**All About the Curve:** The Somerset Patriots take on the Altoona Curve at Peoples Natural Gas Field this week. The two teams met in Bridgewater and split a six-game series. Somerset took the first game of the series last night with nine runs on 16 hits.

**Arms Race:** Somerset's pitching staff owns the lowest ERA (3.29) and BAA (.209), most shutout wins (15), third-lowest WHIP (1.16) and fourth-most strikeouts (987) in all of MiLB.

**Peraza Party:** Shorstop Oswald Peraza returned to the team last night after spending the last week as a member of the New York Yankees taxi squad. The shortstop went 4-for-6 with a homer to leadoff the game, three RBI and finished a triple shy of the cycle. It marked just the third time this season that a Patriot collected four hits in a game (Beltre, Castillo). Peraza is listed as the No. 3 prospect by Baseball America and No. 4 prospect by Baseball America in the Yankees system.

**Yer a Wizard, Hayden:** RHP Hayden Wesneski tossed six shutout innings in last night's win. It marked the second-straight scoreless performance for Wesneski. The righty has now thrown 17-straight scoreless frames, lowering his Double-A ERA from 6.35 to 4.78. In his previous outing, Wesneski recorded the first complete-game shutout thrown by a Patriots this season in a 7-inning win over the Portland Sea Dogs. Wesneski is 3-0 with a 0.50 ERA (1 ER over 18.0 IP) with 19 strikeouts and a .169 BAA across three August starts.

Bombs For Days: INF Dermis Garcia hit his 24th home run of the season Sunday night. Garcia leads the league and Yankees organization in homers and is tied for third in all of the minors. Last week, Garcia went 7-for-19 (.368) with two home runs, two doubles and a .478 on-base percentage against Portland. He has a hit in five-straight games and has reached base safely in 12 of his 14 games in August. Garcia owns a .292 average with a .404 OBP in August and now has hit overall batting average (.198) at its highest point since June 16th.

**Post Milone:** Thomas Milone finished 2-for-4 last night to extend his on-base streak to a team-high 33 games. Milone's streak dates back to May 11th and spans three tours in Somerset sandwhiched around two separate stops with Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He has now reached base safely in 37 of the 38 games in which he's played with Somerset this season.

On the Beltway: Michael Beltre has hit safely in six-straight games and has reached base safely in 11 of his 12 games so far in August. He's batting .391 (9-for-23) with a home run, four RBI, four runs and three stolen bases in his last six games. Beltre currently leads the Double-A Northeast League in triples (6) and stolen bases (27).

Cabrera Calibrating: Oswaldo Cabrera went 2-for-6 with three RBI last night after having failed to reach base in his last two games since his 31-game on-base streak closed. It marked Cabrera's first multi-RBI game since July 29th. The switch-hitting infielder is currently tied for fourth in the league in RBI (54). Additionally, Cabrera ranks second in the league in doubles (25) and extra-base hits (40), fourth in total bases (152) and sixth in hits (83).
