- The Blue Jays took a rain-shortened series finale 5-0 on Sunday afternoon in Lakeland.
- James Kaprielian, who has spent parts of the last four seasons at the big league level in Oakland, started the game for the D-Jays. The righty delivered four innings of shutout ball, and worked out of a bases loaded, no-out jam in the bottom of the first.
- Nic Deschamps two-out, two-RBI single put Dunedin ahead for good.
- In the fourth, Victor Arias picked up an RBI fielders' choice and Arjun Nimmala added an RBI double to make it 4-0. Arias picked up his own RBI double in the top of the sixth.
- The game was called in the bottom of the sixth with no-outs, following an hour and 18 minute delay.

SERIES SUCCESS STYMIED

Last week's four-games to two series loss to Lakeland snapped a streak of six straight sets with at least a split for the D-Jays. The team's last series loss came on the road at Fort Myers, May 7-12.

LONG TIME. NO SEE

Today's contest against Clearwater marks the first meeting between the two sides since the Threshers took four of six from the Blue Jays at TD Ballpark April 16-21. The Threshers took the final three games of the set, sending Dunedin tumbling into a nine-game losing streak. Entering that series, the Jays were 7-2 to start the season.

THE MONTH THAT WAS

Dunedin finished June with a 12-13 record. The Blue Jays' pitching staff had its best month of the season thus far, posting a 3.35 ERA (the fourth best in the FSL) after struggling with a 4.70 ERA in May (second worst in the league). At the plate, the Blue Jays' .614 OPS in June was their lowest by month this season. After leading the league with 27 home runs in May, Dunedin only hit 13 in June.

HELLO, JOEY

17-year MLB first baseman, six-time All-Star, and 2010 National League MVP Joey Votto continues his rehab stretch with Dunedin today. Votto suffered a severe ankle sprain during Spring Training after signing with Toronto on March 8. The Toronto native is MLB's active walks leader with 1,365, and his 356 home runs are third most among active players.

TOUGH STRETCH

The Blue Jays are in the midst of perhaps their toughest stretch of the year, scheduled to play nine games in eight days. All nine games are against the two best teams in the FSL in Lakeland (47-27) and Clearwater (47-28).

HAPPY CANADA DAY

As Dunedin's parent club observes Canada Day with a 3:07 pm first pitch against Houston, at least three members of Dunedin's roster will observe the holiday. Nic Deschamps (Quebec City, QC), Bryce Arnold (Hamilton, ONT), and Joey Votto (Toronto, ONT) mark the lone Canadians on the Blue Jays roster.

ROAD COOKING

Dunedin's pitching staff has proved to be more effective on the road than at home. At TD Ballpark, the Jays have posted a 4.30 ERA in 343 innings. On the road, the staff's ERA stands at 3.54 in 3110 innings - the second best road ERA in the FSL.

ALLERGIC TO BLOWOUTS

Saturday's 3-2 loss marked Dunedin's 27th one-run game this season - tied for the most in the FSL with Bradenton. The Jays are 12-15 in those contests. 51 of the Blue Jays 74 games this season (68%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 25-26 record in those games. 10 of the team's last 13 have been decided by three or fewer.

REHAB CITY, USA

With James Kaprielian's rehab start from AAA on Sunday, Dunedin has hosted 13 MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. Joey Votto's rehab assignment continues today. Other notable rehabs include No. 1 prospect Ricky Tiedemann, Alek Manoah, Damiano Palmegiani (AAA), and Riley Tirotta (AAA).

NICE TO SEE YOU, NIMMALA

In his first game with Dunedin in over a month, Arjun Nimmala lifted a solo home run Thursday - his fourth of the season in Single-A. Nimmala was placed on Dunedin's development list on May 14, and then was assigned to the FCL Blue Jays on June 3. In 8 FCL contests, Nimmala went 5-21 with a home run. Nimmala was the Blue Jays first round draft pick last season, and is the organization's third-ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline.
