YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost, 5-3, to the Fightin Phils. Richmond took the lead on the second batter of the game when **Marco Luciano** hit an RBI double. In the fourth, **Logan Wyatt** hit an RBI single to open a 2-0 lead. Reading closed the score to 2-1 in the fifth with an RBI double by Matt Kroon. In the seventh, Wyatt hit a solo home run, his second in the last two games, to extend the lead to 3-1. Reading scored four runs in the eighth to take the lead. Oliver Dunn hit an RBI single and Nick Podkul followed with a three-run homer. **Landen Roupp** struck out seven over 3.1 scoreless, hitless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. This series is the second of the year between the two teams. The Flying Squirrels opened the season with a three-game sweep against the Fightin Phils at The Diamond on April 8 and 9.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS went 33-36 in the first half, finishing in fourth place in the Southwest Division. They were 14-7 through their first 21 games but are 20-30 since May 3. However, they had won six straight, their longest winning streak of the year, prior to Friday night's loss. It was their longest winning streak since they won seven straight from April 28-May 5, 2022. Over the last six games, the Flying Squirrels are batting .304 (70-for-230) with eight homers, 19 doubles and have scored 46 runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.83 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 257.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 363.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.37 ERA, which is tied for the lowest in Double-A and is tied for the sixth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS were 28-40 in the first half of the season, which was last in the Eastern League. Last week, Reading won four-of-six at Portland, including three straight wins to open the series, which tied their longest win streak of the season. The Fightin Phils opened the season 0-5, including a three-game sweep at The Diamond to begin the year. The Reading offense leads the league in batting average (.265), hits (637), total bases (1042), doubles (133), triples (16), OBP (.352), SLG (.433) and OPS (.785). Reading's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Phillies prospects, including RHP Mick Abel (No. 2), RHP Griff McGarry (No. 4), OF Johan Rojas (No. 5), OF Ethan Wilson (No. 11), OF Carlos De La Cruz (No. 17) and OF Jhailyn Ortiz (No. 22). McGarry is rated by Baseball America as having the best fastball, Ortiz is rated as having the best outfield arm and Baron Radcliff is rated as the best power hitter. MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospect list includes Abel (No. 2), McGarry (No. 4), Rojas (No. 6), De La Cruz (No. 9), Wilson (No. 14) and Ortiz (No. 18).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Mason Black** makes his 15th Double-A start and second against the Fightin Phils. Last time out, Black threw 4.1 scoreless innings against the Senators on Sunday afternoon. It was his fourth consecutive scoreless start, spanning 17.1 innings since June 8. He last faced Reading in his Double-A debut on April 9 at The Diamond and allowed three runs over four innings with six strikeouts. For the season among Eastern League pitchers (min. 50 IP), Black ranks third in strikeout percentage (29.7), tied for fifth in WHIP (1.15), sixth in K/9 (11.0) and seventh in BAA (.211). Black was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Lehigh University, where he was the Patriot League Pitcher of the Year as a junior. He made his professional debut last season with the Low-A San Jose Giants, posting a 1.57 ERA in eight starts. Black led the minors with a 0.35 ERA for the month of May last season and earned a promotion to High-A Eugene on May 24. For the season, he ranked fourth in the Giants organization with 136 strikeouts last year and was named an MLB.com Giants Organization All-Star. Black is rated by Baseball America as the No. 9 Giants prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com. **For more on Black, see page two.**

FOR READING: Left-hander David Parkinson makes his 11th start of the season and his first against the Flying Squirrels. In his last start, Parkinson allowed four runs over six innings with a season-high nine strikeouts. In his four June outings, including one appearance for Triple-A Lehigh Valley, Parkinson has gone 1-1 with a 7.17 ERA (17 ER/211 IP). Parkinson is a Richmond native and attended Mills E. Godwin High School, where he was first-team all-state as a senior in 2014. After one junior college season in South Carolina in 2015, he transferred to Ole Miss and played two seasons for the Rebels. He was selected in the 12th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Phillies. He first reached Double-A with Reading in 2019 and returned in 2021 but missed the 2022 season. Over his three seasons (2019, 2021, 2023) in the Eastern League, Parkinson has combined to go 12-12 with a 4.47 ERA in 34 outings (32 starts). He has also pitched 21 games with Triple-A Lehigh Valley in 2021 and 2023. Parkinson has faced the Flying Squirrels four times in his career, all during the 2019 season, including three starts at The Diamond. Against Richmond, Parkinson is 2-2 with a 3.86 ERA (9 ER/21.0 IP).

VAUN GONE WILD: **Vaun Brown** is riding a six-game hit streak since June 22. He has homered three times in that stretch, including home runs in each of the first two games of this week's series. In his last six games, Brown is batting .333 (9-for-27) with three homers, two doubles and nine RBIs, adding two stolen bases. Over his previous nine games from June 9-20, Brown hit .057 (2-for-35) with three walks and 16 strikeouts.

LONGBALL LOGAN: Since his promotion to Double-A on June 13, **Logan Wyatt** is batting .344 (11-for-32) with three homers, two doubles and eight RBIs. Between his time with High-A Eugene and with Richmond, Wyatt has homered 11 times this season in 62 games. Wyatt hit his first Double-A homer on June 23 at The Diamond against the Senators. He hit his second Double-A home run on Thursday night at Reading and finished the game with four RBIs, which tied his career high. Wyatt added another homer, a solo shot, in a two-RBI performance on Friday. He has driven in six runs over his last two games.

RETURN OF THE MECK: In Game 1 of June 23's doubleheader, **Wade Meckler** closed his historic performance with a two-run, walk-off single, giving the Flying Squirrels a 9-8 win in extras. Meckler went 5-for-5 and tied the single-game franchise record for hits. It was the 11th time a Richmond player has collected five hits in a game. In the first three games of this week's series, Meckler has reached base 10 times with seven hits, including four on Thursday, and three walks. Meckler has now reached base in all 19 of his Double-A games, including 29 hits and 15 walks. His on-base streak is the second-longest active streak in the league and the longest by a Richmond player this season. Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 170 PA) this season with a .425 batting average and third in OBP (.494).

I LOVE LUCI: On June 4, **Marco Luciano** hit a grand slam and a two-run homer in the Flying Squirrels' 11-2 win. It was the fourth multi-homer game of his career. He went deep again with a two-run homer on Sunday afternoon and added a 432-foot, opposite-field two-run shot last Wednesday at Bowie. Luciano leads the team with 10 homers this year. He went on a five-game hit streak from June 10-14, during which he hit .588 (10-for-17) with four homers, a double, five walks and 10 RBIs. After going 1-for-20 over his next five games, Luciano has picked up nine hits in his last six games, including going 4-for-4 last Saturday and hitting a solo home run on Sunday.

RAGIN' CANTRELLE: In his last 11 games since June 14, **Hayden Cantrelle** has reached base 19 times, posting a .442 on-base percentage. In that stretch, he has picked up eight hits, walked nine times and been hit by a pitch twice in 43 plate appearances. This season, he has been hit by a pitch 13 times, the most in the Eastern League. He also ranks seventh in the league in on-base percentage (.395) and seventh in walks (44). He is also second among Giants minor leaguers in walks for the year.

OLD FRIENDS: Reading's roster includes former Flying Squirrels pitcher Matt Seelinger, who played with Richmond in 2021. The reliever spent that entire season with the Flying Squirrels, going 3-1 with a 3.07 ERA in 36 appearances. He was selected by the Phillies in the minor-league phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft. With Reading last year, Seelinger pitched against Richmond twice, both at The Diamond, and allowed one unearned run over 2.2 innings of work with four strikeouts. Seelinger is one of four former Richmond players in the Eastern League this year. Frankie Tostado, who was with the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is playing with the Senators. Diego Rincones, who was with the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is now playing for the Erie SeaWolves. Pitcher Grey Fenter, a member of the 2022 Flying Squirrels, is now with the Somerset Patriots.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Hayden Cantrelle** is seventh in OBP (.395) and seventh in walks (44). **Carson Seymour** is eighth in ERA (3.43), ninth in BAA (.225) and seventh in WHIP (1.20). **Matt Frisbee** is tied for first in wins (6). **Mason Black** is tied for second in starts (14).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Marco Luciano** (No. 2), LHP **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 6), OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 8), RHP **Mason Black** (No. 9), RHP **Carson Seymour** (No. 14), RHP **Landen Roupp** (No. 15), OF **Wade Meckler** (No. 16), RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 27) and RHP **José Cruz** (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Luciano as the best power hitter, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. Luciano is also ranked as Baseball America's No. 55-overall prospect. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes nine Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2), Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29). Luciano is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 17 prospect in baseball.
