OFFENSE RUNS DRY IN GAME FIVE LOSS:

The Frisco RoughRiders had their three-game winning streak snapped with a 4-1 loss to the San Antonio Mission on Saturday night from Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium. As they had in the last three games, the Riders (4-4) found the scoreboard first in the first inning. Luisangel Acuña started off the scoring with a Little League home run to left-center field. After San Antonio (3-5) centerfielder Daniel Johnson slid to try and knock the ball down and kicked it to the warning track, left fielder Jorge Oña committed an error trying to field the ball there, allowing Acuña to circle the bases and make it 1-0 Frisco. In the bottom of the second, the Missions answered back with a two-run double from Luis Avilas Jr. to take the lead off of Frisco starter **Tekoah Roby** (0-1), who went six innings, allowing four runs on eight hits while striking out seven and not walking a batter. The Missions added on in the bottom of the sixth on an RBI single from Chandler Seagle and an RBI double from Brantly Bell to put the game to bed. Out of the bullpen, Grant Anderson and Marc Church both fired scoreless innings for the RoughRiders.

RISP-ECT THIS:

In Saturday's 4-1 loss, the Riders went 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position. Through eight games, Frisco is fifth in the 10-team Texas League, batting .280 with RISP. Overall, the RoughRiders are hitting .280/.404/.413/.817 in those situations and all in all, they are batting just .232/.342/.342/.684 as a team. With two outs and runners in scoring position, Frisco is slashing .278/.395/.472/.867. As a team, through eight games, Frisco only has 17 extra base hits, which is tied for second-to-last in the Texas League, though they are first with four triples.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The RoughRiders have just committed two errors through six games, but both of those defensive miscues have come from pitchers **Jack Leiter** and **Theo McDowell**, meaning the Riders fielders have not committed an error this season. While there are four teams with two errors in Minor League Baseball, the RoughRiders are the only team in the minors with out a position player error at this point in the season. The team's .993 fielding percentage is tied for first in Minor League Baseball (Clearwater, .993).

MISSION POSSIBLE:

With a chance at another series victory today in San Antonio, the Riders dominated the Padres affiliate over their last three seasons. Last season, they went 15-9 against San Antonio and 10-2 at Nelson Wolff Stadium, but dating back to 2021, Frisco is 31-16 against the Padres affiliate. The Riders also swept the Missions in the 2022 South Division Champioship Series, winning one game at home and one in San Antonio. Dating back to mid-June of 2018, the Riders are 43-24 against San Antonio in their last 67 regular season

I LIKE BIG WINS AND I CANNOT LIE:

The RoughRiders four wins this season have come by eight, six, seven and seven runs, respectively, while their four losses have come by a combined 11 runs. That gives Frisco a +17 run differential through seven games, which is the second best in the Texas League despite being one game back of Amarillo (5-3 record, +/- 0 run differential). The only team with a +20 run differential in the league is Tulsa, which is 6-2 (+27).

EVAN ALMIGHTY:

Outfielder Evan Carter has reached safely in seven of the eight games this season, batting .364 (12-for-38)/.447/.576/1.023 with a double, two home runs, five walks, 12 RBIs and two stolen bases. Carter is 10th in the Texas League in average (.364), tied for second in hits (12), tied for second in home runs (two), tied for second in RBIs (12) and 12th in OPS (1.023). On Wednesday, Carter crushed a three-run home run and a solo homer for his second two-home run game of his Minor League career. The No. 3 prospect in the Rangers system won a MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove in 2022. The reigning Tom Greive Rangers Minor League Player of the Year, Carter joined the RoughRiders for the last week of the 2022 season and the playoffs.

Carter is also the second-youngest player in the Texas League this season.

ABOUT RYAN

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a $1.28\,\mathrm{ERA}$ over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April $\,$ 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
