Run, Tony, Run!... Infielder Tony Santa Maria leads the 2026 South Atlantic League with 49 stolen bases, adding two more in Saturday's game against the Greensboro Grasshoppers. The 24-year-old surpassed 2012 Bowling Green Hot Rods player Ryan Brett for third-most steals in a single-season in franchise history. The all-time record belongs to 2013's Andrew Toles, who logged 62 steals.

Resetting the Record Books... The 2026 Hot Rods are up to a franchise-record 272 stolen bases this season. The 272 steals surpasses the 2024 Hot Rods squad, who stole 262 bases. Nine different players have logged 20-plus steal seasons for Bowling Green this season.

Bringing Our Sunday Best... Right-handed pitcher Trevor Harrison takes the mound for the Hot Rods this afternoon. The Tampa Bay Rays' No. 21 prospect, per MLB Pipeline, racked up a career-high 10 strikeouts on Tuesday night against Greensboro. Harrison joins Jacob Kisting and Anderson Brito as the third different Hot Rods starter to log a 10-strikeout performance this season.

Nicandro Keeps Rolling... Nicandro Aybar has reached base in all 18 games with Bowling Green following a promotion from the Charleston RiverDogs on July 19. The 21-year-old has torched Greensboro in particular, hitting 14-for-30 (.467 AVG) with six RBI in eight games.

Iron Man Re-Run... Infielder Narciso Polanco logged an RBI double in Saturday's game. The 21-year-old leads all Hot Rods players with 105 games played during the 2026 season. Polanco led the 2025 Carolina League season with 121 appearances for Charleston, also boasting a league-high 84 runs scored for the RiverDogs.

Go, Go, Gonzalez!... Infielder Ricardo Gonzalez is hitting 4-for-9 (.444 AVG) with two RBI in his first series with the Hot Rods since May 26 to May 31 against the Hudson Valley Renegades. The Venezuelan posted 11 hits in 11 games after returning from the injured list with Single-A Charleston prior to rejoining Bowling Green this week.
