It's Friday Night

The Fightin Phils continue the first week of the season's second half with game four of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox at home. It is the seventh-of-nine matchups between the teams this season and fourth-of-six in Reading. The teams saw each other the first weekend of the season from Apr. 5-7 in Bowie. Reading won the first game, then dropped the final two contests at Prince George's Stadium. Bowie leads the season-series 4-2.

It's Like Deja Vu

The Fightin Phils dropped their second-straight game by an identical score as Wednesday, with a 3-2 defeat to Bowie. The Baysox jumped out to a 3-0 lead with one in the second and two in the fourth, all of Reading starter Max Castillo, who took the loss. The bullpen then held Bowie scoreless over the next five innings, allowing just one hit. Reading got on the board when Ethan Wilson hit his first home run of the season in the bottom of the fifth. The R-Phils added another tally in the bottom of the seventh on a Carlos De la Cruz RBI double. Reading had chances in both the eighth and the ninth, but Lincoln Henzman worked out of trouble in both innings to earn the save.

Bombs Away

After hitting another home run on Thursday night, Reading has set a season-high with home runs in 12 games in a row. This comes after also hitting home runs in seven-straight games from June 4-11. The only game since June 4 Reading has not hit a home run in was June 12, so they have homered in 19-of-20 games. The 12-game home run streak is Reading's longest such streak since homering in 12-straight games from August 10-23. of the 2018 season. The last time Reading homered in 13-straight games was from June 21-July 3, of the 2016 season.

Do You Like Pina Colladas?

Fightin Phils Ace Robinson Pina gets the ball to start tonight's game on the mound. Pina has been stellar in June, posting a 3-0 record, and 2.38 ERA, over four starts. That included a seven-inning, complete-game shutout on June 8 at Harrisburg. It was a start that won him Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honors. Pina is currently tied with Harrisburg's Brad Lord for the most wins in the Eastern League with eight. His other Eastern League ranks are: 9th ERA (3.50), T-1st CG (1), T-1st SHO (1), T-10th WHIP (1.18) and T-2nd WPCT (.800). Pina currently sits second in the Eastern League with an 8.75 strikeout-to-walk ratio on the season. The only player ahead of him is Lachlan Wells at 8.83. Matt Osterberg also ranks fifth at 3.50. Amongst qualified Eastern League pitchers, Pina's 10.22 strikeout-per-nine ratio ranks eighth. Tonight's Bowie starter Alex Pham is third with an 11.55 strikeout-to-nine ratio on the season.

Marcus is Mashing

With two hits last night, Marcus Lee Sang is currently riding an active team-best 12-game on-base streak. It also matches his personal-best on-base streak for the season. He also reached in 12-straight games from Apr. 26 to May 12. Over his current 12-game on-base streak, Lee Sang is slashing .271/.321/.500, with an .821 OPS. He's added nine runs, two doubles, three home runs and eight RBI over the streak, dating back to June 12.

Take a Walk, or Not

Dating back to June 18 (eight games), Fightin Phils pitchers have issued just 11 walks, which ranks as the fewest in the Eastern League over that span. It also ranks as the fewest walks allowed in all of Minor League Baseball, with the second least being 17. Reading also leads Minor League baseball in that stretch with a 4.64 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and a 1.38 walk-per-nine ratio.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 28, 1999: At Reading, the Phils score a run in the bottom on the 9th to nip Trenton, 11-10. Pat Burrell triples twice and homers, driving in four runs in the process.

The Book on Bowi

Bowie enters tonight after finishing in fifth place in the Eastern League's Southwest Divison for the first half with a 32-36 record. They are tied for first in the Southwest Division with a 2-1 record in the second half of the season. Bowie most recently dropped five-of-six at home against the Altoona Curve. Following this week, Bowie heads home for three against Richmond, then three at the Flying Squirrels. Bowie's roster features nine players ranked amongst the Baltimore Orioles' top-30 prospects: Samuel Basallo (2), Dylan Beavers (7), Seth Johnson (10), Jud Fabian (12), Max Wagner (14), Trace Bright (16), John Rhodes (23), Alex Pham (24) and Frederick Benscome (27).

On the Mound for Bowie

Righty, and Orioles No. 24 Prospect, Alex Pham starts tonight for Bowie. This season, Pham is 3-1, with a 5.85 ERA over 14 starts (60 IP, 56 H, 27 BB, 77 SO). He last started on June 22 vs Altoona, allowing three runs (two earned) over 3.2 innings, with seven strikeouts. Pham split 2023 between High-A Aberdeen and Bowie, combining to go 3-5, with a 2.57 ERA over 26 appearances and 19 starts. The 24-year old was drafted out of San Francisco in the 19th round of the 2021 draft. He mostly pitched as a reliever for San Francisco, starting just seven of his 73 career appearances. He posted a 3.60 ERA from 2018-21 in college.
