he faced in order. Daytona scored seven runs over the game's final six innings to win 7-0 in just over two hours. **Braylon Bishop** launched Bradenton's only homer of the series with a towering drive to left in game two. **Yordany De Los Santos** also drove in three runs throughout the weekend and **Will Taylor** went 4-for-9 with two doubles. They have now dropped three consecutive opening series dating back to 2023.

STUMBO GETS THE NOD: Peyton Stumbo is set to make his season debut tonight. The 22-year-old right hander appeared in 37 games for Bradenton in 2024 and made 3 starts. Over 67.2 innings, he registered a 4.92 ERA and fanned 76 hitters. In two relief outings at Palm Beach last year, he tossed three shutout frames and punched out two hitters.

WASTING NO TIME: MLB.com's No. 42 prospect and 2024 first-round pick Konnor Griffin went 2-for-4 with a walk and two stolen bases in his professional debut on Friday night. Both singles left the bat at 104 mph and 111 mph respectively. His first knock came on the first pitch he saw, while the second completed a 10-pitch at bat.

 $\textbf{TOP PROSPECTS \& SPRING BREAKOUT:} \ \ The 2025 \ roster features \ six of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 \ Prospects according to \ \textbf{MLB Pipeline: Konnor Griffin (No. 2), Zander Mueth (No. 10), Jhonny Severino (No. 12), Yordany De Los Santos (No. 16), Tony Blanco Jr. [IL] (No. 21), and \textbf{Axiel Plaz (No. 28)}. \\ All \ six players played for the Pirates Spring Breakout Team on 3/14 in a 3-5 loss to the Philladelphia Phillies Prospects.$ 

HORNER RETURNS TO CAPTAIN SHIP: Jim Horner returns to the Bradenton Marauders in 2025 for his second season as manager of the club, and sixth year in the Pirates organization. Prior to 2024, Horner managed the Florida Complex League Pirates (FCL) in 2023, served as a Minor League Assistant Field Coordinator in 2022 and a bench coach for Bradenton in 2021.

IT ALL BEGINS IN BRADENTON: Seven former Marauders were named to the Pirates Opening Day Roster (excluding rehab assignments), including four in the season's first starting lineup: Oneil Cruz (2019), Adam Frazier (2014), Ke'Bryan Hayes (2017), Jared Jones (IL - 2021), Mitch Keller (2016-18), Endy Rodriguez (2021), and Paul Skenes (2023). Thomas Harrington (2023) also made his Major League debut on 4/1 vs Tampa Bay, and INF Tsung-Che Cheng (2022) was called up on 4/7 making them the 107th and eventual 108th former Marauders to appear in the big leagues.
