LAST OUTING: Rodriguez was efficient in a rain-shortened 4.0-inning start at Gwinnett on July 30. He allowed just one hit and zero earned runs on 47 pitches.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Rodriguez's second career appearance against Gwinnett with his first coming in the series opener.
