NOTES AND NUGGETS

JAC ATTACK

Sunday night, it was announced that top Royals prospect Jac Caglianone was to be promoted from Double-A Northwest Arkansas to Triple-A Omaha ... today will be his Triple-A debut, with the Storm Chasers.

✦ Caglianone was selected by the Royals with the 6th overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft, announced as a two-way player, though he has yet to pitch professionally.
✦ In 38 games in Double-A, "Cags" hit .322 (49-for-152), with 8 doubles, 9 homers, 43 RBI and a .947 OPS ... he ranked 1st in the Texas League in RBI, hits (49), total bases (84) and runs scored (32), tied 2nd in extra-base hits (17), 3rd in homers and average, 4th in slugging percentage (.535) and OPS.

✦ Caglianone leads Minor League Baseball with 43 RBI, while his 84 total bases rank 10th in the Minors.

✦ In college, at the University of Florida, Jac exclusively played first base and pitched ... last year with High-A Quad Cities, he only played first base and while he largely played first with NW Arkansas this year, he did make 7 appearances in the outfield, 1 in left field and 6 in right field.

I LEFT MY SOUL IN THE PACIFIC COAST LEAGUE

This week, the Storm Chasers travel west to play the Salt Lake Bees, Omaha's first regular season meeting with a Pacific Coast League club since joining the International League ... this is Omaha's first visit to Salt Lake City since 2017.

✦ Omaha previously played in the Pacific Coast League from 1998 to 2020, playing 119 games against the Triple-A Salt Lake franchise in that window ... from 2003 to 2019, the two clubs played one series a season, traditionally alternating sites between Omaha and Salt Lake City ... however, the Bees made back-to-back trips to Werner Park in 2018 and 2019.

✦ Omaha's last trip to Salt Lake City was May 6 to 9, 2017, with the Bees taking 3 of 4 games from the Storm Chasers at Smith's Ballpark ... Omaha's only win came in the 2nd game of the series, on May 7, behind 7.0 innings of 1-run ball from Christian Binford.

✦ Between 2021 and 2024, teams from the International and Pacific Coast Leagues did not play each other, except for in the Triple-A National Championship game ... the last time Omaha traveled West was for the 2024 Triple-A National Championship game on September 28 in Las Vegas, as the Storm Chasers lost to the Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Astros affiliate), by a score of 13-6.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

✦ Omaha has successfully stolen 65 bases this year, and only been caught 9 times ... 65-for-74 in steal attempts is a 87.8% success rate, the highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 3rd-best among full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 93.8%, 30-for-32).

✦ No Storm Chaser baserunner has been caught stealing more than once ... John Rave leads the team with 15 steals, while Nick Loftin is 2nd with 10 stolen bases.

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits near the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 430 strikeouts this season ... that is 2nd in the league and 3rd at the Triple-A level, 14 strikeouts behind the top Triple-A team (Iowa, 444).

✦ Over 377.0 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.27 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

✦ With 430 strikeouts through 43 games, an average of 10.0 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,490 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

LET'S RAVE

Outfielder John Rave has been a consistent presence at the top of the Omaha all season long, contributing in all facets of the game.

✦ John enters today on a career-best 14-game hitting streak ... the 3rd-longest active streak in the league, Rave has hit .440 (22-for-50) with a 1.300 OPS since May 3 ... his previous career-best hitting streak was 10 games from June 11-25, 2023, from his final game in Double-A to his first 9 games with Omaha that year, a stretch where he hit .417 (15-for-36) with a 1.238 OPS.

✦ Rave has also scored a run in all 14 games of his hitting streak, with 21 runs scored in the stretch since May 3, which ties a career-best ... Rave has the modern Omaha scoring streak record, when he scored a run in 14 straight games, from June 17 to July 2, 2023.

✦ Rave is 2nd in the Minors in run scored (40) ... he leads the IL in triples (4), is tied 4th in steals (15), 5th in total bases (79) and tied 8th in extra-base hits (17) ... additionally, he leads Omaha in hits (44) and is tied 1st on the team in homers (7).

- ✓ Hatch is making his **9th start with Omaha** this season ... made Omaha's 2025 Breaking Roster, after signing a Minor League deal with the Royals in February ... spent 2024 in Japan with the Hiroshima Toyo Carp.
- ✓ Playing his 9th professional season this year ... Royals are Hatch's 4th MLB organization, has previously spent time with the Cubs, Blue Jays, Pirates and in Japan ... has appeared in 39 Major League games from 2020 to 2023.
- ✓ Hatch was a starting pitcher in Japan last season ... he began his professional career as a starter, his first 80 games were starts, from 2017 into 2020 ... from his MLB debut on July 26, 2020 through 2023, just 44 of his 112 appearances were starts, with 33 total relief appearances in his 39 MLB games.
- ✓ Goes by his middle name, Thomas, to honor his grandfather whom he was named after.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are 58 results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. 34 of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
