#### **GRAY HOMERS, SHRIMP OUTLAST BULLS 4-3**

Griffin Conine drove in two and Tristan Gray homered for the third game in a row on Thursday in Jacksonville's 4-3 win. The Jumbo Shrimp earned a wire-to-wire victory. Marty Costes led off with a single and scored on a double from Griffin Conine. Dane Myers singled and two batters later, Troy Johnston grounded out but Conine scored to give Jacksonville a 2-0 lead. The Jumbo Shrimp added a run in the fourth with an RBI base hit from Conine. Durham added a run in the bottom of the fourth before Tristan Gray (3) homered in the fifth to make it 4-1. Durham added two more runs in the sixth but were blanked from that point on.

#### SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through six games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 19 runs, in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 10-for-60 (.167/.282/.250/.532, ranking 29th, 29th, 29th, 29th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position, stranding a total of 47 runners. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

#### **GRAY'S ANATOMY**

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Tristan Gray**, who played 331 games with the Durham Bulls from 2021-23, has been on a tear since returning to the Bull City. The Missouri City, Texas native has reached base five times in each of his three contests in Durham, going a combined 6-for-12 with a double, three home runs, five RBIs, walk and three runs scored. During his career with the Bulls, Gray batted .233/.300/.474/.774 with 59 doubles, five triples, 71 home runs, 220 RBIs and 179 runs scored.

#### THE CHICKS DIG IT

It took into the club's second series of the year to hit their first home run, but Jacksonville has launched five bombs through three games in Durham. In 2023, the Jumbo Shrimp finished in the bottom of the IL in home runs (T-15, 160). Historically, Jacksonville has clobbered more home runs on the road since rejoining Triple-A prior to the 2021 campaign (82 vs 78 in '23, 109 vs 74 in '22 and 81 vs 55 in '21).

#### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Outside of a 10-0 loss to Gwinnett on Sunday, all five of Jacksonville's contests in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have gone 3-2 in those affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

#### **RAGING BULL**

Dating back to last season, 12 of the last 15 games between Jacksonville and Durham have been decided by three runs or fewer. The clubs have split these matchups decided by razor-thin margins, with each team winning six of those 12 closely-decided contests. From when the Jumbo Shrimp and Bulls first began playing each other in 2021 until this current 15-game stretch began on May 31, 2023, 33 of the 66 matchups between the clubs were decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville went 15-18 (.455) against Durham in those affairs.

#### TROY MEETS WORLD

Jumbo Shrimp first baseman **Troy Johnston** is coming off an extraordinary season that saw him earn Marlins Minor League Player of the Year. Johnston finished the season leading all of Minor League Baseball in RBIs (116) while ranking fourth in extra-base hits (67), ninth in hits (157), tied for 10th in runs (102), 13th in OPS (.948), tied for 15th in doubles (36) and 17th in slugging percentage (.549). Over 134 games between Jacksonville and Double-Pensacola, Johnston slashed .307/.399/.549/.948 with 26 home runs and 24 stolen bases, becoming the first Marlins minor leaguer since 2008 to post a season with at least 20 homers and 20 steals.

#### SHRIMP BITES

Of the 12 innings Jacksonville in which has scored in this season, six have been multi-run frames... Two Miami Marlins will make rehab starts in the next three days for the Jumbo Shrimp. Edward Cabrera's second rehab start comes tonight, with Braxton Garrett beginning a rehab assignment by starting Sunday in the Bull City... Jacksonville's nine stolen bases rank in a tie for second in the IL.

#### **ABOUT EDWARD**

-Cabrera made his major league debut for the Marlins on August 25, 2021 against the Washington Nationals from loanDepot park. He yielded three runs on four hits in 6.1 innings

-Once ranked as the No. 2 prospect in the Marlins' organization by MLB.com, Cabrera signed with Miami for \$100,000 on July 2, 2015 as an international free agent. He was also a consensus Top-100 prospect in 2022, ranked 33rd by Keith Law of *The Athletic*, 34th by *MLB Pipeline* and No. 69 by both *Baseball Prospectus* and *Baseball America*.

-The Marlins were fairly aggressive with Cabrera in the minor leagues, starting his professional career in the Gulf Coast League. After just 82.2 innings in 24 games, including 13 starts, with the GCL Marlins and Short Season Class A Batavia, Cabrera found himself in full season ball with Low-A Greensboro in 2018 at the age of 19.

#### 2024 SEASON

-Assisgned to Jacksonville on March 30 on a rehab assignment.

#### **2023 SEASON**

-Posted a 2.91 ERA in seven home MLB starts, going 5-0 while going 0-6 in 10 road starts with a 6.28 ERA.

-Named the International League Pitcher of the Week for the week of August 7-13 after tossing 6.0 shutout innings of one-hit ball with 10 strikeouts on August 12 against Norfolk.

#### 2022 SEASON

-In 14 starts with Miami, posted a 1.49 ERA in seven road starts versus a 4.58 ERA in seven starts at home.

#### 2021 SEASON

-Cabrera made two rehab starts with Low-A Jupiter on June 6 and June 12, throwing 6.0 scoreless innings with 11 strikeouts and no walks. His rehab assignment ended on June 15, when he was assigned to Double-A Pensacola. After five starts with the Blue Wahoos, he was promoted to Jacksonville on July 15.

#### 2020 SEASON

-Cabrera was a member of the Marlins' Alternate Training Site.

#### 2019 SEASON

-Cabrera was assigned to Jacksonville on June 23 from High-A Jupiter. At the time of his promotion, the right-hander ranked second in the Florida State League out of 60 pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched in FIP (2.28), third in strikeout percentage (32.2 percent), fourth in K-BB% (24.3 percent), fifth in xFIP (2.64) and ninth in ERA (2.02). He also tallied the circuit's sixth-highest swinging strike percentage (14.5 percent).

-The Santiago, Dominican Republic native surrendered four runs to the first five batters he faced on the season on April 5 at Palm Beach. However, he did not cede another tally until the sixth inning of his start on May 23, a span of 28 consecutive scoreless innings.

## JUMBO SHRIMP IN THE BULLPEN
