**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn dropped Friday's contest at Wilmington in walk-off fashion, 3-2...Blue Rocks C **Maxwell Romero Jr.** collected the game-winning RBI single with two out in the bottom of the ninth...IB **Kellum Clark** picked up his fourth-straight multi-hit game for the Cyclones, accumulating two singles and a walk...C **Christian Pregent** reached base three times, going 2-for-3 with a walk and an RBI...DH **Wilfredo Lara** doubled and walked as part of a two-hit performance, scoring a run...RHP **Dakota Hawkins** took a no-decision for Brooklyn after striking out a career-high-tying five over 5.0 innings of two-run ball...RHP **Henry Henry** posted 2.0 innings of scoreless relief, striking out four and walking one.

**THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY:** On July 13, 2004, **Joseph Gajdos** walked through the gates at then-KeySpan Park and became the one-millionth fan to come through the gates in Cyclones history...In 2007, LF **Lucas Duda** went 4-for-4 with two runs scored, two runs batted in, and a walk, as the Cyclones scored 10 runs over the final two innings in a 16-7 win at Tri-City...In 2016, IB **Pete Alonso** blasted a two-run home run — the first of his professional career — in the top of the first as part of a two-hit, three-RBI day in a 6-2 win at Aberdeen...In 2021, IB **Jeremy Vasquez** provided the game's only run on a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the eighth, as RHPs **Jaison Viera** (5.0 IP), **Colby Morris** (2.0), and **Michel Otañez** (2.0) combined on a three-hit 1-0 shutout vs. Jersey Shore...In 2022, RF **Stanley Consuegra** tallied four extra-base hits — a franchise-record-tying three doubles and a three-run home run — as part of a five-RBI day in a 9-0 win vs. Greensboro.

**SPROAT THE GOAT:** RHP **Brandon Sproat** — who started the season in the Brooklyn Cyclones rotation — will represent the New York Mets in Saturday's Sirius/XM All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Park in Arlington, Texas...The 23-year-old made six appearances (five starts) for Brooklyn, registering a 2-1 record with a 1.07 ERA (3 ER in 25.1 IP), 16 walks (15.7 BB%), and 33 strikeouts (32.4 K%). Since joining Double-A Binghamton on May 13, Sproat has continued his dominance, posting a 4-0 mark with a 2.05 ERA (11 ER in 48.1 IP), 12 walks (6.7 BB%), and 52 strikeouts (29.2 K%)...The 2023 second-round pick will be the first player to play for Brooklyn and appear in the Futures Game in the same season since C **Francisco Alvarez** and INF **Brett Baty** in 2021.

**'TALK 2 'EM:** RHP **Kade Morris** has started to find his stride at the High-A level...Since his start on June 21 vs. Jersey Shore, the 22-year-old holds a 2-1 record with a sparkling 1.85 ERA (5 ER in 24.1 IP) in four appearances (three starts)...He has yielded just 15 hits and 10 walks (10.2 BB%) while striking out 21 (21.4 K%)...Since June 20, Morris and RHP **Jonah Tong** have been two of the best arms in the South Atlantic League...In that span, Tong is second in the circuit in ERA (0.82) and Morris (1.85) is eighth...Additionally, Kade is third in innings pitched (24.1), fifth in batting average against (.174), and ninth in WHIP (1.03)...Since making his SAL debut on May 22, Morris is third in the league in innings pitched (48.0), fourth in batting average against (.219), sixth in WHIP (1.21), and eighth in ERA (3.56).

**THE TONG SONG:** RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Over his last four starts since June 20, the 21-year-old is 2-1 with an 0.82 ERA (2 ER in 22.0 IP), allowing only eight hits and six walks (7.40 BB%), while striking out 32 (39.51 K%)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native has led the circuit in strikeouts (70) and batting average against (.189)...He is also second in ERA (2.85) and WHIP (1.14), and seventh in innings pitched (53.2)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 70.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.11), fourth in strikeout rate (36.1%), fifth in strikeout-to-walk rate (26.5%), and seventh in strikeouts (106).

**TAKING KELLUM 123:** OF **Kellum Clark** snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game last Saturday at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since...The 23-year-old has picked up multiple knocks in his previous four games, going 9-for-14 (.643) with three runs scored, a double, an RBI, and two walks...Clark had just one multi-hit game in the first 48 contests of his career before the four-game multi-hit streak.

**TRAVELING CIRCUIS:** Starting with the June 25 game in Aberdeen, the Cyclones have just six home games in 28 days...Brooklyn's next full six-game home series will take place from July 23-28 vs. Rome...So far, Brooklyn is 5-11 in the stretch...The Cyclones played three games at home vs. Hudson Valley from July 1-3 and will play another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 19-21 immediately following the All-Star break...The stretch also includes a 12-day run without a day off (June 25-July 6), the longest of the season for Brooklyn.

**WIZARD OF PAZ:** OF **Karell Paz** is in the midst of one of his best offensive stretches of the 2024 season...Since clubbing a go-ahead two-run home run in the ninth inning on June 30 at Aberdeen, the 24-year-old is 10-for-31 (.323) at the plate in nine games...Paz has scored four runs and picked up three doubles, a home run, five runs batted in, four walks, and four stolen bases...His OPS is .916 during that span.

**vs. WILMINGTON:** After a two-day break, Brooklyn travels south for a six-game series against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks boast three of Washington's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP **Jarlin Susana** (10), OF **Jeremy De La Rosa** (23), and INF **T.J. White** (25)...The Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Wilmington in the first meeting on Coney Island (April 23-28), but the Blue Rocks swept the season-opening series at Frawley Stadium (April 5-7) winning the last two games in walk-off fashion...Brooklyn was 9-9 at home and 7-5 on the road against the 'Rocks in the 2023 for a 16-14 record...Since 2021, the Cyclones are 47-46 all-time against Wilmington (.505).

**MORABITO FUEL:** OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The 21-year-old is 11th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (37)...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito is tied for third in the circuit in stolen bases (26) and hits (60), and tied for eighth in runs scored (37)...On the year, the former second-round selection is ninth in the SAL in batting average (.278) and stolen bases (26)...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.310), on-base percentage (.408), and stolen bases (37)...He is also second in hits (91) and runs scored (51) and tied for fourth in triples (4).

**OMAR-I-GONE:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League with 31 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (68) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (68) and is tied for fourth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (140).

**ZILCH, ZERO, NADA:** RHPs **Kodai Senga** (2.2 IP) and **Kade Morris** (6.1) combined on a four-hit shutout, as the Cyclones blanked the Renegades, 4-0, last Wednesday...A night before, RHPs **Jonah Tong** (5.0 IP), **Ben Simon** (3.0), and **Jake Stevenson** (1.0) combined on a two-hitter in a 7-0 triumph vs. Hudson Valley...Cyclones pitching staff in 2024 trailing only scoreless innings between OF **Garrett Martin's** solo home run in the eighth inning on July 1 and DH **Omar Martinez's** three-run blast in the first inning on July 4...Brooklyn's longest scoreless stretch of the year is 23.2 frames from June 1-5 at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively...Brooklyn now has 10 shutouts, the second most by a South Atlantic League pitching staff in 2024 trailing only Rome (13)...It is also tied for sixth most throughout Minor League Baseball...The Cyclones' single-season shutout record is 11 set during the 2023 campaign.

**LOCATION, LOCATION:** The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...OF **Nick Morabito** loves his time on the road...He is hitting .307/.394/.407 with a .801 OPS, adding two home runs, nine RBI, and 24 stolen bases in 34 road contests...He is fifth in the circuit in road batting average (.307) and, since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old has had the most road hits (43) and stolen bases (24) in the circuit...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .224/.289/.250 line with a .539 OPS, two extra-base hits, two RBI, and two stolen bases over 18 games...INF **Junior Tilen** has thrived at Maimonides Park, posting a .309/.366/.455 mark with a .821 OPS, three home runs, and 14 RBI in 31 games...On the road, Tilen is hitting .174/.279/.250 with a .529 OPS, a home run, and nine runs batted in over 37 contests...C **Chris Suero** is hitting .250/.418/.442 with a .860 OPS, three home runs, and 11 RBI in 16 games on Coney Island...The 20-year-old is batting .181/.302/.267 with a .569 OPS, a home run, and 14 RBI in 31 affairs in visiting ballparks.

**LARRUPIN' LORUSSO:** INF **Nick Lorusso** was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Wednesday...During his time in the South Atlantic League, the 23-year-old was tied for eighth in total bases (123), ninth in walks (40), and 10th in OPS (.834)...Lorusso also dominated at Maimonides Park...The former Maryland Terrapin hit .367/.444/.661 with a 1.105 OPS in 30 contests on Coney Island...Lorusso led the SAL in home batting average (.367) and on-base percentage (.444) while trailing only Greenville OF **Brayan González** in slugging (.661) and OPS (1.105)...The Connecticut native is the 12th Cyclone to join the Rumble Ponies in 2024.

**WALK-OFF WOES:** Brooklyn's 3-2 loss at Wilmington on Friday night marked the team's seventh walk-off defeat of the season...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 17 walk-off losses, accumulating 15.32% of all defeats...Brooklyn has one walk-off win this year on **Nick Lorusso's** game-winning home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Asheville on April 14.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesús Báez** (9), RHP **Jonah Tong** (15), RHP **Kade Morris** (23), RHP **Jack Weninger** (26), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season injured list...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Báez (22), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not receive a decision last Saturday night at Hudson Valley...Surrendered three runs on four hits over 5.1 innings...Walked three and struck out three...Induced a double play...Tossed 78 pitches and 48 strikes (61.54%)...Relieved by RHP **Jake Stevenson** with a runner at second and one out in the bottom of the sixth and Brooklyn trailing 2-1...Bequeathed runner scored...Cyclones rallied for three runs in the top of the seventh to tie the game at four...Renegades took the lead for good with a bases-loaded walk in the bottom of the inning and defeated Brooklyn, 5-4.

**PROSPECT RADAR:** After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by *Baseball America*.

**HOME COOKING:** De La Cruz has been outstanding on Coney Island in 2024...Through his first seven appearance (six starts) of the campaign, the southpaw is 1-2 with a 1.84 ERA (6 ER in 29.1 IP), 13 walks, and 38 strikeouts...De La Cruz has not seen the same level of success on the road...The 23-year-old holds a 2-3 mark in visiting parks, but yields a 6.19 ERA (22 ER in 32.0 IP), with 15 walks, and 33 strikeouts...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 29.0 innings pitched at home, De La Cruz ranks fifth in ERA (1.84).

**FELIP-IN' AMAZIN':** The 23-year-old celebrated his birthday a day early by shutting out Hudson Valley on May 25 over 6.0 innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts...De La Cruz was one shy of the single game Brooklyn franchise record of 14 set by LHP **Mike Cox** (8/25/01 vs. HV) and RHP **Brad Holt** (7/24/08 vs. VER)...He was the first Cyclone to strike out 13+ hitters in a single contest since RHP **Rob Gsellman** accomplished the feat on August 24, 2013, at Vermont...De La Cruz is the sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13 punchout threshold and the third to strikeout 13 or more in 6.0 or fewer innings.

**WELCOME TO BROOKLYN:** The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all six innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **José Butto** accomplished the feat, tossing six innings in a seven-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

**FLORIDA STATE FELIPE:** De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
