Today: It's the final home game of the Lugnuts' 27th Midwest League season, the finale in a six-game series against the West Michigan Whitecaps – and the 449th all-time meeting between the in-state archrivals. The Lugnuts are 8-12 vs. the Whitecaps this season after winning a wild 11-inning game last night, putting the Nuts in position to gain a series split with a victory today. It's also Accessibility Day on a Capital City Market Kids Day, featuring postgame Kids Run the Bases and an Extra Inning with free ice cream at Capital City Market.

Last Night: Lugnuts 11, Whitecaps 10 (11 innings). The Nuts had a 4-3 lead with two outs in the top of the ninth inning, only to watch West Michigan rally for four runs. That touched off a wild finish in which Lansing came back from 7-4 deficit with two outs in the bottom of the 9th, an 8-7 deficit in the bottom of the 10th, and a 10-8 deficit in the bottom of the 11th to walk off West Michigan on a one-out, bases-loaded, RBI single from **Colby Halter** in front of a roaring crowd of 5,896. It was the Lugnuts' eighth walk-off win of the season, and it trimmed the Whitecaps' division lead to a 1/2-game over Fort Wayne.

On Deck: After a day off tomorrow, the Lugnuts close out the 2023 regular season with a six-game road trip at Lake County from September 5-10.

LUG•NOTES

A Night to Remember: Last night's epic saw seven runs scored in the first eight innings and 14 runs scored in the final three. It lasted a season-long three hours, 54 minutes to complete, and saw 12 pitchers throw a combined 389 pitches. **Junior Pérez** tied a Lugnuts 2023 single game high with four runs scored, **Jacob Wilson** collected his first four-hit game as a pro and reached base five times (also tying a Lugnuts single game high for 2023) and Lansing collected six doubles (which, yes, also tied a 2023 single game high). West Michigan blew two separate saves in the game, giving the Whitecaps 22 blown saves for the year, while the Nuts improved to 7-2 in extra-inning games.

Roll Call: The Lugnuts have used 25 position players this year and 26 pitchers (not including **Danny Bautista, Jr.**, who tossed one inning as a position-player-pitching). 16 players have hit at least one home run, 16 players have stolen at least one base, 15 pitchers have made at least one start, 19 pitchers have won at least one game, and 13 pitchers have recorded at least one save.

Two for the Price of One: Lansing leads the league with 112 double plays turned, thanks to another yesterday, seven more than second-place Peoria.

Crossing the 300,000-Fan Threshold: Including the season-opening Crosstown Showdown, the Lugnuts have drawn 299,286 fans to Jackson® Field™ this season, with today's crowd pushing the final count over 300,000. Overall, the Nuts' average attendance of 4,684/game ranks eighth among the 30 High-A teams and Lansing's July 4th attendance of 11,521 remains the largest single game crowd at the High-A level and puts the Lugnuts eighth among all teams in Minor League Baseball in largest single game crowds.

Among the League Leaders: The promoted **Daniel Susac** now leads the Midwest League in qualified batting average with a .303 average. **Danny Bautista, Jr.** is tied for 2nd with Susac in base hits (111). **Junior Pérez** is 4th in stolen bases (40), tied for 6th in doubles (26), tied for 9th in total bases (165) and 10th in extra-base hits (40).

Jerome Holtzman, Represent: The Lugnuts have been playing closer and closer games as the season has gone on. By month: seven saves in 20 games in April (35%), nine in 27 games in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), 22 in 27 games played in August (81%), and one through two games in September.

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster has two current first-rounders: shortstop **Jacob Wilson**, the sixth overall pick this year from Grand Canyon University, and the Blue Jays' 2021 first-round selection, 19th overall, **Gunnar Hoglund**, acquired via trade in March 2022 for Matt Chapman. The A's 2021 first-round selection, shortstop **Max Muncy**, and 2022 first-round selection, catcher **Daniel Susac**, are both currently excelling with the Double-A Midland RockHounds in the Texas League.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2011: It was 96 degrees in Dayton as Dragons SS Billy Hamilton went 2-for-3 with a sacrifice, stealing three bases to reach the 100-steal mark. The Lugnuts lost, 4-2.

2012: In the final game of the regular season, the Lugnuts finished with an 82-55 record after scoring six runs in the 3rd – and then blowing the lead in absurd fashion, allowing Lake County to score three in the 4th, three in the 5th and then nine runs in the 7th inning. The Nuts lost, 15-6.

2022: Cooper Bowman hit a grand slam and Sahid Valenzuela stole home, helping the Lugnuts win at South Bend, 10-8. Mason Miller started the game, firing two innings, followed by two innings apiece from TJ Czyn, Mac Lardner and Brock Whittlesey before Calvin Coker wrapped up the ninth, striking out Pete Crow-Armstrong to end the game. Crow-Armstrong shattered his bat over his knee in frustration, upset by a strike call earlier in the at-bat.

In a Nutshell: The last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers this year was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced “ZoYk”), the 21st pick in 2016, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016, spent last season with the Cincinnati Reds, and is currently in Lehigh Valley (Triple-A - Philadelphia)... @mitch_myers9.

International Respect: Mitch is ranked No. 3 in the world in the video game *Super Monkey Ball*... he is also considered the top chess player in the Lugnuts’ clubhouse.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett’s motto is “The Gateway to Alabama,” since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt’s Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics’ 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

2023 with the Lugnuts: Opened season as the Nuts’ Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3... tossed another quality start (6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 6 K) against Quad Cities on July 27.
