NOTES AND NUGGETS

NEW (AND OLD) KIDS ON THE BLOCK

- Omaha added 2 hitters to the team's offenses ahead of this week's series with Indy.
- Outfielder **Dairon Blanco** has joined Omaha today, on a Major League rehab assignment ... he landed on Kansas City's 10-Day Injured list on March 31 with *right Achilles tendinopathy* ... Blanco has played 194 games with the Storm Chasers previously, between 2021 and 2023.
- Additionally, infielder **Peyton Wilson** has been promoted to Omaha from Double-A Northwest Arkansas ... the 66th overall pick in the 2021 MLB Draft out of Alabama, Wilson has been in Double-A since the start of the 2023 season and racked up 267 games with the Naturals, where he's slashed .268/.365/.418 with NWA ... Wilson currently ranks Top-10 among qualified Minor League hitters in average, on-base percentage, slugging percentage and OPS.

GETTING SWEEPED UP IN TOLEDO

- Omaha was swept in last week's series at Fifth Third Field, to stretch the team's losing streak to 7 games (since April 19).
- A 7-game losing streak is Omaha's longest since an 11-game losing streak, August 1 to 12, 2023 ... that stretch also includes the last time the Storm Chasers were swept in a 6-game series, August 1 to 6, 2023 @ Louisville.
- Last week's series against the Mud Hens marked just the second time Omaha was swept in a 6-game series since the 6-game series were adopted in 2021.
- A .196 team average last week in Toledo was Omaha's lowest in a 6-game series since August 1 to 6, 2023 @ Louisville, when the Chasers hit .184 ... a .542 team OPS was the 2nd-lowest for Omaha in a 6-game series since 2021, trailing only May 10-15, 2022 @ Iowa, when the Storm Chasers produced a team OPS of .506.

DON'T LEAD ME ON

- Omaha has not held a lead since last Wednesday, April 23 in Toledo, and the Storm Chasers only led for 6 innings in last week's series to the Mud Hens.
- Over the final 4 games of the series, Omaha led for 0 of the 32 innings played, with Toledo leading for 25 of the 32 innings (78%) ... in the series as a whole, the Mud Hens led for 34 of 54 innings (63%).

DOWN, BUT NOT OUT

- Comeback games have been a common theme through the first 25 games of Omaha's 2025 season, with 12 of the 25 games Omaha has played in this year being games where the winning team trailed at some point.
- The Storm Chasers have trailed at some point in 8 of 10 wins this year, with 4 wins where they trailed for at least half the game before coming back to win.
- On the flip side, the Chasers have had a lead for at least an inning in 4 of the team's 15 losses ... in the 15 losses, Omaha has had a lead for a total of 13 innings.

WHAT A RELIEF!

- Relievers stepped up lately for Omaha, including 3 bullpen games last week.
- Since Wednesday, April 16, relief innings accounted for 57.1 of Omaha's 85.1 innings, approximately 67% of the team's total innings.
- 32.2 innings from Omaha's starting pitchers across the last two weeks (11 games) are the fewest of any MiLB team in since April 15.
- When accounting for the reliever Anthony Simonelli opening Game 2 of Saturday's doubleheader, Omaha's bullpen arms have recorded 93 of the team's 148 outs this week (62%) ... the week prior vs. Norfolk (last homestand), the relievers recorded 106 of the team's 135 outs (79%).

DUSTIN TIME

- After joining the Storm Chasers two week ago and starting off slow, infielder **Dustin Dickerson** heated up last week at Fifth Third Field.
- Dickerson began his Omaha career 0-for-8 with 3 walks ... since the 7th inning on Tuesday when he recorded his first Triple-A hit, Dustin is 11-for-23 with 4 RBI, a walk and sacrifice fly ... he had multiple hits in each of the first four games of this week's series before going hitless in Game 2 of Saturday's doubleheader.
- In 9 games with Omaha, he is slashing .355/.417/.419 (11-for-31) with 4 RBI and 4 walks with only 4 strikeouts ... his 11.1% strikeout rate is the 2nd-lowest among 16 Storm Chasers hitters with at least 10 plate appearances this year.

LEAN WITH IT, WALK WITH IT

- Omaha's 114 walks are 6th in the International League league.
- Through 25 games, the Chasers are averaging 4.56 walks per game, and are on pace to draw a club-record 680 walks ... the franchise record is 671 walks drawn in the 2023 season and they have drawn more than 600 walks just twice.
- In the big leagues now, **Nick Loftin** is responsible for nearly 1/4 of Omaha's walks ... the 26 walks Loftin has drawn are the 2nd-most of any Minor League hitter.

The Royals signed a 16-year-old Avila out of Venezuela during the 2018 international signing period. Ever since, it's been steady progress for the now-23-year-old who spent most of the 2024 season at Double-A before making one Triple-A start. Avila posted a 1.37 WHIP over 19 starts for Northwest Arkansas. It was the first time since 2022 that he didn't throw over 100 innings, as he missed about six weeks with a minor oblique injury. In five games (three starts) in the Arizona Fall League, Avila posted a 3.07 ERA with 17 strikeouts and eight walks in 14 2/3 innings. The Royals added him to their 40-man roster to protect him from the Rule 5 Draft in November.

Last year marked the first time Avila missed significant time; he's been a durable young pitcher for the Royals, and those innings don't go unnoticed. Avila's comfort zone with his fastball is 94-95 mph with flashes of the upper 90s, and the pitch has natural cut and ride. To help him command the arm'side of the plate, Avila introduced a two-seamer that is about the same velo as his four-seamer. He throws both the slider and curveball, and both can miss bats. They can sometimes morph into each other, so the separation is a work in progress. A fringe-average changeup rounds out Avila's arsenal, a pitch he's still developing with a focus on backing off the 89-91 mph velocity. Avila has near-average command but hides the ball well in his delivery, and as he's grown, his presence on the mound has gotten stronger.

Now that he's on the 40-man, Avila could make his big league debut at some point in 2025. He needs more development time in Omaha, particularly with his secondary pitches and command, but will be part of the Triple-A depth to begin the season. Avila will continue to start but might be someone whom the Royals can rely on in different roles depending on need for a long reliever or a swingman.

Baseball America

Scouting Grades: Fastball: 55 | Curveball: 60 | Changeup: 45 | Control: 45

Track Record: It's been a slow trek through the Royals system for Avila since first signing in 2018, but he's proven enough value to get a spot on the 40-man roster. The Venezuelan righthander was on the way to a strong season until a rib cage injury in early July put him on the sidelines for seven weeks. He returned in time to get three more starts at Double-A Northwest Arkansas and one with Triple-A Omaha. His 3.81 ERA and .229 opponent batting average in Double-A were among the best numbers of his career. Avila finished his year in the Arizona Fall League, where he pitched in the annual Fall Stars Game as well as throwing two scoreless innings in the championship game.

Scouting Report: Avila's four-seam fastball has glove-side cutting action and sits 93-95 mph, touching 98, with ride. A development goal will be to improve the location and consistency of the pitch. His best pitch is a high-spin two-plane curveball at 79-83 mph and he uses it to get swings and misses with its downward movement that's tough to barrel. His 87-91 mph hard changeup is still in development, a pitch with natural sink that gets whiffs, and could be an average offering with more consistency. He repeats his delivery and has been called a sneaky competitor.

The Future: The Royals added Avila to the 40-man roster in November. He projects as a valuable innings-eater at the back of the rotation but could thrive in a bullpen role.

- 🚩 Since 2021, Avila ranks 2nd among Royals Minor League arms in innings (386.2) and 3rd in strikeouts (359) ... he's allowed just 23 home runs in 436.0 pro innings, for a 0.47 HR/9 ... in that span (since 2018), only two qualified Minor League pitchers (min. 400.0 IP) had a better mark: the best is **Luis Devers** (0.37 HR/9, Cubs org).

Pitched 3.0 innings in his first start in 11 days, throwing 58 pitches (19.33 P/IP) ... retired his first 4 hitters, including a 1-2-3 inning in the 1st, but allowed a solo homer to Jahmai Jones with 1 out in the 2nd ... a single, walk, double, error and sac fly scored 3 more runs (2 earned) in the 3rd inning ... did not come out for the 4th.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Made 3 Cactus League appearances for the Royals in Major League Spring Training ... allowed 1 earned run over 6.0 innings (1.50 ERA), with 5 hits, 2 walks and 7 strikeouts.
- Optioned to Triple-A on March 9, the first player optioned to Omaha this spring.
- Pitched 3.0 innings of relief (4th to 6th) of the Royals' Spring Breakout game, on March 14 @ Arizona ... allowed 3 runs on 3 hits and 1 walk, with 4 strikeouts ... threw a 1-2-3 6th inning, retired his last 5 batters.
- Started Omaha's home opener, April 1 vs. Louisville ... retired his first 12 hitters, and struck out a career-high 11.
- His turn in the rotation was skipped during Omaha's series vs. Norfolk, April 16 to 22.

CAREER NOTES

2024

- Opened the season in the Double-A starting rotation with Northwest Arkansas ... made 16 starts before landing on the 7-Day Injured List on July 12 ... missed 47 days of the regular season, activated on August 27 and made 3 more starts with the Naturals.
- Ranked 2nd on the Naturals' pitching staff in starts (19), tied 2nd in wins (6) and 4th in innings pitched (82.2).
- Made 3 quality starts for the Naturals, including tying a career-high with 7.0 scoreless innings on June 21 vs. Tulsa (LAD) ... made quality starts back-to-back starts on May 17 @ Arkansas (SEA) and May 23 vs. Amarillo (AZ).
- 7 of 19 starts in Double-A were scoreless, including 3 straight around his stint on the IL, for a 10.1-inning scoreless streak (July 9 to September 3).
- Assigned to Omaha at the end of the Double-A season, on September 17 ... made his Triple-A debut on September 21 @ Louisville (CIN), allowed 5 earned runs in 4.1 innings ... started the Triple-A National Championship game in Las Vegas, September 28 @ Sugar Land, allowed 3 runs on 6 hits in just 1.1 innings.
