SPRINGDALE, AR – The Northwest Arkansas Naturals and Springfield Cardinals traded leads early, but a surge in the middle and late innings pushed the Cardinals ahead as the Naturals dropped the series opener, 11-4.

- At the top of the order, shortstop **Maikel Garcia** scored three of Northwest Arkansas' four runs, as he singled and scored in the first, doubled and scored in the third, then walked and scored in the seventh.
- After Garcia dashed home on a wild pitch in the first, Springfield leapt ahead in the second inning, then the Naturals took the lead back in the third on a two-run single from **Tucker Bradley**. Northwest Arkansas stayed ahead until the fifth, when the Cardinals tied the game on a single and error, then took the lead for good in the sixth.
- Bradley doubled Garcia across in the seventh to counter a run the Cardinals scored in the top half, but a five-run eighth from Springfield was too much for the Naturals to overcome.
- Starting pitcher **Andrew Hoffmann** made his Arvest Ballpark debut, holding the Cardinals to three runs on four hits over the first five innings, but could not make it out of the sixth, throwing 5.2 innings. Hoffmann was charged for five runs on eight hits for his second straight start.
- Nathan Webb**, **Yefri Del Rosario** and **Walter Pennington** combined to throw 3.1 innings of relief, but combined to allow six runs (four earned) on three hits and three walks.

THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 6-5 all-time when playing on July 23

On July 23, 2017, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals walked off on the Tulsa Drillers, 8-7 at Arvest Ballpark. The Naturals entered the ninth trailing the Drillers 5-4, then Tulsa scored twice to jump out to a three run lead for a 7-4 score heading to the bottom of the ninth. The first two outs in the bottom of the inning were recorded quickly, before the Naturals rallied. **Donnie Dewees** was hit by a pitch, then **Humberto Arteaga** and **Allan de San Miguel** walked. With the bases loaded, **Nick Dini** singled in two, then **Nicky Lopez** singled in one to tie the game. Tulsa brought a position player in to pitch and **Anderson Miller** doubled home Dini as the winning run.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 18 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
6 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Jake Means, Noah Murdock, Logan Porter and John Rave.

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 31-6, while when scoring six runs or less, just 7-43.
The Naturals are 25-11 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 13-38.
The Naturals are 35-11 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 3-38 when out-hit by their opponent.
When the Naturals score first, they are 24-17, whereas 14-32 when the opponent scores first.

ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY

The Naturals are 4-17 in one-run games this season, meaning 17 of their 49 losses (45.7%) this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the tying run at the plate or on base in 19 losses this season (including 13 of their one-run losses).

YO, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 87 games, the Naturals have stolen 120 bases in 145 attempts (average 1.38 steals/game, 82.8% success rate).

- 120 steals ranks tied for the most in the Texas League, tied fourth in Double-A and tied 23rd in the Minors.
Maikel Garcia's 27 steals (in 30 attempts) ranks third in the Texas League and eighth among all Double-A basestealers.
The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 57 of 87 games this season (65.5%), including 31 games with two or more steals ... the team stole a season-high six bases on July 6 vs. Tulsa with a pair of five-steal games as well this season.
The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 16 times, meaning 32 of 120 steals this year (26.7%) have come on a double-steal.
Naturals players have stolen multiple bases in a game 14 times, SIX of those occasions being Garcia ... Tucker Bradley had the first three-steal game of the season (and of his career) on July 9 vs. Tulsa.

BIG INNING BITES AGAIN

Friday night, the Cardinals scored five runs in the eighth inning, the seventh straight game where Naturals pitching has allowed five or more runs in one inning.

- Across the seven innings in the last seven games where the Naturals have allowed at least five runs, a total of 42 runs have been scored in those innings, an average of 6.0 runs/inning.
42 runs allowed across seven big innings represents 60.9% of the total runs (69) the Naturals have allowed in their last seven games.
When removing the big inning from each of the last seven games, the Naturals have allowed 27 runs in 52 innings, or an average of 0.52 runs/inning, or one run every 1.93 innings.
When you expand the scope to a four-run inning or worse surrendered by Naturals pitching, that has happened at least once in 11 of 16 games in the month of July, representing 59 of the 122 runs (48.4%) the staff has allowed since July 1.

TYLER, THE CREATOR (OF RUNS)

Naturals outfielder Tyler Gentry has been one of the best hitters in the Kansas City Royals' system this season, with an incredible impact since joining the Naturals last month.

- Among qualified full-season Minor League hitters, Gentry ranks 10th in batting average, while 15th in OPS, when you combine his numbers between NW Arkansas and Quad Cities (A+).
He has hits in 19 of his first 28 games with the Naturals and has reached base in 24 of 28 games, including at one point a stretch of 18 straight.
Since his call-up to Double-A on June 14, Gentry is batting .318 (34-for-107) over 28 games with six doubles, nine home runs and 31 runs batted (1.11 RBI per game) and a 1.020 OPS ... he's driven in at least one run in 16 of 28 games, with eight multi-RBI games ... he already has 10 multi-hit games and nine multi-run games as well.
Over 15 games in the month of July, Gentry is hitting .345 (20-for-58) with seven extra-base hits and 20 runs batted in, while he has scored 17 runs as well ... his 20 RBI this month rank third among Texas League hitters.
He is the Royals' organization leader in batting average (.328) and OPS (.982), while ranking second in on-base percentage (.416) and slugging percentage (.566) ... his 54 runs batted in between the River Bandits and Naturals rank fifth, while 14 total home runs is sixth.
Gentry's 18-game on-base streak that snapped last night is the longest for a Naturals player this season ... between June 26 and July 17, he hit .382 (26-for-68) with 10 extra-base hits and 12 walks, with an on-base percentage of .459 in that span.

ROCKIN' ROBBIE

After slumping for much of June, first baseman Robbie Glendinning has returned to form, with a hot stretch that has carried from late June to July.

- Glendinning's 62 runs batted in this season rank fourth not just in the Texas League, but among all Double-A hitters as well, behind 64 from three players ... his 34 extra-base hits are tied for the ninth-most in the circuit, while 145 total bases in 10th.
He has reached base in 68 of 76 games he's played this season (89.5%), reaching multiple times in 37 games this season ... he has hits in 52 of 76 games, including a team-best 25 multi-hit games this season ... 22 of his multi-hit games are two-hit games.
In 15 games this month, Glendinning is hitting .333 (21-for-63) with nine extra-base hits and 19 runs batted in ... his 41 total bases, six home runs and 19 runs batted in are all tied for the fourth-most in the Texas League in the month of July.
Among Royals minor league hitters, Glendinning ranks as one of the top hitters in nearly every category ... his 145 total bases are tied for the second-most in the system, while 62 runs batted in, 18 doubles, 34 extra-base and 57 runs scored hits rank third and 15 home runs (a career-high) are tied for fourth ... he ranks fifth among qualified hitters in the system in slugging percentage (.505), sixth in OPS (.878), seventh in on-base percentage (.373) and ninth in batting average (.279).

PUSHIN P(ORTER)

Catcher Logan Porter has quietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- Among qualified full-season Minor League hitters, Porter ranks FOURTH in on-base percentage (.448) ... he is first among all qualified Double-A hitters in OBP ... in the Texas League, he is second in OBP, seventh in OPS (.950) and ninth in batting average (.311).
Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter's .448 OBP is the highest on-base percentage in the system, while he ranks second in OPS, third in batting average and sixth in slugging percentage (.502) ... his 50 walks are second in the system, behind Nick Pratto's 51.
Porter has reached base in 58 of 65 games he's played this season (89.2%) and has reached base multiple times on 41 occasions, with hits in 54 of 65 games and 22 multi-hit games.
Porter's 17-game on-base streak between May 31 and June 23 is tied for the second-longest on the team this season, a stretch where he hit .321 (17-for-53) with 15 walks and a .493 OBP.

Pitchers of the Month (1)

May: LHP Drew Parrish ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

Players of the Week (3)

- April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.
May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.
June 27 to July 3: OF Tyler Gentry ... hit .435 (10-for-23) with two doubles, four home runs and 11 runs batted in, which was tied for the most in the league. Recorded 24 total bases with a 1.043 slugging percentage 1.543 OPS.

Pitchers of the Week (3)

- May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.
May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.
June 6 to June 12: LHP Anthony Veneziano ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a complete-game shutout on June 9 @ Tulsa ... held the Drillers to just three hits and one walk while striking out five, on 79 pitches. Retired the final eight hitters he faced and 11 of the last 12, only needing five pitches for a 1-2-3 seventh inning to end the night.
