#### WINNING STREAK SNAPPED WITH 5-3 LOSS TO TULSA: Aaron

**McKeithan** went 3-for-3 and **RJ Yeager** clubbed a two-run homer but the Cardinals could not muster a late comeback in a 5-3 loss to the Tulsa Drillers on Sunday afternoon at Hammons Field. With the loss the Cardinals saw a 7 game winning streak come to an end, their 2nd-longest of the season behind their franchise-record 9-gamer to start the season. **Jeremy Rivas** and **Jacob Buchberger** each notched two-hit games for Springfield, who went just 3-for-19 with runners in scoring position. **Edwin Nuñez** fired 2.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen for the Cards.

## CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

#### CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals! **DN PACE...:** With 70 wins through their first 120 games, the Cardinals are on pace for 80 wins in 2024, which would eclipse the franchise record for wins in a season. The current record is 77 wins which as been acheived twice: 2017 (77-63) and the Texas League title year of 2012 (77-61). Springfield has reaced the 70-win mark 9 other times in franchise history, and has done it in consecutive seasons for the first time since 2009-10. The Cards went 72-66 last season.

**LONG, HOT SUMMER:** Since the beginning of July, no other team in Double-A has won more games than the Springfield Cardinals. The Cards are 31-14 since July 1, tied with the Tennessee Smokies (CHC) for the best record in Double-A during that time. Springfield since the calendar flipped to July is 5-1-2 in series and has the best batting average below Triple-A at .278. The Cardinals have an ERA during that time of 3.88, which is 3rd-best in the Texas League. Through the end of June Springfield sported a 4.75 ERA.

**RDAD WARRIDRS:** For the duration of the 2024 season to this point, the Cardinals have been the best road team in the Texas League by a wide margin. Springfield is 36-20 (.643) away from Hammons Field this season, nearly .100 percentage points ahead of the 2nd-best road record belonging to Frisco (32-26, .552). The best road record in Double-A belongs to the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (NYM) of the Eastern League who are 36-19 (.655).

**CARDIAC CARDS:** Over their last 12 games, the Cardinals have saved their best work for late in games. Despite trailing in the 7th inning or later in 7 of their last 12 games, Springfield is 9-2 during that time. The Cards outscored their opponents 27-9 in the 8th inning or later, and walked6off on the Drillers in 3 of the 6 games of last week's series at Hammons Field.

**POWER SURGE:** After getting off to a slow start in the power category to start the 2024 season, the Cardinals have already eclipsed their home run total from the first half. With 48 longballs in 51 games, Springfield is on pace to hit 65 HR in the 2nd half after hitting just 37 in the 1st half. Springfield has the highest OBP (.352) and OPS (.764) in the Texas League and has scored 17 more runs (274) than any other club in all of Double-A in the 2nd half (since June 24). The Birds ranked 6th in SLG (.361) and 5th in OPS (.712) in the Texas League in the 1st half.

**FOR STARTERS:** The Cardinals starting rotation has been up and down this season but has been one of the best units in the leauge since the calendar turned to August. Springfield's starters since August 1 have the 2nd-best ERA in the Texas League at 2.41, trailing only Midland (2.11). Opposing hitters are batting just .223 against Cardinal starters since the calendar flipped. Last week against the Drillers, Springfield starters compiled the best mark in the league with a 1.32 ERA while going 2-0 and racking up 33 K in 34.0 IP with a .202 BAA.

**MONTH OF TORRES:** Among qualified hitters in the Texas League, nobody has been swinging a hotter bat in the month of August than Cardinals INF/OF **Bryan Torres**. **Torres** is batting .434 through 19 games in the month with 5 2B, a home run and 11 RBI while compiling a .506 OBP and 1.045 OPS. He has notched multiple hits in 9 of his last 12 games and is a scorching-hot .509 (27-for-53) since August 10. **Torres** was named Texas League Player of Ithe Week for August 12-18 after he went 14-for-23 (.609) with 2 2B, 4 RBIs and 8 runs scored in Frisco against the RoughRiders.

**SIANI REHABBING:** St. Louis Cardinals rookie OF **Michael Siani** will join Springfield for a rehab stint starting on Tuesday when he will bat 2nd and play CF. In 101 games with St. Louis this season **Siani** is batting .256 with 2 HR and 18 RBIs while going 14-for-17 in SB while ranking top-10 among CF in MLB with 9 Defensive Runs Saved. He was placed on the 10-day injured list on August 4 with a right oblique strain. He was claimed by the Cardinals in September 2023 after being DFA'd by the Reds. He played in 10 games for Triple-A Memphis but did not appear in a game for Springfield.

**SLAM THE DODR:** Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 23-for-23 and his 46 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 23 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 23.2 IP (0.38 ERA) and is 13-for-13 in save opportunities. **Svanson** has allowed just one unearned run over his last 18 appearances, allowing just 12 H with 19 K over 22.2 IP. The Cardinals are 50-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.


