TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve play a critical series with the Richmond Flying Squirrels, the final series for the team at The Diamond. All-time, Altoona is 64-68 at the Gem of the Eastern League.

Joe Whitman makes his second start of the season against Altoona, he allowed 1 run in 3.2 innings against the Curve on June 21 at PNG Field. Whitman was picked 69th overall by the Giants in 2023, the Pirates selected RHP Zander Meuth two picks before him and OF Mitch Jebb 42nd overall in the second round. Whitman is a super smooth 6-foot-5 lefty with a beautiful arm action and delivery. After two years with just 5.2 total innings pitched at Purdue, Whitman transferred to Kent State for his junior year and had a breakout season. Given the arc of his college career, it seemed feasible that Whitman had both skill and physical development remaining, with a chance to blow up on a pro strength and conditioning program. Early on in 2024, it appeared that was happening, as he was touching 96, though Whitman's fastball ended up averaging 92-94 across all of last season. (Eric Logenhagen, Fangraphs).

TERMARRINATOR: Infielder **Termarr Johnson** has recorded three straight multi-hit games to begin this week's series with Richmond. In his last 11 games he's batting 17-for-44 (.386) with 1 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR and 5 RBI with a .940 OPS. Johnson matched his career-high with four hits on August 14 at Richmond.

NICK AT NIGHT: First baseman **Nick Cimillo** has returned from the All-Star break with a vengeance. In his last 20 games, he's batting .267 with 15 extra base hits (1.035 OPS). In that time he ranks 2nd among Double-A players in HR (7), SLG% (.667) and 5th in OPS (1.035). He's T-1st in XBH (15).

DUUUUUUCE: Infielder **Duce Gourson**'s last two homers have come in clutch spots. After swatting a game-tying shot on August 8 in the bottom of the 9th against Hartford, Gourson smacked a go-ahead 3-run homer on Tuesday, August 18 at Richmond. With the Curve down to their final out, Gourson rocked his third hit of the game to take a 7-4 lead in an exhilarating comeback win for the Curve. Gourson is 8-for-22 (.364) with 2 2B, 2 HR, 4 RBI and 7 BB in his last 7 games (since August 7).

KELLY K'S: Righty **Antwone Kelly** has become one of the top pitching prospects in the Pirates minor league system. The 21-year-old holds a 0.98 WHIP between Greensboro and Altoona which ranks 4th among qualified minor league pitchers. The Aruban righty has allowed 2 runs or fewer in 18-of-22 starts this year. He's totaled 109 strikeouts this season, 2nd-most in the Pirates minor league system (**Bubba Chandler**, 116), tied with teammate **Wilber Dotel** (109).

AUGUSTO OMAR: Catcher **Omar Alfonzo** has picked up two multi-hit games to start the calendar month. Alfonzo is 10-for-34 (.294) with 1 2B, 1 3B and 5 RBI in his last 9 games.

SO YOU LIKE PLAYING ALTOONA?: Nine players this season have earned an Eastern League weekly or monthly award immediately after playing the Curve. CJ Kayfus (Akron, 4/13), Brandon Beck (Somerset, 4/20), Blaze Jordan (Portland, May Player of the Month), David Sandlin (Portland, 6/1), Rafael Sanchez (New Hampshire, 6/8), Trey Gibson (Chesapeake, 7/27), Max Ferguson (Portland, 8/3), Sean Sullivan (Hartford August 11) have all taken home weekly awards after playing Altoona. **Hunter Barco** was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week (April 27) and Pitcher of the Month in April to account for Altoona's only honors this season.

EZZY: Outfielder **Esmerlyn Valdez** has gotten his feet underneath of him at Double-A, in his last 16 games, he is 15-for-57 (.263) with 1 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 10 RBI and 11 walks (.792 OPS).

MY VALENTIN: Righty **Valentin Linarez** has turned in one of the best seasons of his professional career in 2025. In addition to holding opponents to a career-low .181BAA this season and a 1.13 WHIP, since June 10 he's allowed just 3 runs in 24.0 IP (1.13 ERA) and a 0.83 WHIP with 25 strikeouts.

JUSTIN'S MEIS: Since recording a 4.91 ERA in the month of May, **Justin Meis** has held opponents to a 0.93 WHIP and walked just 5 batters in 29.0 innings with 32 strikeouts. Meis' 57 K's this season are 4th-most by an Eastern League reliever.

CLOSE WINS: 20 of Altoona's last 26 wins (since June 18) have all come in a save situation for the bullpen. 54 of the team's 109 games this year (50%) have been decided by two runs or fewer.

ITALIANISSIMO: Righty **Alessandro Ercolani** has dialed in throughout his first trip through the Eastern League. In 11 of his 21 outings this season, he's allowed 1 run or fewer. Held under an innings count this year, Ercolani has gone 0-1 with a 2.13 ERA (6 ER / 25.1 IP) in his last 6 outings (5 starts) in which he's held opponents to a .196 BAA.

WE'LL SEE THEM ALL: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Binghamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.

TODAY IN CURVE HISTORY PRESENTED BY

2006 - A pair of Pirates first rounders, top 2 prospects and future staples in the Bucs lineup make their AA debut. Andrew McCutchen, the 11th overall pick in 2005, made his AA debut for the Curve at Connecticut and went 1-4 with a single in his second plate appearance. McCutchen is the youngest player to suit up for the Curve. Neil Walker, Pittsburgh's 2004 first-rounder (11th overall) debuted at catcher and hit a solo homer in the eighth. Curve lost 2-1. Walker was No. 1 prospect and McCutchen was No. 2 according to BA preseason.
