## FRISCO SCORES EARLY, HANGS ON LATE AGAINST AMARILLO IN SERIES OPENER:

The Frisco RoughRiders used a steady offensive attack to drop the Amarillo Sod Poodles 8-3 on Friday night from HODGETOWN. Frisco (7-6, 38-43) struck first in the second inning with an RBI fielder's choice from **Josh Hatcher**, starting his strong night. In the third, they added on with a **Thomas Saggese** RBI single and another RBI fielder's choice, this one from **Kellen Strahm**, to make it 3-0. After a solo homer from Amarillo's (8-5, 42-40) Seth Beer in the fourth, Frisco added with a Hatcher RBI single to push the lead to 4-1. Leading 4-2 in the fifth, Saggese ripped a two-run single to left and the Frisco lead pushed to 6-2. Hatcher put the finishing touches on the offense with a two-run home run in the ninth. He drove in four and now has 16 RBIs in his 13 games with Frisco. Saggese extended his hitting streak to 10 games while **Luisangel Acuña** doubled to set his hitting streak at 14 games. On the mound, **Ryan Garcia** started and went four innings, allowing just one run for Frisco before giving way to **Aidan Anderson**. **Grant Wolfram** (5-0) then entered and allowed just one run over two innings while striking out four. **Nick Starr** and **Antoine Kelly** both fired shutout innings from the bullpen as well. In the defeat, Luke Albright (5-3) started and went 4.1 innings for Amarillo.

## HATCH IS THE RIGHT MATCH:

Since coming to Frisco in June, **Josh Hatcher** has been a run-producing machine. In his 13 games, he has driven in 16 runs and in July, Hatcher is hitting .333/.355/.556/.911 with two homers and 12 RBIs in seven games.

## WELCOME BACK, CARTER:

**Evan Carter** has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last 18 games since his return, he has seven multi-hit games, batting .366 (26-for-71)/.432/.606/1.038 with three doubles, one triple, four home runs, 14 RBIs and 15 runs scored. Carter is now eighth in the Texas League in batting average (.303) and seventh in OBP (.412).

## SPEAS, STEPHAN HONORED FOR JUNE:

The Texas Rangers announced on Thursday that **Alex Speas** had been named the Rangers Minor League Relief Pitcher of the Month for June as part of four awards for Rangers minor league players. Speas, who made eight appearances in June for the Frisco RoughRiders before getting called up to Round Rock (AAA) on June 30, was named the Relief Pitcher of the Month for the second consecutive time. The 25-year-old Speas did not allow an earned run in June in nine appearances, covering 14 innings. **Josh Stephan** won Starting Pitcher of the Month for posting a 2.16 ERA across 25 innings, all with High-A Hickory. Stephan was promoted to Frisco on July 4th to make his Double-A debut.

## THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

**Thomas Saggese** has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. Over his last 30 games, he is hitting .381/.464/.703/1.167 with nine home runs and 29 RBIs. Saggese is currently on an 10-game hitting streak, batting .421 (16-for-37) during that stretch. The California native is currently fourth in the league in batting average (.318), third in RBIs (64), seventh in slugging percentage (.522), second in hits (101), third in doubles (20) and second in total bases (166).

## AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

**Thomas Saggese** has been fantastic on first pitches this season, first in the Texas League (min. 11 at-bats) with a .586 average (17-for-29) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.544 OPS on the first pitch, which is first in the league as well. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .463 (25-for-54) on the initial offering while his 25 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are second in the minors.

## SPEED KILLS:

**Luisangel Acuña** leads the league in steals with 36 and is on pace for a career-best 61 swipes. The RoughRiders are fifth in Texas League steals with 110 bases in 132 attempts (83 percent). The RoughRiders' stolen base production lately has not been as high as it was earlier in the season. Frisco has just stolen seven bases in 10 July games, which is eighth in the 10-team Texas League. Of those seven steals, four are from Acuña and three are from three different players (**Evan Carter**, **Josh Hatcher** and **Thomas Saggese**).

## ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

## ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .405/.444/.500/.944 in July. Currently on an 14-game hitting streak, he is hitting .400/.438/.500/.938 during this stretch, including a four-hit game in game one of the doubleheader last Friday. He is fifth in the Texas League in batting average (.314), third in hits (99), third in doubles (20), second in runs (58) and first in steals (36). When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (118).

### ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 8-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

### 2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

### 2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

### 2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
