Round Rock and Tacoma will meet in the series finale on Sunday afternoon. Express RHP Zak Kent is scheduled to make the start up against Rainiers RHP Phillips Valdéz. First pitch at Cheney Stadium is slated for 3:35 p.m. CT.

A WINNING RECAP

Round Rock held off Tacoma for a 7-6 win on Saturday. The Rainiers took a 1-0 lead in the first after LF Forrester Wall singled and SS Mason McCoy doubled to bring home Wall. The E-Train scored five in the fourth frame. Singles for 1B Blaine Crim and 3B Davis Wendzel set up RF Sandro Fabian. He doubled to score Crim and tie the game. Wendzel advanced to third and 2B Diosbel Arias grounded out to score him as Round Rock led 2-1. After SS Ryan Dorow walked, CF Elier Hernandez doubled and scored two to increase the lead to 4-1. A single for LF Ezequiel Duran extended the lead to 5-1. In the home-half McCoy earned a bases loaded walk to cut the lead at 5-2. Wendzel hit a solo home run in the sixth and the Express led 6-2. In the home-half, CF Cade Marlowe singled and scored two as Round Rock clinged to a 6-4 lead. E-Train C Meibrys Vilorio answered with a RBI single in the seventh inning as the Express held a 7-4 edge. Rainiers 1B Zach Green tacked a run across in the bottom of the seventh on a ground out and a fielding error allowed another run to score in the eighth making it a 7-6 game. RHP Demarcus Evans shut the door for Round Rock with a scoreless ninth inning.

KENT ON THE BUMP

Round Rock RHP Zak Kent is slated to start on Sunday. In four starts since he was promoted from Double-A Frisco on August 31, the righty is 1-1 with a 0.39 ERA (1 ER/23.0 IP). Kent has allowed only 13 hits in those 23.0 innings.

FINAL ROAD GAME OF THE YEAR

The Express will finish off the 2022 road slate on Sunday in Tacoma. Round Rock held a 17-8 record in road games to start the season, but since June 9, they are just 20-29 away from Dell Diamond.

EVANS IS ON FIRE

Express RHP Demarcus Evans tossed a scoreless ninth inning yesterday to collect his third save of the season. Since July 15, Evans has posted a 0.47 ERA (1 ER/19.0 IP) with only seven walks and 23 strikeouts. The righty held an 8.31 ERA (12 ER/13.0 IP) in his first 13 games of the season. Opponents are hitting .179 against him this year.

WENZDEL LEADS THE WAY

Express 3B Davis Wendzel posted a 3-for-4 night with a home run, RBI, two runs scored and a walk. He earned his 17th home run of the season. His previous season-high in home runs came last year when he hit eight. The righty is second on the team in homers behind C Sam Huff (21). Wendzel has done that while playing in only 82 games.

LEE LEAVES 'EM STRANDED

RHP Chase Lee entered in the fourth inning with the bases loaded and two outs. He struck out CF Cade Marlow to get the Express out of the inning. It's the second time this season Lee has entered a game with the bases juiced and the righty did not allow a run on either occasion. Lee has inherited eight runners this season and only one has scored.

CRIM KEEPS CRUSHING

After a 2-for-5 night with a run scored, 1B Blaine Crim is hitting .317 (13-41) in his first 10 games at the Triple-A level. Yesterday was his third multi-hit game since joining the Express.

80-WIN SEASON ON THE LINE

The Express will look for their seventh 80-win season in franchise history. Their last season with 80 wins came in 2019 when they went 84-56. Before the 2019 season, the last 80-win campaign for the Express came in 2011 when they went 87-57. Round Rock won 80 or more games in four of their first seven seasons from 2000-2006.

Martinez, RHP Seth Nordlin, RHP Fernery Ozuna, C Konner Pionto, LHP Cole Ragans, OF Josh Sale, RHP Tyree Thompson and C Matt Whatley. EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.



Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
