PAPILLION, NEB. – The Omaha Storm Chasers climbed back from a deficit but fell to the Columbus Clippers 8-7 in the series opener Tuesday at Werner Park.

- After two scoreless innings, Columbus jumped ahead against Omaha starting pitcher Luis Cessa as the Clippers plated four runs in the top of the 3rd inning with back-to-back two-run hits for a 4-0 lead, though just one of the four runs was earned to Cessa as the Chasers made a pair of costly fielding errors.
- Omaha answered with its first run in the bottom of the 4th inning to move the score to 4-1 as Nick Loftin doubled in Nick Pratto to bring the Chasers within three.
- In the top of the 5th inning, Clippers' Jhonkensy Noel doubled in another run to increase the lead back to 5-1 in favor of Columbus and knock Cessa out of the game. Cessa went 4.1 innings, struck out two batters and allowed five runs on six hits before he was replaced by Anthony Veneziano in the top of the 5th inning ... Veneziano stranded an inherited runner in the 5th inning and struck out two over on 1.2 scoreless innings.
- Major league rehabber Carlos Hernández reliever Veneziano with a scoreless 7th inning, then Dan Altavilla worked a 1-2-3 8th inning to keep Omaha within striking distance.
- The Storm Chasers brought the game closer in the bottom of the 7th inning, as CJ Alexander singled, Logan Porter walked and Cam Devanney drove them in with a three-run homer to the opposite field, his fifth long ball of the year, to move the score to 5-4 and bring the Chasers a run away from tying.
- In the bottom of the 8th inning, Loftin drew a walk on a pitch timer violation against Columbus reliever Anthony Gose to bring the go-ahead run to the plate ... with two outs, Nate Eaton crushed his fourth home run of the year, a two-run shot to right field, to plate Loftin for the first Chaser lead of the game 6-5.
- Walter Pennington entered the last frame for Altavilla to try and earn his third save, but instead wound up charged with his second loss of the season despite striking out three ... a hit batter was followed with a game-tying RBI double and two-run homer off the bat of Daniel Schneemann for a 8-6 Columbus lead.
- In the bottom half of the 9th, Omaha showed fight as Porter singled, Devanney grounded into a fielder's choice and John Rave doubled to put two in scoring position ... Drew Waters used a sac fly to plate Devanney and move the score to 8-7 ... that was all the Chasers could come away, with as Pratto hit a sharp line drive to end the game, Omaha's hardest-hit ball of the night to conclude the series opener.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### IN GOOD STANDINGS

Omaha's enters today's game in 2nd place in the 20-team International League, with a 28-15 record (.651 winning percentage).

- Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders (NY Yankees Triple-A) sits a half game ahead of Omaha in the league standings, at 30-16 with a .952 winning percentage.
- Omaha has previously spent five days this season in 1st place, or with a share of 1st in the International League, but not since April 16 before yesterday.

#### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Omaha has won 4 straight series and 14 of its last 18 games... 13 of those 18 games have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 10 of the team's 14 wins in this stretch.

- After Omaha's relievers had just 4 saves in the first 26 games, 9 of the last 14 wins have had a save awarded ... Will Klein has 3 saves in that span, while Walter Pennington and Sam Long have 2 saves each.
- In total, 30 of Omaha's 43 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or fewer (70%), including 12 of 15 losses this season.

#### I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 257 to 199 this season, a +58 run differential.

- A +58 run differential ranks as the best in the International League, 2nd-best at the Triple-A level and 5th in Minor League Baseball ... Oklahoma City leads Triple-A at +64, while Modesto leads MiLB at +88.
- Omaha has had a positive run differential after 36 of 43 games this year, including 34 straight games, since April 9 ... last year, the Chasers only had a positive differential after 28 of the team's 145 games and never more than 15 days in a row.

#### YOU CAN COUNT ON ME

Two factors contributing to Omaha's success this season include the starting pitchers going deep into games and the offense providing their starters run support.

- When Omaha's starter can get through at least 5.0 innings this year, the team has a 15-3 record, compared to 13-12 when starters don't make it through the 5th inning.
- When the offense can provide 3+ runs of support, the Storm Chasers are 19-4, while the team is just 9-11 when the offense offers 2 runs of support or less to the starter.

#### RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen remains one of the best in the International League and even across the entire Triple-A level.

- The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a Triple-A best .205 average, while the .675 opposing OPS ranks 2nd-best and a 3.98 ERA against the Omaha bullpen is 4th-best in Triple-A.
- Wednesday's shutout marked the 8th time Omaha's relievers combined in a single game to not allow any runs ... it was the 7th time they have combined for at least 4.0 scoreless innings ... the season-high is 6.0 scoreless frames on March 29 vs. Iowa.
