

Looking Back

Reading won in an extra-inning pitchers' duel 2-1. Binghamton struck first with a home run off Mick Abel and Reading tied it up in the third. Abel was solid over five innings and the bullpen combined for five innings of shutout work. Tyler McKay earned the win with 2.1 innings of work and Carlos De La Cruz drove in both runs, including the game-winning run in the tenth.

De La Cruzin

Carlos De La Cruz has been red-hot for the Fightin Phils. He currently holds a 24-game on-streak and has hits in 15 straight. Over his 15-game hitting streak, De La Cruz is hitting .349 and is also hitting .458 over his last five games. He has back-to-back three-hit games.

Rojas Rolling

Johan Rojas is establishing himself as one of the best two-way players in Minor League Baseball. Offensively, he is 6-12 this week and Rojas is hitting .400 over his last five games. Rojas also leads all Minor League center fielders with 14 defensive runs saved. He also ranks eighth in the Eastern League with a .296 average.

Kroon Crushing It

Matthew Kroon joins the party of hot R-Phils at the plate lately. He joined Rojas with a four-hit performance Tuesday and is 7-12 on the series and is hitting .368 over his last five games. He ranks third in the Eastern League with a .313 average.

Bullpen Blues

This week's series features the two bullpens with the highest ERA in the Eastern League. Reading enters tonight ranked 11th with a 5.36 ERA, and Binghamton is 12th with a 5.58 ERA. A recent bright spot in the R-Phils bullpen has been Phillies No. 17 prospect Andrew Baker. Baker has turned in four-straight scoreless inning and five of his last six outings have been scoreless.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies walked off the Dodgers thanks to a Kyle Schwarber home run in the ninth inning last night. Lehigh Valley beat Syracuse 9-6 last night and plays a doubleheader today. Jersey Shore fell to Hudson Valley 8-4 in ten innings last night in a big series for the first-half title. Clearwater fell to Fort Myers 6-1 last night, but sits at 39-15 and inching towards a first-half title.

Phillies Number Three Prosepct. Started season on injured list.McGarry has been a prospect since his high school days, when he was a late-round pick of the Rangers before honoring his commitment to Virginia. With the Cavaliers, he showed off his premium arm strength as well as a lack of familiarity with the strike zone, making him an intriguing, yet enigmatic college arm in 2021. The Phillies thought McGarry's stuff was worth taking in the fifth round, and he pitched his way from High-A to Triple-A in his first full season of pro ball. If you're just evaluating pure stuff, McGarry could be considered one of the better pitching prospects in the game. He's flirted with 100 mph in the past and was up to 99 mph at the upper levels in 2022, averaging over 95 mph. It's an elite pitch not just because of velocity, but because of his vertical approach angle as well. His mid-80s slider can be plus at times, missing a ton of bats, and he fools hitters with an upper-70s curve too. He doesn't throw his changeup nearly as much as the breaking stuff, but it has characteristics of a plus pitch. He added a hard cutter at the end of last year to give him a potential five-pitch mix. How often McGarry can land his elite-level stuff in the strike zone will determine exactly what he can be in the big leagues. A 13.9 K/9 rate to start off his pro career shows he can fool pro hitters, but even with some improvements since joining the Phillies, he's walked 5.4 per nine entering 2023. There's hope that as he adds mass to his loose 6-foot-2 frame, he can keep refining his delivery and throw enough strikes to start, a role he'll continue for now unless there's a need as a reliever in Philadelphia.

They found a bargain later on in the period, in January of 2018, when they inked Rojas for just \$10K. In each of his two years of full season ball, he's started slowly but finished well offensively, showing off his plus speed and defense at all stops. He made it to Double-A for the first time in 2022 and then finished with a strong performance in the Arizona Fall League before getting added to the 40-man roster. Rojas has shown he can be an impact player on both sides of the ball thanks to his near-top-of-the-scale speed. He's an elite baserunner, one who stole 62 bases in 67 tries last season and then went 13-for-13 in the AFL. His speed is an obvious asset in the outfield, where he is a premium defender in center field, one who could be a Gold Glov.
