**Capital City:** The Somerset Patriots take on the Harrisburg Senators in the second game of a six game series tonight. Last night, Harrisburg scored three unanswered runs after the Patriots tied the game at four. The Senators took the series opener 7-4.

**Medina Magic:** Earlier today, the New York Yankees announced that Patriots' pitcher Luis Medina was selected to represent the Yankees in the 2021 All-Star Futures Game. The contest will be played on Sunday July, 11 at 3 p.m. at Coors Field in Denver. According to Baseball America, Medina has the "best pure stuff" in the Yankees' system. The righty joins Jasson Dominguez to represent the Yankees at the game.

**Hits and Misses:** The Patriots pitching staff owns a 3.16 ERA, second-lowest among all of Minor League Baseball (full season) and lowest in the Double-A Northeast League. They also lead all of Double-A in strikeouts (570), in WHIP (1.15) and have the lowest BAA (.203).

**Whiz Kid Waldichuk:** Ken Waldichuk earned his first win at the Double-A level his last time out. The lefty pitched 5.1 innings without allowing a hit but gave up a single then home run to the final two batters he faced. He also struck out ten in the performance. Waldichuk began the season pitching a minor league-leading 30.2 scoreless innings with High-A Hudson Valley.

**Go, Diego! Go!:** Diego Castillo has batted leadoff the last seven games. Batting first, Castillo is 13-for-30 (.433) with three home runs, six RBI, four doubles and seven runs. Last night, Castillo hit his ninth of the year. His previous career high was four (High-A Tampa, 2019) and he entered the season with eight total career homers.

**Post Milone:** Outfielder Thomas Milone has reached base in 16-straight games dating back to May 11th, sandwiched around 21 games played with Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. That is tied with Donny Sands for the longest on-base streak for the Patriots this season. He has registered a hit in 14 of the 16 contests and is batting .328 over the streak.

**Ride the Bus:** Reliever Stephen Ridings impressed with 2.1 perfect innings of relief last Thursday night, including earning the win in the extra-inning effort. This season, Ridings has allowed just one earned run this season and has not allowed an inherited runner to score while allowing just one of three placed runners to score in extras.

**Land Ho!:** The Patriots took four of six games against the Portland Sea Dogs last week. Entering the series, the Sea Dogs were trailing the Patriots by just three games in the Northeast Division. Somerset sandwiched four wins between a loss in the first game of a doubleheader to open the series and a Sunday matinee at Hadlock Field.
