COUNTDOWN TO 65: Following the series win over the Indianapolis Indians over the weekend to start the current nine-game homestand, Sounds manager Rick Sweet is 10 wins away from passing Buddy Bailey for the third-most wins by a Minor League manager in history.

A KNIGHTS TALE: Entering the start of the series against Charlotte, the Sounds own a 45-25 all-time record against the Knights, including a 25-10 record at home. Since joining the International League in 2021, the Sounds have not dropped a home series against Charlotte. In their first series of the year, the Sounds took five of six on the road, including setting a franchise record seven home run outburst on April 20. Charlotte enters the series tied for the seventh-most home runs allowed by their opponents with 107 but have hit an IL-best 144. The Sounds have hit the 5th-fewest HR in the IL this year with 88 but have allowed the fewest in the league with just 74.

HOT ONE: Drew Avans' solo home run in the bottom of the seventh inning Sunday marked his third round-tripper in his last eight games. He had gone 60-games between home runs when he hit his first this season with Nashville in the series opener on Tuesday, July 8th in Durham. **Avans has a hit in eight of his last nine games played and is hitting .471 (16-for-34) with four doubles, three home runs, and 10 RBI since July 6th.**

DAZ A STREAK: With a hit and RBI in the series finale on Sunday, Daz Cameron extended a pair of streaks. Cameron now owns a six-game hitting streak, tied for the longest active hitting streak by a Nashville player along with Tyler Black who was recalled by Milwaukee prior to Sunday's finale. His RBI also gives him a RBI in six straight games, matching the longest RBI streak by a Nashville player this year after Cameron previously set the record earlier this year from April 15-22. The six-game streak was matched by Black on Saturday night and now again by Cameron for the second time. **Over his last six games, Cameron is hitting .500 (12-for-24) with four homers, a pair of doubles, and 11 RBI.**

YAY-GER: Right-hander Justin Yeager made his Nashville debut with an inning of relief work out of the bullpen. Yeager joined the Sounds prior to the start of the series after making 31 appearances with Double-A Biloxi to start the year. Yeager has the second-most games pitched in the Brewers farm system this season with 32 after Sunday and leads the farm system with his 10 saves. With Yeager, Will Childers (7), and Craig Yoho (6) all on the active roster, the Sounds have the top three leaders in saves in the organization in the bullpen.

WRAP IT UP: The loss in the series finale on Sunday to the Indians brings an end to the season series against Indianapolis. Nashville drops the season series 5-4 and falls to 160-164 all-time against Indianapolis but walks out of the three-game weekend series with the series win after taking the first two games.

PATTEN DOWN THE HATCHES: Right-hander Chad Patrick made his second start this season in a Sounds uniform and 26th all-time. Patrick picked up a no-decision, allowing three runs (two earned) on five hits, four strikeouts, and a walk over 5.0 innings of work. It is Patrick's third straight start, including his time with Milwaukee, that the 26-year-old has given up two or fewer earned runs when tossing 5.0 or more innings. He now holds a 3.27 ERA with 11 strikeouts over his first 11.0 frames back with Nashville.

THIRD INNING MAGIC: Nashville's offense made a statement in the bottom of the third on Saturday night, scoring four runs on four hits against the Pittsburgh Pirates No. 3 prospect, Hunter Barco. All nine Sounds hitters came to the plate, notching two doubles, two singles, and a walk. The last time Nashville put up four or more runs in an inning was July 12 against Durham when the Sounds scored five runs in the third inning. Nashville has scored a total of 68 runs in the third, which is the most out of any inning this year.

WALK THE LINE: Bobby Dalbec worked a career-high four walks against Indianapolis pitching on Saturday night, and it was the second time this season a Nashville hitter walked as many times. Jefferson Quero was the other, working four walks against the Iowa Cubs back on June 21. Dalbec walked a career-high three times in just three games over his career before Saturday, including one this season on July 5 against Memphis.
