

Looking Back

Reading beat Richmond 5-3 last night, thanks to a four-run eighth inning that was capped off with a three-run go-ahead home run from Nick Podkul. Griff McGarry was strong over five innings of work and Matthew Kroon added two doubles as well in the win. Entering last night, Reading was just 2-32 this season in games when trailing after seven, but picked up the win despite that.

Kroon Krushing It

Matthew Kroon had two doubles last night, marking the third time he's had two in a game this season. He also is tied for third in the Eastern League with 19 doubles this year. Additionally, Kroon's .323 average ranks third in the Eastern League and he's also reached base in a personal-season-best 14-straight games. This all comes one year after Kroon missed all but two games in 2022 due to an injury.

Oliver Dunn had two more hits last night to raise his average to .266 this season. The last two nights, Dunn is five-for-eight, and had two doubles on Thursday. Across his last five games, Dunn's hitting .389 and is at .324 over his last ten. Dunn's Eastern League ranks currently sit at the following: 4th OBP (.405), 3rd walks (50), 7th OPS (.896) and 4th RBI (42).

Nick's Knack for the Dramatics

Nick Podkul's game-winning home run last night was his 11th of the season, after only hitting five last year. Over his last two games, Podkul had two triples Sunday and reached base four times yesterday, including a double and homer to raise his season-average to .302.

Hey Now You're an All Star

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Mick Abel was selected to the All Star Future's Game on Monday night. Abel is one-of-two Phillies' prospects to be selected, with the other being Justin Crawford of Clearwater. Abel will return just three-hours from home for the game in Seattle.

Around the Organization

The Phillies fell to the Nationals in the opening game of this weekend's series last night. Lehigh Valley fell to Rochester 5-4 as former R-Phil Simon Muzziotti had three hits. Jersey Shore dropped one to Brookltn 5-1 as Rixon Wingrove had a single and double. Finally, Clearwater blew out Bradenton 14-1 as Jean Cabrera went five scoreless on the mound and Otto Kemp chipped in two hits.

This Day in Baseballtown History

July 1, 2016: At Reading, the Fightin Phils notch their 5th straight win, a 4-2 triumph over Harrisburg. Tyler Viza goes 7.0 shutout innings, allowing 5 hits and 2 walks while striking out 5 to pick up his second win. Jorge Alfaro is 1-for-4 with a homer and 2 runs.

Richmond Roundup

This is the second series of the season between Reading and Richmond, with the first being a sweep for Richmond at The Diamond. Richmond enters this week after going 33-36 in the first half and finishing fourth in the Southwest Division. Last week, Richmond took five-of-six against Harrisburg, including four-straight to close the series. Next week, Richmond takes on Bowie at home.

Local Kid on the Mound

Righty Mason Black gets the start tonight for Richmond. Overall, Black is 0-4 with a 4.00 ERA over 14 starts. He's allowed 42 hits, issued 20 walks and has 66 strikeouts over 54 innings of work. He combined for 9.1 shutout innings over two starts against Harrisburg last week; combining to allow just four hits and have 11 strikeouts. On Apr. 9, Black went four innings and gave up three runs to Reading. Black was a third-round pick by the Giants in 2021 out of Lehigh and is from Scranton, PA. He split 2022 between San Jose and Eugene.

They found a bargain later on in the period, in January of 2018, when they inked Rojas for just \$10K. In each of his two years of full season ball, he's started slowly but finished well offensively, showing off his plus speed and defense at all stops. He made it to Double-A for the first time in 2022 and then finished with a strong performance in the Arizona Fall League before getting added to the 40-man roster. Rojas has shown he can be an impact player on both sides of the ball thanks to his near-top-of-the-scale speed. He's an elite baserunner, one who stole 62 bases in 67 tries last season and then went 13-for-13 in the AFL. His speed is an obvious asset in the outfield, where he is a premium defender in center field, one who could be a Gold Glov.
