Leading Off

Today, the Reading Fightin Phils continue a six-game series on the road at the Somerset Patriots. It's the third of 18 matchups between the teams this season. Reading returns to Somerset from July 4-9 and the Patriots come to Reading from August 15-20. In 2022, Reading went 7-11 vs Somerset, going 5-5 at home and 2-7 on the road.

A Good Morning

Yesterday, Reading cruised to a 9-1 morning win over the Patriots to even the series at one. Reading put up multiple crooked numbers, but the pitching stole the show. The quartet of Griff McGarry (5), Cristian Hernandez (5), Adam Leverett (4) and Max Kuhns (5) combined to strike out 19 hitters. It was a season-high for Reading and the most in a nine-inning game for the R-Phils since May 8, 2021.

Kroon Is Back

After a brief dry spell, Matthew Kroon is back to dominating at the plate. Dating back to May 6 (10 games), Kroon is hitting .444 with a home run and eight RBI. He has also reached base in his last five, with hits in his last three games. In the eight games prior to May 6 (4/22-5/4), Kroon hit .069 in a 2-29 spell. But, it's safe to say Kroon has got himself back on track.

Oliver Getting It Dunn

Oliver Dunn continues to put up big numbers, this time against his former team Somerset. Dunn has hits in eight of his last ten games and is slashing .286 with three home runs and 11 RBI over that span. He has three home runs in a span of five games, after only hitting one in his first 24.

McCarthy Mashes

McCarthy Tatum is another Fightin Phils who is bouncing back strong after a recent dry spell. Tatum has hits in his last four games and is hitting .400 over that span with a home run and seven RBI. In seven games prior, from April 21-May 11, Tatum was just 1/27 (.037) and was hitless in six of those seven games.

Around the Organization

At the big-league level, the Philadelphia Phillies were swept by the San Francisco Giants, losing 7-4. After an off day today, the Phillies return home to open a series against the Cubs. Lehigh Valley rode a seven-run tenth inning to a morning win at the Worcester Red Sox 10-3. High-A Jersey Shore also had a morning game and beat the Wilmington Blue Rocks 7-3 at home. Finally, Clearwater completed the quartet of morning games with a 5-4 victory over Bradenton for a 4-0 day for Phillies affiliates. The Threshers own the best Florida State League record at 26-9.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 18, 2017: At Erie, Andrew Pullin goes 3-for-4 with a HR, double, 2 RBIs and 2 runs in an 8-3 win that completes Reading's 3-game sweep.

'Sup Somerset

This is the first series of the season between Reading and Somerset. The Patriots sit second in the Northeast Division with a 21-13 record. Last week at Portland, Somerset split the six-game series, with the teams alternating wins in the series between the top-two teams in the division. Next up, the Patriots hit the road for a six-game series at Erie next week before welcoming Portland to Jersey the week after.

The Fitts File

Righty Richard Fitts gets the start tonight for Somerset. He has struggled so far in 2023, going 1-3 with a 6.07 ERA over six games. He has allowed 32 hits, walked eight and struck out 34 hitters over 29.2 innings pitches. He last threw last Wednesday at Portland, struggling over two innings. Fitts allowed four runs on five hits against the Sea Dogs. He split 2022 between single-A Tampa and high-A Hudson Valley, going 7-8 with a 3.70 ERA over 22 games, all starts. He was selected in the sixth round of the 2021 draft by the Yankees out of Auburn.
