SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (13-21) vs. TULSA DRILLERS (20-14)

LHP MASON MOLINA (0-2, 3.86 ERA) vs. RHP PATRICK COPEN (3-1, 3.31 ERA)

SETTING THE SCENE: Springfield travels west on Route 66 to visit the Drillers (Dodgers) for a 6-game series ... today's game is the 2nd game of the series ... Springfield won the opener last night, 7-6 ... LHP Mason Molina (0-2) makes the start for the Cards opposite RHP Patrick Copen (3-1).

A MOLINA MORNING: LHP Mason Molina makes his 7th start and his 2nd against Tulsa ... in last start on 5/7 vs. the Hooks he allowed 2 runs on 5 hits over 4.1 IP with 5 SO and a season-high 6 BB in a no-decision (SGF won 4-3) ... pitched vs. Tulsa on 4/11 in Springfield and allowed 4 runs on 6 hits over a season-high 5.0 IP ... was his last start of 5.0+ IP ... struck out a season-high 8.

DRILL-VILLAINS: Today's game is the 8th of 18 in the season series and the 2nd of 12 games for in "Drillville" ... Tulsa won 5-of-6 in Springfield when the club's matched up in April ... Tulsa enters the day in 1st place in the North Division, 7.0 games up on 5th-place Springfield ... Cards went 7-5 at ONEOK Field in 2025.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Springfield tied a season-high by drawing 11 walks en route to a 7-6 win in the series opener ... allowed 5 runs in the 3rd inning to fall behind before scoring 4 times in the 4th to retake the lead ... RHP Hunter Hayes threw 2.1-shutout innings to pick up the win.

SERIES BUSINESS: Springfield has won 3 straight games and is 6-2 over its last 8 games ... can match its longest win streak of the season with a win today.

SERIES BUSINESS: The Cardinals took the down the Hooks, 11-5, in the series-finale on Sunday at Route 66 Stadium to win the series (4-2) ... was Springfield's first series win since the first of the season, a 3-game sweep at Amarillo ... had lost 4-straight series.

LET IT RAIN: C Rainiel Rodriguez went 2x4 in his Springfield debut including a base-hit in his 1st Double-A at-bat ... was added to roster prior to yesterday's opener in Tulsa ... the 19-year-old is the Cardinals' 2nd-ranked prospect and the top-ranked catching prospect in all of baseball according to MLB Pipeline ... he becomes the 2nd-youngest player in all of Double-A ... was hitting .311 with 4 HR and 21 RBI in 28 games with High-A Peoria.

BURNS BABY BURNS: RHP Mason Burns recorded his 4th save on Tuesday at Tulsa with a 1-2-3 inning on just 7 pitches ... is 4-for-4 in save chances this season (t-3rd in TXL) ... has not allowed a run in 6-straight outings (7.2 IP).

ARRIBA AR-RIVAS: IF Jeremy Rivas went 2x4 on Tuesday to extend his hit streak to 9 ... is the longest active streak in the TXL and the club's longest of the season ... is hitting .419 (13x31) with 2 HR, 10 RBI, and a 1.228 OPS during the stretch which began on 4/30.
