**C-Rod:** Clingstones OF Carlos Rodriguez extended his season-opening hit streak to 9G on Wednesday, tied for the longest in the Southern League this season... He leads the league in AVG (.378), and hits (T-1,14) and ranks Top 5 in OBP (3rd, .442).

**The Whole Day Through:** Three players on the Columbus roster are Georgia natives, including LHP Hayden Harris (Augusta), RHP Jonathan Hughes (Decatur), and OF Kevin Kilpatrick Jr. (Stone Mountain).

**Tonight:** The Clingstones continue their season-opening homestand with game three of a six-game series vs. Pensacola ... It is the 3rd of 30 meetings this year (3rd of 18G at Synovus Park).  
**Craig Comes Home:** Craig Kimbrel entered in relief for the eighth inning on Tuesday night (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 2 SO (20 pitches/10 strikes) ... It marked his first pitching appearance in the Atlanta organization 9/28/14 at Philadelphia ... The nine-time Major League All-Star was originally drafted by Atlanta in 2008 and pitched for the Braves from 2010-14, going 15-10 with a 4.33 ERA (46 ER in 289.0 IP) and 186 saves across 294G before being traded to San Diego in 2014.

**As Grand As it Gets:** OF Geraldo Quintero smashed the second grand slam of the series for Columbus in the first inning on Friday, marking the second grand slam of his career and first since 9/7/22 with Rome ... Columbus leads all Double-A clubs in grand slams this season with two.

**Lucas Braun** makes his 2nd start of 2025 and 15th start overall in Double-A on 4/17 vs. Pensacola ... In 3 career starts vs. Pensacola, is 2-0 with a 1.83 5 BB, 21 SO.

**Pipeline:** Ranked the Braves' No. 10 prospect by MLB.com

**2024 Season:**

- **Braves Org:** Split season between High-A Rome and Double-A Mississippi ... Went a combined 9-4 with a 3.26 ERA (52 ER in 143.2 IP), 1.14 WHIP, .228 BAA, and 162 SO in 25G (24 starts).
- **Phil Niekro Award:** 2024 recipient of award presented to top pitcher in Braves' minor league organization ... Past winners include Bryce Elder (2021), Ian Anderson (2019), Julio Teheran (2010- 11), and Craig Kimbrel (2009).
