Tonight's Game: The Sounds and Stripers play the series finale with Gwinnett up three games to two and are 8-3 overall against Nashville this season. Right-hander Carlos Rodriguez is on the mound for the Sounds and will face off against AJ Smith-Shawver for Gwinnett at Coolray Field.

Carlos Rodriguez: The 22-year-old right-hander makes his 18th appearance (15th start) for Nashville this season. He got the start in the series opener and was excellent in his four innings before the rain cut his outing short. He allowed just two baserunners and was at just 47 pitches. Rodriguez has not been sharp in the majority of his outings since returning to Nashville on June 29. He allowed 12 earned runs in 14.2 innings in his first three appearances back but has tossed 6.0 scoreless over his last two appearances. Rodriguez won the International League Pitcher of the Month in May where he had a 3.03 ERA (29.2 IP/10 ER) in five starts. That led to his first three outings in the big leagues in June but was charged with a loss in all three. The Nicaragua native moved to Miami when he was eight years old and became the 16th Nicaragua-born player to make his MLB debut. He had the honor to be the opening game starter for his country in the 2023 World Baseball Classic and pitched 4.0 innings with one earned run against Puerto Rico. He is ranked as the no. 7 prospect in the organization according to MLB.com, he has racked up the accolades in the minor leagues. He was named the Southern League Pitcher of the Year in 2023 and has been named the Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Year twice.

AJ Smith-Shawver: The 21-year-old makes his 12th start for the Stripers this season. He made one start for the Braves this season on May 23 and didn't allow any runs in 4.1 innings at Chicago-NL. He made six appearances (five starts) for the Braves in 2023. In his last outing on July 27, Smith-Shawver gave up three earned runs with seven strikeouts and was charged with the loss. The Braves drafted him in the seventh round in 2021 from Colleyville Heritage High School in Texas. He is currently ranked as the no. 1 prospect in the Braves organization according to MLB.com. He has quickly moved through the minor leagues but hasn't thrown more than 68.2 innings in a given season. His season-high pitch count was 91 on May 7 and he hasn't completed the fifth inning since May 18. His righty/lefty splits are reversed with a .163 opponent batting average (16-for-98) from lefties compared to .286 (24-for-84) from righties. The long ball has also hurt him with 13 home runs allowed in 44.1 innings.

Big Fly Black: Tyler Black hit a two-run home run last night which was his first since July 2 at Memphis. His streak of 18 games without a home run matched his previous high of 14 games homerless to start the season. Black's 11 home runs trail only Brewer Hicklen (19) for the most on the team.

Running Wild: Chris Roller had his sixth stolen base of the season which was the 25th stolen base by the Sounds in the last 10 games (2nd most in IL Triple-A during the span). With 139 stolen bases this season, Nashville is third in the Internation League, trailing Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (168 stolen bases) and Gwinnett (150 stolen bases). The best month for the team was in June where they went 40-for-48 and are currently 6-for-6 to start August. Brewer Hicklen is currently tied for the IL lead with 34 stolen bases on 38 attempts.

The Starter Merry-Go-Round: With Easton McGee making his first Nashville start on Friday and Jacob Misiorowski last night, the Sounds have had 18 different starters. This puts them tied for the sixth most different starters for a team in the IL. Indianapolis has had the most with 23, while Iowa (21), Columbus (20), Durham (20), and Jacksonville (19) still have more. Charlotte and Syracuse also have 18.

Second Inning Woes: Last night, Misiorowski and Chirino combined to allow seven earned runs in the second inning. This tied the most runs the Sounds have given up in a single inning (April 30 vs. Norfolk). It was also only the second time in 42 career outings that Misiorowski did not record a strikeout in the last two games. It is the most earned runs given up by Chirino in an outing since July 12, 2022, at Tennessee with Biloxi. Chirino has been solid lately, giving up just two earned runs in his previous eight outings before last night. Nashville has allowed nine runs in the second inning. With 66 runs scored against the Sounds in the second inning this season, only the fourth inning (78 runs) and sixth inning (88 runs) have had more runs from the opposition.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 738-634 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,330-2,154 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Rodriguez's second career appearance against Gwinnett with his first coming in the series opener.
