# RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (19-8) Visalia Rawhide (13-14)





RHP Sean Paul Linan (2-1, 1.40 ERA) vs. RHP Denny Larrondo (0-2, 3.50 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes open a six-game road trip tonight, with game one of a six-game series against the Visalia Rawhide (AZ). The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, May 13th, taking on the Inland Empire 66ers in a six-game series. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE RAWHIDE: Today's game is the first of 24 head-to-head meetings and the first of 15 here at Valley Strong Ballpark. Last season, the Quakes went 14-16 against the Rawhide, 7-8 here in Visalia.

**LAST GAME:** The Quakes got a big day from Mike Sirota at the plate and won for the fifth time in six games on the home stand, taking a 9-5 decision from Stockton on Sunday afternoon at LoanMart Field. Sirota finished with four hits, including his fourth homer of the year, a walk and three runs scored to cap a perfect day offensively, helping the Quakes win for the tenth time in their last 11 games overall. Rancho hit a total of three homers on the day, with Kellon Lindsey (2) and Jaron Elkins (3) also going deep. Rancho reliever Aidan Foeller (1-1) fired three scoreless innings and was credited with his first pro win. Stockton starter Wei-En Lin (1-1) took the loss.

**PLENTY OF WINNING:** Friday's loss ended Rancho's best run of the season, at straight games overall and five straight here at home. While both those streaks ended on Friday, back-to-back wins to finish the series gives them 10 of their last 11 overall, five of six in the Stockton series and seven of their last eight at home. They're now 12-3 at LoanMart Field, having gone 3-0 against Lake Elsinore, 4-2 against San Jose and 5-1 against the Ports. Their longest winning streak since moving from High-A to Low-A is 10 straight (2023). Their longest winning streak in franchise history was in their third and most recent championship season of 2018, when they won 15 straight.

**SEAN PAUL RAISING THE TEMPERATURE:** Sean Paul Linan was named Cal League Pitcher of the Month for the month of April, after dominating over five appearances (four starts). Linan went 2-1 with a 1.40 ERA, striking out 45 batters, while walking just six over 25.2 innings of work. Linan was also named Cal League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 20th, where he allowed one hit and one walk, while striking out ten over five in a win over San Jose. **WEEKLY AWARDS SWEEP:** The Quakes had a great home stand and the Cal League's weekly awards reflect that. Quakes' starting pitcher Sterling Patick (five perfect innings against Stockton) was named the Pitcher of the Week, while Mike Sirota (7-for-20, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 7 R, 4 BB, .458 OBP, 1.208 OPS) was named Hitter of the week.

**SEAN PAUL LINAN:** Right-hander Sean Paul Linan makes his sixth appearance and fifth start of the year, his first against the Rawhide. In his last outing overall, Linan allowed two runs on five hits over five innings in a no-decision vs Stockton on April 30th. Linan's 45 strikeouts not only lead the league, but are the most in all of Minor League Baseball. Linan was named Cal League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 20th and is the league's reigning Pitcher of the Month. Linan opened 2024 with the ACL Dodgers, going 3-0 with a 2.08 ERA over six games (one start) before joining the Quakes, where he'd go 6-2 with a 4.89 ERA over 13 games (four starts). Linan signed with the Dodgers in January of 2022 out of Cartagena, Colombia.

**DENNY LARRONDO:** Third-year Visalia right-hander Denny Larrondo makes his fifth start of the year and his first against the Quakes. In Larrondo's last start overall, he allowed just one hit over six scoreless innings in a no-decision against Fresno on April 29th. Last year, Larrondo went 6-5 with a 3.56 ERA over 23 starts for Visalia, striking out 107 over 93.2 innings of work. Larrondo signed with the New York Yankees out of Cuba in 2018 and was claimed off waivers by Arizona in December of 2022.
