A WILD ONE ON SUNDAY

Round Rock collected a 9-7 win in extra innings on Saturday night at Constellation Field against Sugar Land. The Space Cowboys jumped out to an early 5-0 lead in the first five innings. The top of the sixth saw Round Rock score four runs to cut the Sugar Land lead to 5-4. 1B Blaine Crim and RF Sandro Fabian hit a pair of two-RBI doubles. A wild pitch allowed Bastidas to score in the seventh and extended the lead to 6-4. RF Pedro León blasted a solo home run to put the Space Cowboys up 7-4 heading into the final frame. The Express tied the game at seven thanks to two long balls in the top of the ninth. Fabian launched a solo homer to start the inning. After LF Trevor Hauver walked, Matt Whatley came to the plate as a pinch-hitter and delivered a game-tying home run to even the score at seven. With Crim on second base to start the 10th inning, C Sam Huff gave the E-Train a 9-7 lead with a two-run homer. Wolfram recorded the first two outs of the bottom of the 10th for the Express before Robert entered and struck out León to end the game. The E-Train finished with a series split against the Space Cowboys.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB

Round Rock C Sam Huff smacked a 10th inning home run on Saturday and became the sixth member in Express club history to belt 50 home runs. He joined OF Jared Hoying (83), INF Brooks Conrad (80), INF Luke Scott (70), INF Mark Saccomanno (64) and INF Davis Wendzel (52). The righty has 119 home runs in the minors.

D-BOB TO THE SHOW

Round Rock RHP Daniel Robert had his contract selected yesterday afternoon by the Texas Rangers and will look to make his Major League debut on Tuesday against the Los Angeles Angels. Robert has been with the Express for parts of the last three seasons. Among pitchers in the Pacific Coast League with at least 30.0 innings pitched this year, he is fourth with a 2.35 ERA (8 ER/30.2 IP). Robert did not allow an earned run for 19.0 innings from May 22-July 4.

WHATLEY! (SEINFELD VOICE)

Express C Matt Whatley delivered a pinch-hit, game-tying home run in the ninth inning on Saturday. This was the first pinch-hit home run for an Express hitter since C Meibrys Vilorio did it on September 11, 2022 against Sugar Land. After entering July with just one home run in his first 26 games this year, Whatley has two home runs in his last three games.

CRIM OF THE CROP

E-Train 1B Blaine Crim went 1-for-4 with a walk, two RBI and two runs scored on Saturday. He is riding a six-game hitting streak and a 10-game on-base streak. During his on-base streak, the righty is 14-for-37 with six RBI, five runs scored and seven walks.

BIG-TIME BIGGERS

Express INF Jax Biggers is slashing .277/.413/.410 in 67 games this year. Biggers in fourth in the Pacific Coast League in on-base percentage and he has reached base in seven consecutive games.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

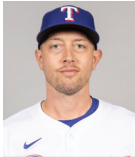
