TODAY'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Houston Astros affiliate) get set for the series final in Sugar Land on Sunday. The Express earned a pair of 5-3 victories yesterday. In the first game, the E-Train scored three in the first and two more in the third behind three RBI from Richie Martin to build a 5-0 lead. The Space Cowboys rallied, but Ryan Brasier earned the save to close it out. In Game 2, SS Michael Helman delivered go-ahead RBI single in the eighth while C Jose Herrera and 2B Justin Foscue added two in the ninth. 1B Nick Pratto recorded the final out on the mound with the bases loaded.

THE TRAIN IS RUMBLING

Round Rock has won back-to-back series for the first time and clinched their first road series win yesterday. The Express are 8-3 over their last 11 games. In the three losses, they have scored a combined five runs (1.6 per game), while totaling 56 runs (7.0 per game) in the eight wins. Seven of those eight victories have been decided by three runs or fewer, including six by two runs or fewer. The lone win by more than three was a 12-5 victory in Game 2 of Thursday's doubleheader. Round Rock is 11-3 when scoring five or more runs this year and they are 1-11 when they tally four or fewer.

DOUBLEHEADER MADNESS

The Express finished their third doubleheader in seven days on Saturday. They went 5-1 including sweeps of the Space Cowboys on Thursday and Saturday. Round Rock is 28-8 in doubleheaders since 2021 and 24-6 since 2023 (includes suspended games played as two at a later date). They have not lost a doubleheader since July 5, 2019 at Oklahoma City. The Express are 13-3 in the eight doubleheaders with the Space Cowboys since 2021.

NEW FACES IN NEW PLACES

Yesterday, OF Jonah Bride (718 professional games) was playing left field for the first time in his professional career and caught the final out as 1B Nick Pratto (919 professional games) recorded his first professional save in just his second appearance ever on the mound. 1B Trevor Hauser appeared at first base for the first time since 2023 and INF Richie Martin (860 professional games) batted clean-up for the first time in his career in Game 1 of the doubleheader.

RUNAWAY BRIDE

INF Jonah Bride has a hit in four straight games and six of last seven. He owns an eight-game on-base streak. He is second in the PCL in walks (19), fifth in OBP (.444) and eighth in OPS (.950). He is hitting .304 (17-56) with two strikes.

FOSCUKE KEEPS FEELING IT

INF Justin Foscue owns a four-game on-base streak. He is tied for second in the PCL in doubles (9) and seventh in the PCL in hits (28). In 23 games, Foscue is slashing .298/.385/.457/.842. He is two homers away from 50 with the E-Train.

ON THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - THURSDAY, APRIL 26, 1990

43-year-old Nolan Ryan went out and tossed his 12th career one-hitter, tying Bob Feller for the all-time Major League lead in front of 20,404 fans at Arlington Stadium. The Ryan Express set a Rangers club record for strikeouts in a game with 16, and it was the 15th time he struck out 16 or more in a ballgame. He broke his own record, which he had set the previous season. Texas Rangers won, 1-0, as Jeff Huson drove in Geno Petralli with a soft single in the fifth.

The lone hit came on a bloop single by Ron Kittle in the second inning for the Chicago White Sox. The flare just got over Rafael Palmeiro, who was playing first base. "I tripped," Palmeiro said postgame. "It was a routine play. When I saw the replay, I almost killed myself."

Ryan walked two in the game. At one point, he struck out five consecutive hitters — the last two in the seventh, followed by striking out the side in the eighth. He ended the game by catching Sammy Sosa looking for strike three. Ryan threw 128 pitches. Notable White Sox players with multiple strikeouts included Sosa, Carlton Fisk, and Robin Ventura. The only White Sox hitter who did not strike out was Ozzie Guillén.

"He wanted us to have someone ready in the eighth," Rangers manager Bobby Valentine said with a smile. "He was running low, he said. So he struck out the side. I guess he had a little left."
