Blast the Baysox: The Somerset Patriots take on the Bowie Baysox for the first-time ever at Prince George's Stadium this week. The Patriots currently own a 5-4 series lead.

Playoff Picture: The Double-A Northeast League will feature a two-team playoffs this season with one best-of-five Championship Series played between the two teams with the best overall records regardless of division. The Patriots currently find themselves 0.5 games ahead of the Bowie Baysox for the second playoff spot and 4.0 games behind the Akron RubberDucks for the best overall record in the league. The Portland Sea Dogs are also in the conversation, currently 3.0 games behind Somerset. Nine of the Patriots' final 15 games of the season are against Akron and Bowie.

Comeback Kidz: Each of the Patriots last four wins have been comeback efforts, including overcoming deficits of two runs or more three times. Tuesday night's series-opener in Bowie marked the largest come-from-behind win of the year for Somerset. The team jumped ahead 4-0 early, then trailed by as many as five runs (9-4 deficit) after allowing seven runs in the second and two more in the third inning. The Patriots outscored the Baysox 9-1 over the final six innings of the night, including a six-run rally in the eighth inning. It marked the second-straight win for Somerset in which they erased at least a four-run deficit (8/29 vs. Akron).

Locked and Loaded: OF Brandon Lockridge was reinstated from the 7-Day Injured List last night and played in the first game of the doubleheader. Lockridge missed two weeks away from the team. He was hitting .342 with seven home runs, 13 RBI, eight stolen bases, and a .387 OBP before he was injured, including a .370 AVG and .435 OBP across 12 games in August.

Hammer Time: INF Dermis Garcia has a pair of go-ahead three-run home runs over the first three games of the current series. Garcia leads the league and the Yankees' organization in home runs (27). Additionally, he ranks second among all of Double-A and is tied for sixth in all of Minor League Baseball in home runs.

Call to the Bullpen: Somerset's bullpen tossed 3.1 scoreless innings yesterday and now has a 1.23 ERA (5 ER over 36.2 IP) over its last nine games.

Belly Up: INF Chad Bell began his time in Somerset 6-for-56 (.107) over his first 15 games. He is 5-for-11 (.455) with a home run, RBI, three runs and a walk in his last three games.

Arms Race: Somerset's pitching staff owns the lowest ERA (3.42), BAA (.212), and most shutout wins (15) across all MiLB levels. Additionally, the team has the third-lowest WHIP (1.16) and ranks fifth in strikeouts (1,136). The Patriots have already set a new franchise record for strikeouts in a season, passing the previous high set in 2016.
