**SATURDAY:** The Flying Squirrels split a doubleheader with the Baysox. Bowie won Game 1, 1-0. Donta' Williams drove in the only run of the game with a sac fly in the first inning. **Kai-Wei Teng** struck out five and allowed one run over 3.2 innings. **Nick Swiney** worked 2.1 scoreless innings out of the bullpen and allowed one hit with three strikeouts. **Ismael Munguia** had the Flying Squirrels' only hit. In Game 2, the Flying Squirrels won, 6-4. The Baysox took a 1-0 lead in the first with an RBI single by John Rhodes. In the third, Munguia tied the game with an RBI single and later scored on a single by **Luis Matos**. **Tyler Fitzgerald** hit a two-run homer to cap the four-run inning and give Richmond a 4-1 lead. Munguia added a sac fly in the fourth to extend the lead to 5-1. Bowie picked up a run in the fourth on an error. In the sixth, Munguia opened a 6-2 lead with an RBI single, his third RBI of the night. Zach Watson hit a two-run homer in the sixth to pull the Baysox within two runs. **Erik Miller** worked a 1-2-3 seventh to close out his first save of the season. Sunday's series finale was postponed for rain to June 14.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the first of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. Today marks the first 18 games between the Flying Squirrels and Curve this season. Altoona will return to The Diamond for a six-game series from June 6-11. The Flying Squirrels will head to Peoples Natural Gas Field in Altoona for a six-game series from August 1-6. The Flying Squirrels are 10-7 this year against opponents from the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels are 7-5 in games following a win.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have won eight-of-the-last-11 games and are in first place in the division, 2.5 games ahead of Altoona. After starting the season 4-0 for the first time in team history, Richmond dropped four-of-the-next-five games before taking four-of-six last week against the SeaWolves. The Flying Squirrels offense ranks first in the Eastern League in batting average (.248), runs (112), OBP (.345) and OPS (.735) while ranking second in RBIs (98) and third in hits (160). The Richmond pitching staff leads the league in strikeouts (215) and have the EL's second-best ERA (3.24).

**THE CURVE** enter the series in second place in the division, 2.5 games behind the Flying Squirrels. Altoona has won seven-of-its-last-10 games and three-of-its-last-four. Last week, they won three-of-five at Reading. Sunday's finale was canceled. The Altoona offense is tied with Somerset for the most home runs (21) in the Eastern League and have the fewest strikeouts (160). The Curve roster includes five of Baseball America's Top-30 Pirates Prospects: C Henry Davis (No. 3), INF Liover Peguera (No. 7), RHP Jared Jones (No. 11), OF Matt Gorski (No. 16 + best power hitter + best outfield arm) and INF Andres Alvarez (No. 30). Nick Dombkowski is rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Pirates organization and Lolo Sanchez is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. The Altoona roster also includes five of MLB.com's Top-30 Pirates Prospects, including Davis (No. 3), Peguera (No. 6), Gorski (No. 17), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 20) and Frazier (No. 23).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Carson Seymour** takes the mound for his fifth Double-A start. He started last Tuesday afternoon at Bowie and allowed two runs over three innings in a no-decision. A native of Poway, Calif., Seymour was selected by the New York Mets in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Kansas State University. After making four appearances in 2021, he began the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, where he went 4-0 with a 1.19 ERA in seven outings (four starts). He was promoted to High-A Brooklyn on May 23 for 11 outings before being traded to the Giants on August 2 as part of the deal that sent Darin Ruf to the Mets. Seymour closed the year with High-A Eugene, going 2-3 with a 3.99 ERA in six starts. Seymour is rated by Baseball America as the No. 12 Giants prospect and No. 17 by MLB.com. **For more on Seymour, see page two.**

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander Kyle Nicolas makes his fifth start of the season. Last time out, he worked 4.2 innings and allowed seven runs, all unearned, in Reading last Tuesday with a season-high six strikeouts. Nicolas was selected with the 61st pick in the 2020 MLB Draft by the Miami Marlins out of Ball State. He first reached Double-A with Pensacola in his pro debut season in 2021. In November 2021, Nicolas was traded to the Pirates along with RHP Zach Thompson and OF Connor Scott for C Jacob Stallings. Last season, Nicolas made 24 appearances (22 starts) for the Curve, going 2-4 with a 3.97 ERA. He has made five starts against the Flying Squirrels, all no-decisions, combining for a 3.71 ERA (7 ER/17.0 IP) with 24 strikeouts. Nicolas is rated by MLB.com as the No. 20 Pirates prospect.

**STARTING STRONG:** The Flying Squirrels lead the Southwest Division with an 13-7 record this year, the best start in team history through 20 games, surpassing the previous mark of 12-8 set in 2018, 2021 and 2022. The team's best start through 21 games was 13-8 in 2018 and 2022. This year, Richmond went 4-0 to start the season, the longest unbeaten streak to start a year in franchise history.

**RISPY BUSINESS:** For the season, the Flying Squirrels are batting .314 (59-for-188) with runners in scoring position, which leads the Eastern League. Richmond also has the best batting average in the league with runners in scoring position and two outs at .314 (27-for-86). With runners on base, the Flying Squirrels are leading the EL with a .308 average (93-for-302). The Flying Squirrels have scored four-or-more runs in a single inning 10 times this year.

**HITZ-GERALD:** **Tyler Fitzgerald** hit his second homer of the season on Saturday night in Game 2 of the doubleheader. In last week's series, Fitzgerald hit .421 (8-for-19) with a homer, a triple, four doubles, two walks and two RBIs. With his triple on Tuesday at Bowie, Fitzgerald became the first player in the Eastern League this year with three three-base hits. He added three hits in Wednesday's win over the Baysox, including a double, and scored three runs, and he hit a double on Thursday night. In the Eastern League, Fitzgerald is ranked fourth in batting average (.324), seventh in OBP (.410), third in SLG (.588), fifth in OPS (.998), tied for fourth in hits (22), tied for fifth in doubles (6), first in triples (3), second in extra-base hits (11), third in total bases (40) and tied for third in runs scored (15).

**FULL MUNGUIA:** After going 0-for-15 over a three-game stretch from April 23-26, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .455 (5-for-11) with a homer, a double and four RBIs over his last three games. He led off Thursday's game with a homer on the third pitch of the game, his second Double-A home run. In the second game of Saturday's doubleheader, he tied his season high with three RBIs, picking up a pair of RBI singles and a sac fly. Munguia is tied for seventh in the league in hits (20) and second in runs scored (16).

**HEY, HAYDEN:** **Hayden Cantrelle** has hit safely in 12-of-his-last-14 games dating back to April 12, batting .319 (15-for-47) with four doubles, a triple, eight RBIs and 11 runs scored while adding three stolen bases. For the season, Cantrelle is tied for ninth in the Eastern League with 12 runs scored.

**MATOS MANIA:** **Luis Matos** reached base in each of his first 17 Double-A games, the longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season, until going 0-for-3 in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader. During the streak, Matos reached base 28 total times with 16 hits and 12 walks. He hit a homer in his Double-A debut in Game 1 of the Flying Squirrels' season-opening doubleheader on April 8 against Reading. For the year, Matos has struck out just nine times in 82 plate appearances (11.0 percent), the third-lowest rate in the league.

**TAKE A WALK:** **Andy Thomas** is tied for second in Eastern League with 17 walks. He is third in the Eastern League with a 24.6-percent walk rate. Last season, Thomas led the Northwest League in on-base percentage (.373) and ranked third in walks (58). He has worked at least one walk in nine-of-his-15 games played so far this season. In last week's series at Bowie, he hit .375 (6-for-16) with a homer, a double, five walks and four RBIs.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **Patrick Bailey** is ranked third in batting average (.333) and 10th in OPS (.881). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is fourth in batting average (.324), seventh in OBP (.410), third in SLG (.588), fifth in OPS (.998), tied for fourth in hits (22), tied for fifth in doubles (6), first in triples (3), second in extra-base hits (11), third in total bases (40) and tied for third in runs scored (15). **Ismael Munguia** is tied for seventh in hits (20) and second in runs scored (16). **Andy Thomas** is tied for second in walks (17). **Luis Matos** is tied for fifth in runs scored (14). **Juan Sanchez** is tied for second in wins (3). **Kai-Wei Teng** is first in strikeouts (30).

**WHERE THE CURVE RANK:** Among the Eastern League leaders, Domingo Leyba is second in batting average (.350), fifth in OBP (.426), eighth in OPS (.926) and sixth in hits (21). Henry Davis is tied for first in homers (6), third in RBIs (15), fourth in OBP (.452), first in SLG (.655), first in OPS (1.107), tied for eighth in walks (15) and seventh in total bases (36). Mason Martin is second in OBP (.466), fifth in SLG (.561), second in OPS (1.027) and tied for eighth in walks (15).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, **Luis Matos** (No. 5), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Erik Miller** (No. 15), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Nick Swiney** (No. 24) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).

### THIS DATE IN SQUIRRELS HISTORY

In 2011, the Flying Squirrels beat the New Britain Rock Cats, 6-2, in Connecticut. Eric Surkamp started on the mound and allowed one run over six innings for his first Double-A win. He struck out 10 batters, tying the Richmond franchise record. It was the third of his team-record eight starts with 10-or-more strikeouts. In a four-run fifth inning, Charlie Culberson drove a two-run single and later scored on a wild pitch.
