- Dunedin opened the second half with a 6-5, 10-inning loss to Daytona on Friday night at TD Ballpark.
- The game's deciding run came via a 10th inning balk from JJ Sanchez, which allowed Sammy Stafura to score ahead of a two-out, two-strike pitch.
- Blue Jays starter Fernando Perez fired an immaculate inning in the fifth, part of a seven-strikeout performance. However, Perez surrendered 4 earned runs in 5.1 innings, all on home runs: a two-run shot from Yerlin Confidan in the third, and a 3-run shot from Connor Burns in the sixth
- Trailing 5-4 in the eighth, Dunedin tied the game on a chaotic infield single from Tucker Toman that induced a throwing error from Trey Faltine, allowing Manuel Beltre to score from first base.

EXTRA TOUGH

Last night's 10-inning loss for the Jays marks their first extra innings loss at TD Ballpark this season. Prior to the defeat, Dunedin had won four of its last five extra inning contests, including Thursday's 11-inning win, via Robert Robertis' walk-off home run.

INCREDIBLY IMMACULATE

Fernando Perez delivered an immaculate fifth inning last night, marking the second immaculate inning in as many nights at TD Ballpark, after Adam Serwinowski pulled it off in the first inning on Thursday. The immaculate innings are the first in the Florida State League in nearly two years, as Bradenton's Carlos Jimenez was the last to do, on July 9, 2022. It's the first immaculate inning on record for the Dunedin Blue Jays since pitch-by-pitch data collection records for MiLB began in 2016.

UNBLEMISHED BULLPEN

Dunedin's bullpen has been outstanding through four games of the series with Daytona, working 20.2 innings without allowing an earned run. Last night's deciding run was unearned, as Sammy Stafura was the placed runner in the 10th. Across the last six games, the bullpen has posted a 1.57 ERA in 34.1 innings.

SNAPPED OUT OF IT

After being held to three or fewer runs in five straight games, the Blue Jays tallied five runs on 10 hits to snap out of their offensive funk. However, Dunedin struggled to capitalize with runners in scoring position, going 2-11 with RISP, leaving nine men on base. The loss marks the sixth game this season the Jays have tallied 10 hits or more and still lost (12-6).

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Friday's 6-5 defeat marked Dunedin's 24th one-run game this season - the second-most in the FSL, behind Bradenton's 26. The Jays are 11-13 in those contests. 46 of the Blue Jays 67 games this season (68%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 23-23 record in those games.

A CAVEMAN COULD DO IT

Nolan Perry is set to make his eighth start with the Blue Jays this evening. Perry was drafted out of Carlsbad HS (NM) in 2022 after winning New Mexico's Gatorade Player of the Year award and a state championship. Carlsbad's team mascot is the Cavemen.

SERIES SUCCESS

With a win tonight, the Blue Jays would clinch six straight sets with a split or better. Across the last five series, Dunedin has earned three splits and two series wins. Dunedin has split three of its last four series.

HOPE SPRINGS ETERNAL IN THE SUMMER

Dunedin opened the second half with a 10th inning loss Friday. The D-Jays' 34-32 mark in the first half was the team's best first half record since 2019 (41-24). Last season, Dunedin finished in last place in the FSL West in the second half with a 30-36 record. In 2022, Dunedin won the second-half title with a 38-25 record after going 28-38 in the first half.

REHAB CITY, USA

With Ricky Tiedemann's start Thursday and Joey Votto's Wednesday, Dunedin has hosted 12 MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. Tuesday, infielder Cade Doughty re-joined the Jays' roster for his second rehab stint of the season and homered in his first at-bat. Other notable rehabs include Alek Manoah, Damiano Palmegiani (AAA), and Riley Tirotta (AAA).

DEFENDING HOME TURF

Dunedin has lost just one series at home this season: April 16-21 vs Clearwater. In five sets at TD Ballpark, the Jays have split three times and won twice.
