**TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER:** The Curve play yet another series with the Harrisburg Senators this week, by the end of the week, the Curve will have played 15-of-39 games against the Senators already.

Jackson Kent starts for Harrisburg tonight. He struck out 7 in 5.2 innings and earned the win against the Curve on April 24. Kent was Washington's 4th round pick in 2024 out of the University of Arizona and pitched twice against the Curve last August where they put 8 runs on him in 9.0 innings during the week. native of Hanover Park, Ill, Kent redshirted his freshman campaign in 2022 and broke out in a major way in 2024, earning All-Pac-12 honors. Kent majored in Leadership Learning Innovation with an emphasis in Community Educations and enjoys playing Golf and Fortnite in his free time.

**LET'S GET HEALTHY:** 2023 Curve righty **Jared Jones** joined the Curve on Tuesday, May 12 to continue his major league rehab assignment. Jones, who is returning from an internal brace UCL repair, began a rehab assignment with Bradenton on Wednesday April 29 and then pitched 3.0 IP again on Wednesday May 6 against Omaha with Indianapolis after their game was rained out on Tuesday, May 5. In 6.0 innings he has allowed one run and struck out 7. Baltimore Orioles infielder Jackson Holliday went 1-for-8 against the Curve on rehab last week and outfielder Heston Kjerstad went 1-for-6 in two games. Tuesday will be the 5th straight game for the Curve in which a major league rehab has played.

**SLAMMING BABY:** Altoona has an odd propensity for hitting solo homers early in the season. Entering Tuesday, the Curve have hit 34 homers, 21 of them have been solo. The 34 homers in 32 games for the Curve are T-4th-most in the Eastern League and have come from 13 different players, tied with Richmond for the most in the circuit.

**BRANMAN:** Infielder **Jack Brannigan** has solidified the middle of the Curve order on April 18 since returning from the Injured List, he has 6 multi-hit games and recorded 10 extra base hits in 21 games.

**'CURT SCHILLING?':** Right-hander **Khristian Curtis** matched his career-high with 10 strikeouts over 5.0 innings on Sunday, April 26. It was the 42nd time in franchise history that a Curve pitcher has punched out 10 hitters in a game and the first in 5.0 innings or fewer since **Kyle Nicolas** struck out 10 batters in 5.0 innings on May 2, 2023 at Richmond. Curtis is T-2nd among Eastern League hurlers with 41 strikeouts, T-5th among Double-A arms.

**LONNIE GANG:** Since joining the Curve on May 1, outfielder **Lonnie White Jr.** has reached base in 7-of-8 games and recorded 3 2B, 1 HR and 3 RBI. He had two hits in back-to-back games on May 6 and 7 at Chesapeake and reached base safely in each of Altoona's games at Prince George's Stadium last week.

**SEE YOU ON THE BASEPATHS:** Infielder **Keiner Delgado** hit .325 (13-for-40) with 4 2B, 2 HR, 12 RBI and a 1.035 OPS during his 12-game on-base streak which ended on May 10. **Duce Gourson**, who had a 12-game on-base streak end on Friday at Chesapeake, held a .444 on-base percentage April 19-May 8.

**CY MAN:** Lefty **Cy Nielson** has become one of Altoona's most reliable bullpen arms early in the season. Nielson is unscored upon in 10-of-11 outings this year and thrown 12.1 consecutive scoreless frames dating back to April 16. In that time he's allowed just 9 hits, 5 walks and struck out 13 across seven outings.

**WHERE THERE'S A WILL, THERE'S A WAY:** Outfielder **Will Taylor** has reached base safely in 16-of-17 games (.314) with 4 2B, 3 HR, 11 RBI and 18 BB (.500 OBP) since April 19. Taylor ranks 1st in the Eastern League in on-base percentage (.500) and 6th in OPS (1.069) in that time. He recorded an RBI in six consecutive games from April 21 to April 30, which is tied for the longest streak this season in the Eastern League.

## CURVE CUTS

Jared Keith Jones... His father, Keith, was drafted by Arizona in 1997 and spent two seasons in their system as an infielder... Selected by the Pirates 13 picks after Carmen Mlodzinski in the 2020 MLB Draft and signed with the Pirates for a bonus of \$2,200,000... Played outfield and pitched in high school and was viewed by scouts as one of the best athletes in the high school class of the 2020 draft... Was committed to play collegiately at the University of Texas... Added the curveball to his pitch mix during the COVID-19 shutdown in the spring and summer of 2020... In his final full high school season in 2019 was named the Whittier Daily News' Player of the Year after leading his team to the CIF-SS Division Semifinals with a 7-1 record and a 0.77 ERA, also hit .457 at the plate... Three times during his amateur career was a member of USA Baseball's Junior National Teams... Was Named the 2019 Perfect Game/Rawlings National High School Two-Way Player of the Year... Became close friends with MLB Pitcher/Outfielder Michael Lorenzen through La Mirada High School's Fellowship for Christian Athletes Program...

In 2023... Earned Altoona's Pitcher of the Year Award after holding his opponent to 2 runs or fewer in each of his 10 starts with the Curve to begin the season... Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Struck out 6 in 4.2 in his Double-A Debut on April 8 vs. New Hampshire... Matched his career-high with 4 BB on 4/14 @ Erie... Placed on 7-day IL on 4/23 (retro 4/21) with lower back spasms, activated on 5/10 for 11 a.m. start vs. Akron... Sturck out a season-high 7 batters in 4.0 innings on 5/16 at Bowie... Carried a no-hit bid into the 7th inning on 6/8 @ RIC... Promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis on June 15...

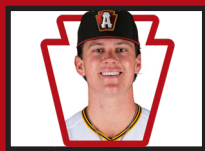
