Tonight: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fourth game in a season-ending six-game series against the Dayton Dragons, High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds. The Dragons have won two of three games to open the series, leaving the Lugnuts with a 4-5 record at home and 9-6 overall mark against the Dragons.

Off the Field: This evening is the final LAFCU Frontline Friday with postgame LAFCU Fireworks! Tomorrow is Fan Appreciation Night featuring the Lugnut Jersey Charity Auction, and Sunday, the final game of the year, is a Capital City Market Kids Day / Accessible Day, partnering with Disability Rights Michigan.

Starting Matchup: Lugnuts right-hander Kyle Virbitsky looks for his third straight quality start, opposing Dayton right-hander Sam Benschoter, a native of Tecumseh who pitched five years at Michigan State University and signed as an undrafted free agent last year. Memorably, Benschoter struck out 17 Nebraska Cornhuskers in 9 1/3 innings on April 25, 2021, breaking Mark Mulder's single game school record achieved in 1998. Benschoter pitched against the Nuts in both the 2018 (0.2 IP, 1 K) and 2019 Crosstown Showdown (1 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 K).

Last Night: Dragons 3, Lugnuts 1. Dayton starter Julian Aguiar allowed one unearned run in five innings while striking out six and Austin Hendrick lined a tie-breaking RBI double in the eighth inning to lift the Dragons to a second straight win. In defeat, Joey Estes posted his third straight quality start with one run allowed on three hits and a walk in six innings, striking out five.

Clean Baseball: The Nuts committed one error last night, a throwing error by 1B Lawrence Butler, for their 106th error of the year. Regardless, this remains the best defensive season in team history, averaging 0.822 errors per game. In only three previous seasons in team history did the Lugnuts finish with fewer than 1 error committed per game: 2004 (0.950), 2015 (0.964) and 2017 (0.956). Contrast that with the Lugnuts' inaugural year, 1996, in which the club committed 218 errors in 139 games, an average of 1.568 per game.

Stacking Up: Comparing this season to the other 25 Lugnuts' seasons historically, the Nuts have their fourth highest single-season home run total all-time (107) but their 200 doubles currently ranks as the fewest in an season in team history; the team's strikeout total of 1.205 is the fourth highest; the team batting average of .243 is the fifth lowest; the team ERA of 5.08 is the second highest; and the pitchers' 137 home runs allowed and 95 HBPs each ranks as the most by any Nuts staff in team history.

The Wright Stuff: INF/OF Joshwan Wright went 1-for-2 yesterday with a single, a walk and an HBP, extending his hitting streak to 10 games, which tied Lawrence Butler (June 5-16) for the longest hitting streak on the team this season. Wright's streak began August 28 and has seen him hit 14-for-37, .378. Since June 25, the 21-year-old Wright is hitting .333 (55-for-165), raising his batting average from .188 to .278.

Up and Away: Ten Lugnuts have been promoted this year. Two pitchers - Hogan Harris and Jake Walkinshaw - reached Triple-A Las Vegas, while Double-A Midland currently features Jeff Criswell and David Leal in the rotation, Charles Hall and Trayson Kubo in the bullpen, and Austin Beck, Marty Bechina, Brett Harris and Tyler Soderstrom in the starting lineup. (The RockHounds, by the way, are playing their second doubleheader in three days tonight against Corpus Christi. They swept a twinbill from the Hooks on Wednesday.)

No-No History: Before last Sunday's four-pitcher no-hitter at South Bend, the only no-hitters in Lugnuts franchise history were...

- A three-pitcher, nine-inning 15-0 win on April 21, 2003, vs. Dayton, noteworthy for Donnie Hood hitting for the cycle in the same game
- A two-pitcher, six-inning 1-0 loss on July 14, 2016, at Peoria as part of a doubleheader, noteworthy for 2022 A.L. All-Star Jordan Romano starting the game for Lansing.

Team USA's Skipper for the Series: When manager Phil Pohl went on scheduled vacation from August 16-21 vs. Great Lakes; Veronica Alvarez stepped in as interim manager, going 2-4. Alvarez was the starting catcher for Team USA Baseball Women's National Team, winning medals in 2008 (bronze), 2010 (bronze), 2012 (silver) and 2015 (gold). She joined the Team USA's coaching staff as assistant coach in 2018, rising to manager of the Women's National Team beginning in 2019, when she led Team USA to a 7-0 record and the gold medal at the Women's Baseball World Cup Qualifier in Mexico, earning her the honor of 2019 USA Baseball Rod Dedeaux Coach of the Year. Welcome Back! After joining the Nuts directly after signing last year as the Athletics' 17th-round selection and making seven appearances, three starts, the towering Nittany Lion rejoined the Lugnuts after excelling in Stockton, replacing the demoted Stevie Emanuels in the Lansing rotation... limited the Great Lakes Loons to an Imanol Vargas solo homer in his 2022 Lansing debut on July 29, whiffing six in five innings.

Gem at Wisconsin: On August 25, Virbitsky whiffed 11 in six innings, tying the Lugnuts' season high as set previously by Blake Beers and Jeff Criswell in May... strikeouts by inning: one in the 1st, two in the 2nd, two in the 3rd, one in the 4th (when the Rattlers scored two runs), three in the 5th, two in the 6th... 96 pitches, 65 strikes.

Last Start: September 2 at South Bend. Blanked the Cubs through the first four innings before allowing a two-run homer to Kevin Made in the 5th inning... recovered to post a scoreless 6th, stranding with the frame ending on Yohendrick Piñango caught stealing second base... 88 pitches, 56 strikes.

The Strikeouts Mean More: Kyle is the Athletics' organizational K leader, topping all Oakland MiLB pitchers with 134 strikeouts... to conclude the season, he has partnered with the Pediatric Brain Tumor Foundation Vs. Cancer program (#GoHead2Head to #CancelChildhoodCancer), raising money with every strikeout he records during his final four starts... he currently has 20 strikeouts through three starts.

Turning Pro: Virbitsky's first time being drafted was in 2021, taken 518th overall by the Oakland Athletics... signed for \$50,000... also from Penn State: Mike Scioscia, David Aardsma, and Hall of Famer John "Monte" Montgomery Ward... both of Kyle's parents attended Penn State.

Glory Days: Attended Episcopal Academy, where he pitched against Michael Siani (William Penn Charter School), who also was the first player Virbitsky faced as a pro (Siani, playing for the Dayton Dragons, tripled)... named a Top-25 baseball player in Pennsylvania by PennLive.com... 2016 Perfect Game Underclass high honorable mention... 2017 Rawlings-Perfect Game honorable mention All-America... as a junior, posted 1.76 ERA with 66 strikeouts while hitting three home runs... as a senior was named Team MVP of the Episcopal baseball team, honored as the No. 8 right-handed pitcher in Pennsylvania by Perfect Game... also named Team MVP of the Episcopal football team (tight end and defensive lineman), and was honored as first-team all-league and all-area at TE and DL.
