PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

IN GOOD STANDINGS

- While the standings re-set for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today's game 26 games over .500 with a 57-31 record (.648 winning percentage).
- 57 wins are tied for the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season with the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, Houston's Triple-A affiliate.
 - Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .658 winning percentage overall this year is also tied for the best in the Minors with Sugar Land (57-31 / .648).
 - The Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

- 57 of Omaha's 88 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 22 of 31 losses in 2024, with 12 of 31 losses by just one run (39%).
- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 7 of its last 15 save opportunities, since June 5 (47%).
 - Omaha is 18-12 in 1-run games this season, which ranks as the 3rd-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team.
 - As a team, Omaha's 27 saves are tied for the 5th-most of any Minor League team and 2nd-most in Triple-A ... **Will Klein's** 9 saves individually rank 4th in the International League, this season, while seven different Storm Chasers pitchers have 2 or more saves in 2024.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

- Omaha has outscored its opponents 497 to 400 this season, a +97 run differential.
- A +97 run differential this year ranks as the best mark both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.
 - Omaha ranks 7th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Greensboro Grasshoppers lead the Minors at +151 (525 to 374).

DAZZLING DEFENSE

- Omaha's defense has had its ups and downs this season, but the team is on one of its best stretches in the field this season.
- Over Omaha's last 27 games (since June 9), a .989 fielding percentage (11 errors in 964 total chances) is the 2nd-best in Minor League Baseball over that span.
 - Overall this year, a .981 fielding percentage is tied 7th in the league, tied 9th in Triple-A and tied 12th of the 120 full-season Minor League teams.
 - The Storm Chasers have not made an error in 10 of the team's last 15 games, with a streak of 6 errorless games snapped last Friday ... early in the season, Omaha went 7 straight games without making an error, March 31 to April 7.

COMEBACK KIDS

- Omaha has 32 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (56%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.
- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 10 occasions.
 - Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 11 of the 31 comeback wins, with five victories where the club had to overcome multiple deficits ... the team has 8 wins in games where they trailed after the 6th inning.

RELIEF AID

- Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best across the entire Triple-A level in 2024.
- The Storm Chasers relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens with a 1.35 WHIP and an opposing slash line of .213/.324/.356 ... the .213 opponents' average is tied for the 8th-best in the Minors ... a 3.86 ERA is 2nd at the Triple-A level.
 - Omaha's bullpen has been combined to not allow a run in 20 games this year, roughly one in every 4.40 games ... a stretch of 16 consecutive games without a scoreless bullpen effort ended with yesterday's 4-0 win over Toledo, which was the longest stretch for the team this season.
 - Evan Sisk** has been one of Omaha's most reliable relief pitchers over the last month ... Sisk has not allowed an earned run since June 9, a stretch of 13 games and 10.2 innings ... in that span, he's allowed just 4 hits with 12 strikeouts.

TODAY'S START

- Champlain is making his 9th start with Omaha and his 16th overall start this season ... after opening the season in Double-A with NW Arkansas, Champlain made 7 starts for the Naturals before being promoted to Omaha on Monday, May 20.
- Ranked 2nd among Royals Minor League pitchers in 2024 in strikeouts (80) and 4th in innings pitched (76.2) ... he is 4th among Royals full-season qualifiers in opponents' batting average (.239), 7th in WHIP (1.23) and 8th in ERA (4.58) ...
- Has thrown 6 quality starts this year in his 15 total starts, 3 at each NW Arkansas (AA) and Omaha (AAA) ... his 3 quality starts with the Storm Chasers have been his 3 starts at Werner Park.
- Ranked by MLB Pipeline as the No. 11 Royals prospect ... Ranked by Baseball America as the No. 7 Royals prospect.

LAST OUTING: FRIDAY, JULY 5 @ IOWA

Fired a 1-2-3 inning, his first time he threw a perfect first inning with Omaha this season ... two singles, a walk and a double scored 3 runs in the 2nd inning ... two walks and a single scored a run in the 3rd inning ... struck out the side in the 4th inning ... did not come out for the 5th inning, one off a season-high, threw 93 pitches over 4.0 innings.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Struggled in his season debut in Double-A on April 7 vs. Tulsa (LAD), tied a career-high with 8 runs allowed in just 2.2 innings, but threw at least 5.0 innings and did not allow more than two runs in each of his final 6 Double-A starts, including three quality starts.
