CARDS 'PEN SPINS GEM IN 6-1 WIN OVER TRAVS: Jack Raiston, Ryan Shreve and Andrew Marrero combined to fire 7.0 scoreless innings in relief of Tink Hence and the Cardinals collected 11 hits in a 6-1 win over the Arkansas Travelers on Wednesday night at Dickey-Stephens Park in North Little Rock. Hence, the Cardinals' top prospect, left after 2.0 innings after an apparent injury. Nathan Church drove in two for the Birds, and Jeremy Rivas had 3 hits to extend his hitting streak to a season-high 10 games. The Cards scored four times in the first two innings, capitalizing on 3 Traveler errros. With the win, Springfield regained a half-game lead on the Travs for first place in the North Division.



**OPPOSING STARTER:** Left-hander **Reid VanScoter** makes his 11th start of the season for the Travelers...Last pitched on Friday, June 1 and took the loss against Amarillo surrendering 4 R (3 ER) on 5 H with 6 K over 4.0 IP... Went 1-2 with a 4.64 ERA in 4 starts in May after a 1-0 record with a 2.77 ERA in 5 April starts...In two starts against the Cardinals this season has allowed 6 ER over 9.1 IP (5.79 ERA) with 7 K and 3 BB...Springfield won both games, but VanScoter did not factor in either decision...Spent the entire 2023 season with High-A Everett and went 10-6 with a 3.27 ERA in 25 starts in his first full season...Struck out 157 with just 35 BB in 143.1 IP...Finished the season tied for 7th in all of MiLB in IP...Selected by the Mariners in the 5th round of the 2022 draft out of Coastal Carolina...2022 Sun Belt Pitcher of the Year and named a 2nd team All-American by Collegiate baseball after going 9-4 with a 3.65 ERA...Went 2-1 with a 4.60 ERA in 12 appearances as a junior in 2021...Spent his first two collegiate seasons at Binghamton... Threw three no-hitters in high school...25 years old

CARDS AND TRAVS SQUARE OFF IN CRUCIAL SIX-GAME SERIES: The Cardinals make their second and final trip to North Little Rock this week for a six-game series against the Arkansas Travelers (Double-A, Seattle Mariners). Just a half game separates the two clubs coming into the series with 18 games remaining in the first half. The Cards swept a 3-game series at Dickey-Stephens Park to start the season.



### CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

# CLASSIC ROCK

### **CARDS' RADIO HOME**

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

**RDAD WARRIDRS:** The Cardinals have been more than solid on the road this season, going 18-10 away from Hammons Field. The Cards have a 3.74 ERA on the road, the 2nd best road ERA in the league behind Midland's 3.42, compared to a 5.80 mark at home.

**HITS, HITS:** For the greater part of the 2024 season, the Cardinals have owned the top hitting offense in Double-A with a .271 batting average, 5 points better than any other team in the level. The Cards have 14 more hits than any other Double-A team with 474. Springfield is tied for 5th

**Nathan Church** leads the Texas league in hits with 57, and **Bryan Torres** ranks 3rd with 56.

**GRINDIN':** Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats. The Cards have struck out the 3rd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 372 whiffs in 53 games. The only teams with fewer strikeouts than Springfield are the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (355 K in 52 games) and Frisco RoughRiders (371 K). The Cards are averaging just 7.01 K's per game.

**POWER OUTAGE:** While the Cardinals have been piling up base hits, not many recently have gone over the wall. The Cards have not hit a home run in any of their last 9 games, and have hit just one longball over their last 12 contests, and 2 homers over their last 14. Springfield's last home run came on Saturday, May 25: a two-run shot by **Mike Antico** off **Orlando Ortiz-Mayr** of the Tulsa Drillers at Hammons Field. The Birds have the 2nd-fewest longballs in the Texas League with 30 on the season.

MOUND TURNAROUND: While the 2024 season has been up and down for the Cardinals pitching staff, Springfield is on a good run of late. Over their last 11 games the Cards have a team ERA of 2.90, 2nd in the Texas League during that time. The Cards' bullpen has been particularly effective during through the first 8 games this 12-game roadtrip, regsitering a 2.15 ERA over 29.1 IP with 3 saves.

**BIG INNINGS, LONGBALL PLAGUING CARDS STAFF:** So far in 2024, home runs and the big inning have hurt the Birds. Springfield has surrendered 36 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs. In those 36 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 140 of the 269 total runs scored by the opposition, 52% of the runs the Birds have allowed this season. Springfield has allowed that production in just 7.9% of their innings pitched. In the other 415.2 IP Springfield has allowed 129 runs, which comes out to 2.79 runs per 9 innings. The Cardinals are 22-4 in games in which they have not allowed a "big inning". The Birds have not allowed a "big inning" in 7 of their last 8 games.

The Cardinals have also allowed 59 homers in 53 games this season, most in Double-A.

**RED-HOT RIVAS:** Riding a 10-game hitting streak and an extended solid 15-game stretch, Cardinals shortstop **Jeremy Rivas** has seen his name rise amongst the top hitters in the Texas League at 3rd among qualified hitters with an average of .322. Over his last 17 games since May 16, **Rivas** is batting .393 (18-for-49), tops in the league among qualified hitters over that time.

**SLAM THE DOOR:** Since the promotion of **Andre Granillo** to Triple-A Memphis on May 21, Cardinals reliever **Matt Svanson** has been a workhorse at the end of Springfield's bullpen. **Svanson** leads the Texas League in appearances with 20 and is 8-for-8 in save opportunities, also tops in the circuit. Since May 21, Svanson is 4-for-4 in save opportunities and has not allowed an earned run over his last 6 appearances and has allowed just one earned run over his last 11 appearances since May 7 and is on a 6.0 inning scoreless streak.

**REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY:** With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 206.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 23 straight games without a home run.


