SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

THE FINAL TUNE-UP: The Biloxi Shuckers are set to play their only exhibition against the Pearl River Community College Wildcats in a seven-inning game at Shuckers Ballpark... The exhibition marks the second consecutive year that the two teams will meet... Both teams will use wood bats... In 2023, the Shuckers defeated the Wildcats 8-0, including a home run from Jeferson Quero, who was one of four Shuckers named to the 2023 Southern League All-Star team... The Shuckers had previously played against William Carey University in an exhibition game from 2017-2019 and 2022.

LET'S GO PROSPECTING: The Biloxi Shuckers roster will feature five Brewers Top-30 prospects, including RHP Jacob Misiorowski (No. 2, No. 33 overall), the organization's best pitching prospect... The other four are; INF Brock Wilken (No. 7), INF Eric Brown Jr. (No. 12), RHP Bradley Blalock (No. 18) and C/1B Wes Clarke (No. 25)

WILDCATS BACK IN BILOXI: Outside of last year's exhibition game, the Wildcats were previously at Shuckers Ballpark on June 28, 2022 when the Shuckers honored Pearl River after they won the 2022 NJCAA Division II National Championship... The title marked the one of two collegiate baseball titles in Mississippi in 2022, along with the NCAA DI Men's College World Series title for Ole Miss.

AND AWAY WE GO!: The Biloxi Shuckers open their 2024 season at home for the first time since 2019 against the Montgomery Biscuits, the Double-A affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays on Friday, April 5... It marks the first time the Shuckers have opened the season at home since 2019, when they opened at home against the Birmingham Barons and swept a doubleheader 5-3 and 5-0 after Opening Day was postponed due to rain... The game also marks the first time the Shuckers have opened the season against the Montgomery Biscuits since 2018, and the first time they've opened up against the Biscuits at home in franchise history.

WELCOME TO THE BIGS, JACKSON!: The 2023 Brewers Co-Minor League Player of the Year, OF Jackson Chourio, was one of two 2023 Shuckers named to the Brewers Opening Day roster, along with RHP Abner Uribe... Chourio, who set the record for the largest contract signed by a player yet to make his MLB debut this off-season, made his MLB debut on Friday, March 29 against the New York Mets as the starting right fielder and tallied a hit, walk and stolen base.

ONE FINAL LOOK AT 2023: In 2023, the Shuckers' lineup set the single-season franchise record in average (.255), runs (754), hits (1,145), walks (668), stolen bases (214), on-base percentage (.359), slugging percentage (.417) and OPS (.776)... The pitching staff set the single-season franchise record for strikeouts (1,349), including 722 from the starting staff and 624 from the bullpen.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP CHAD PATRICK [4-11, 5.59 IN '23]: RHP Chad Patrick makes his first start in a Shuckers uniform after being acquired during the 2023/24 off-season from Oakland in exchange for INF Abraham Toro... Patrick made 21 of his 26 starts in 2023 at the Double-A level, split between Midland (OAK) and Amarillo (ARZ)... Patrick also set career-highs in strikeouts (129), innings (124.0), appearances (27) and starts (26) in 2023.
