**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels shut out the Baysox, 4-0. **John Michael Bertrand** started and threw seven perfect innings with four strikeouts on 68 pitches. The Baysox broke the perfect game and the no-hitter in the eighth, but **Wil Jensen** responded by striking out the final five Bowie batters of the game. **Adrián Sugastey** broke the scoreless tie with a three-run homer in the fifth, his first at Double-A. Two batters later, **Dilan Rosario** added a solo homer to extend the lead to 4-0, also his first Double-A home run.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels, after clinching a series win on Saturday, are looking to take five-of-six with this afternoon's series finale against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. This week's series is the won by Richmond this year after splitting the last two against Akron and at Harrisburg. Since they began wearing the red Fauxback jerseys for every Sunday home game in 2022, the Flying Squirrels are 15-9 in their Sunday home games.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have split the last two series, including a six-game series to open their home schedule against Akron from April 9-14 and a six-game road series in Harrisburg from April 16-21. They dropped two-of-three at Somerset to open the season from April 5-7. Last year, the Flying Squirrels reached the postseason for the second consecutive season and the fourth time in franchise history, winning the Southwest Division Second-Half title. They were eliminated by the Erie SeaWolves in the Southwest Division Series. The team went 74-64 overall, the second-best record in the Southwest Division. In the first half, the Flying Squirrels jumped out of the gate in first place for most of the first month of the season, but slid down the stretch and finished 33-36, fourth in the Southwest. In the second half, the Flying Squirrels surged to a 41-28 record, finishing three games ahead of Erie in first place. The Flying Squirrels spent 57 percent (79 games) of the season in first place in the division. Richmond's 74 wins this year were the third-most in franchise history and their .536 winning percentage was the second-best, trailing only 2014 (79-63, .556). After starting this year 1-4, the Flying Squirrels are 10-5 in their last 15 games.

**THE BAYSOX** won five-of-six in last week's series at Prince George's Stadium against the Altoona Curve, including a walk-off single on Friday in the 10th inning by John Rhodes and a walk-off grand slam by Jud Fabian in the ninth on Saturday. The Baysox opened the year taking two-of-three against the Reading Fightin Phils at home before dropping four-of-six in Hartford from April 9-14. Last year, the Baysox went 67-70, fourth in the Southwest Division. They finished last in the first-half Southwest Division standings, going 31-38, before going 36-32 in the second half, third-best in the division. The Bowie roster includes nine of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including C/1B Samuel Basallo (No. 2), OF Dylan Beavers (No. 7), RHP Seth Johnson (No. 10), OF Jud Fabian (No. 12), RHP Trace Bright (No. 16), OF John Rhodes (No. 23), RHP Alex Pham (No. 24), SS Frederick Bencosme (No. 27) and OF/2B Billy Cook (No. 30). Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes nine Bowie players, including Basallo (No. 2), Johnson (No. 10), Beavers (No. 11), Fabian (No. 13), Bright (No. 21), Rhodes (No. 26), Pham (No. 27), Bencosme (No. 28) and RHP Keagan Gillies (No. 30).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Carson Ragsdale** makes his fifth Double-A start and his second against the Baysox. In Tuesday's series opener, he tied his career high with four walks and allowed two runs, both in the fifth, over 4.1 innings. He finished the start with five strikeouts. Among Eastern League pitchers (min. 15 IP) this season, Ragsdale ranks fifth in strikeout percentage (31.4) and fifth in K/9 (11.42). Two starts ago on April 17 at Harrisburg, Ragsdale threw five innings for the first time since 2021. Last season, he made seven starts for High-A Eugene, going 0-1 with a 2.93 ERA. His season ended in May with an oblique injury. At the time of the injury, he was leading the Northwest League in strikeouts (42) and ranked third in innings pitched (27.2). In 2022, he made five appearances in the Arizona Complex League but missed most of the year after having Thoracic Outlet Syndrome surgery in the spring. Ragsdale was selected by the Philadelphia Phillies in the fourth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of the University of South Florida. Before making his professional debut, he was traded to the San Francisco Giants on January 9, 2021 for pitcher Sam Coonrod. **For more on Ragsdale, see page two.**

**FOR BOWIE:** Right-hander Seth Johnson makes his fourth start of the season. He started the first game of the series on Tuesday and allowed five runs, the most in his Orioles organization career and most since 2022, over 2.1 innings in a loss. Johnson was selected with the 40th pick in the 2019 MLB Draft by the Tampa Bay Rays out of Campbell University. Prior to pitching at Campbell, he was a shortstop at Louisburg College. He was traded to the Orioles on August 1, 2022 as part of a three-team deal that sent Jose Siri to Tampa Bay and Trey Mancini to Houston. Following the trade, he underwent Tommy John surgery and returned to the field late last year. In 2023, he made five starts, including one start with Bowie to close his season, and combined to throw 10.1 innings. Johnson is rated by Baseball America and MLB.com as the No. 10 Orioles prospect.

**AWESOME APRIL:** The Flying Squirrels have drawn an average of 7,166 fans this month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history, pending today's attendance. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and ranked third among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance, trailing only Worcester (8,043) and Dayton (7,856).

**SUGASTEY SURGING:** **Adrián Sugastey** is riding a nine-game on-base streak, tied for the second-longest by a Richmond player this season. He also has at least one hit in eight-of-his-last-nine games, hitting .323 (10-for-31) with a double, a homer, eight RBIs, three walks and four runs scored since April 14. On Saturday night, he hit his first Double-A homer, a three-run shot to break a scoreless tie in a 4-0 win over the Baysox. This year, Sugastey is the youngest catcher in the Eastern League. With his debut earlier this month, Sugastey became the second-youngest catcher in team history behind Tommy Joseph (2012) and the 13th-youngest player in franchise history.

**WILL POWER:** **Will Wilson** is batting .387 (12-for-31) over his current eight-game on-base streak with three doubles, five RBIs and five walks. That stretch has raised his season batting average from .069 to .233. In his last four games, Wilson is batting .538 (7-for-13) with two doubles, four RBIs, four walks and two runs scored while posting a .647 on-base percentage and a 1.339 OPS. Dating back to 2021, Wilson has played 154 games for the Flying Squirrels over parts of four seasons.

**HOWELL HEATING UP:** **Carter Howell** has reached base in 10 consecutive games, the longest on-base streak by a Flying Squirrels batter in 2024 so far. In that stretch, he is batting .306 (11-for-36) with four doubles, one triple, four RBIs, six walks and seven runs scored. Last year in his first full professional season, Howell led the Giants system in hits (144) and triples (8) and was second in the organization in batting average (.294) and runs scored (94) between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene.

**PAY YOUR DUES:** In his 11 games for the Flying Squirrels this year, **Damon Dues** is batting .280 (7-for-25) with 10 walks and a .486 on-base percentage, which is first in the Eastern League (min. 30 PA). In his current nine-game on-base streak, Dues has reached base 15 times. Dues signed with the Giants as a non-drafted free agent in 2021 out of Wright State University.

**STRONG ARMS:** The Richmond pitching staff has combined for 193 strikeouts this season, fourth-most in the Eastern League, and also ranked third with a 3.15 ERA. Flying Squirrels starters have combined for a 3.24 ERA this year, which is third-best in the league behind Akron (2.26) and Erie (2.45). The Richmond bullpen has the fourth-lowest ERA (3.06) in the league.

**BIDDING FOR HISTORY:** Richmond starters **Hayden Birdsong** and **John Michael Bertrand** have each worked hitless starts over the last two games. On Friday night, Birdsong threw five innings and the bullpen carried a no-hit bid into the ninth inning. On Saturday, Bertrand worked through seven perfect innings before the Baysox broke up the perfect game and no-hitter in the eighth inning. There has only been one no-hitter pitched by the home team in the 40-year history of The Diamond, which was a seven-inning no-no in 2013 by Jack Snodgrass and Daryl Maday. The last time a Richmond team completed a no-hitter at home was on June 1, 1977 when Richmond Braves pitcher Mickey Mahler no-hit the Toledo Mud Hens at Parker Field. The only other nine-inning no-hitter thrown by the home team in the current location, which dates back to 1954, was thrown by Al Downing and the Richmond Virginians on May 12, 1962 against the Syracuse Chiefs. The only perfect game by a Richmond professional baseball team was thrown in a seven-inning game by Pete Smith for the Richmond Braves in 1992 at Rochester.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 6), **Reggie Crawford** (No. 9), **Grant McCray** (No. 10), **Vaun Brown** (No. 11), **Eric Silva** (No. 22), **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 25), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28) and **José Cruz** (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Crawford is rated as having the best fastball and best slider. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), Crawford (No. 8), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), **Victor Bericoto** (No. 20) and Sugastey (No. 24).
