Tonight: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play the first in a six-game series at the first half East Division champion Dayton Dragons, High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds. The two clubs met up nine times in April/early May in Michigan's state capital, with the Lugnuts winning five of the nine games.

Last Game, Sunday: Lugnuts 8, Loons 7 (10 innings). The Nuts ended a franchise record 11-game losing streak behind three crucial swings: a **Myles Naylor** grand slam in the 6th inning that erased a 4-0 deficit, a **Gunner Gouldsmith** three-run homer in the 8th that wiped away a 7-4 deficit, and a Naylor RBI fielder's choice to short that brought in pinch-runner **Pedro Pineda** with the game-winning run in the bottom of the 10th inning, supplying the Lugnuts' fifth walk-off win of the year and first victory since June 12.

Starting Matchup: 20-year-old **Steven Echavarria** (*MLB Pipeline's No. 15 A's prospect*), the youngest Lugnut and 2026 Opening Day starter, makes his third start of the year and eighth career start vs. Dayton. The Dragons counter with **Ty Floyd** (*the 38th pick in the 2023 Draft*), making his first start against an A's affiliate. The duo rematches on Sunday.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play Dayton through Sunday, take a day off, and then continue this two-week Ohio road trip to Lake County. The next home game: 19 days away.

LUG-NOTES

JKG to MLB: 2024-2025 Lugnut **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** made his MLB debut last night, going 3-for-4 with two singles and a double (including an RBI single in his first at-bat) as the Athletics lost to the Dodgers, 9-4. Kuroda-Grauer becomes the 207th all-time Lugnut to reach the Majors and the seventh this season (**Daniel Susac**, **Eduardo Rivera**, **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**, **Kade Morris**, **Junior Pérez**). There are nine active Lugnuts on the Athletics: **Bolte**, **Jump**, **Kuroda-Grauer**, **Morris**, **Lawrence Butler**, **Hogan Harris**, **Max Muncy**, **Jack Perkins** and **Colby Thomas**.

Roster Movement: In an exchange of catchers, Lansing's duo of **Carlos Franco** and **Ben Newton** were transferred to Single-A Stockton yesterday, replaced by the Ports' pair of **Bryan Arendt** and **Logan Sauve**. Interestingly, both Arendt (UNC-Wilmington / **Zane Taylor**) and Sauve (West Virginia / **Griffin Kirm**) were drafted last year alongside a pitching teammate, and now they're all teammates with Lansing.

Be Back Soon: Right-hander **Tzu-Chen Sha** has returned to Taiwan to fulfill a military obligation and is expected to rejoin the Lugnuts next week in Lake County.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of A's prospects: No. 15 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 17 (**Zane Taylor**), No. 22 (**Nate Nankil**) and No. 29 (**Nathan Dettmer**). Baseball America's re-ranking of A's prospects placed Echavarria at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and **Nathan Dettmer** at No. 21.

Pitcher's Best Friend: These are the top two teams in the Midwest League at turning double plays, with the Lugnuts' total of 80 double plays in 73 games leading all of High-A, while the Dragons (72 double plays) have coaxed a league-leading 25 GiDPs in June alone.

Lugnut League Leaders:

- **Zane Taylor** is 2nd in the MWL in innings (66 2/3), 3rd in ERA (3.24), 3rd in WHIP (1.22) and 3rd in lowest opponent avg. (.233).
- **Samuel Dutton** leads the league in innings (67 1/3) and is 7th in ERA (3.88) and 9th in WHIP (1.44).
- **Steven Echavarria** is 5th in lowest average (.241), 9th in innings (60 2/3) and 10th in WHIP (1.45).

No Difficulty in Double-A: 2026 Lugnuts standout **Devin Taylor** has acclimated to the Texas League just fine, thank you, slashing .425 / .489 / .750 in his last 10 games for the Midland RockHounds, with 17 hits (including three home runs) and five walks.

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went on to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

- **Midwest League Player of the Week, April 7-12:** C/3B **Davis Diaz** batted .611 (11-for-19) while reaching base 16 times and scoring nine runs in five games at Fort Wayne. Diaz is still dominating, batting .342 / .444 / .579 in 12 games for Class-AA Midland.
- **Midwest League Pitcher of the Week, June 9-14:** Southpaw **Ryan Magdic** struck out nine Cedar Rapids Kernels in seven innings of three-hit, one-run ball on 77 pitches. Magdic is 1-0 with a 2.31 ERA in 11 2/3 innings in Double-A, striking out 11 while walking just three.

JUNE 30 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2016: Lugnuts pitchers Ángel Perdomo and Francisco Rios were selected to represent the Toronto Blue Jays in the MLB Futures Game on July 10 in San Diego.

2019: Otto Lopez went 1-for-4 with a single to extend his on-base streak to 30 games (it would end the next day) and Sean Wymer whiffed seven in 5 2/3 innings in a 3-0 loss to Alan Strong and Bowling Green at Cooley Law School Stadium.

2022: Jared McDonald homered in each of his first three at-bats – a two-run homer in the 1st inning, a three-run homer in the 3rd inning and a two-run homer in the 5th inning – and finished 3-for-4 with a walk and a groundout, tying the Lugnuts' single game HR record and finishing one RBI short of tying the single game RBI record in a 10-3 victory at Lake County..

2026 Campaign: 2026 Lugnuts Opening Day starter... limited opposition to .195 avg. with 3.86 ERA in April, but allowed .260 avg. with 7.23 ERA in May, and .273 avg. with 8.20 ERA in June... allowed one home run in first 30 1/3 innings, but has given up nine homers in next 30 1/3 innings... .218 avg. with bases empty, .269 with runners on... has allowed 16 of 17 stolen base attempts... opponents are batting .321 in the 1st inning, .136 in the 2nd, .160 in the 3rd, .364 in the 4th.

Gatorade, Not Gator: Echavarria posted a 0.28 ERA with 80 strikeouts in 50 innings as a senior at Millburn High School, allowing only one extra-base hit the whole season. He was named New Jersey's 2022-2023 Gatorade High School Baseball Player of the Year and the top prep prospect in the state. Initially committed to Oregon, he changed his commitment to the University of Florida as his senior year dawned, but then signed with the A's for \$3 million to head into professional baseball – the only New Jersey high schooler taken in the 2023 MLB Draft.

Pro Ball: After signing, Echavarria debuted in instructional league ball in 2023. He was slated to pitch in the 2024 Spring Breakout for the A's against the Giants, but the game was canceled due to rain. On May 2, 2024, Game 22 of the Stockton Ports' season, he made his official professional debut, starting against Visalia and working three scoreless innings before allowing two unearned run in the fourth... posted 9.00 ERA in six May starts (20 R/18 ER in 18 IP)... limited opposition to one run or nine in nine of his final 13 starts of the year, including stretch from June 25-August 4 with just 2 ER allowed in 25 2/3 IP... best inning was the fourth inning: 3-for-26, .115 avg. against... base-stealers were successful in 11 of 13 attempts.
