YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Reading Fightin Phils, 6-3, to open the six-game series at FirstEnergy Stadium. Kyle Mottice hit an RBI triple and Matt Frisbee added a sac fly in the second to give the Flying Squirrels a 2-0 lead. In the bottom of the second, Luke Miller hit a solo homer to get Reading on the board. In the third, Frankie Tostado launched his first Double-A homer, a two-run shot, to extend the lead to 4-1. Reading closed back within a run with a two-run homer by Colby Fitch in the fifth. Heliot Ramos hit an RBI single in the sixth inning to extend Richmond's lead to 5-3. Jacob Heyward added a solo home run in the eighth to open a three-run lead. Frisbee picked up his third win after allowing three runs over 6.0 innings with no walks and eight strikeouts. Norwith Gudino pitched 2.0 scoreless innings. Patrick Ruotolo closed out his fourth save with a scoreless ninth inning.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies, at FirstEnergy Stadium. This series marks the only trip to Reading this season for the Flying Squirrels. The Fightin Phils play six games at The Diamond from August 3-8.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have dropped seven of the last 10 games and four of six. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 3.0 games behind first-place Erie. Over the last 10 games since May 14, the Flying Squirrels are batting .219 (72-for-329) as a team. Over the previous nine games to open the season from May 4-13, the Flying Squirrels hit .273, which was third-best in the Double-A Northeast.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS are in fifth place in the Double-A Northeast Division, 11.0 games behind first-place Somerset. They have lost five consecutive games and 13 of the last 14 overall since May 9. For the season, Reading is ranked 28th of 30 Double-A teams with a .192 team batting average. Their 7.42 team ERA is the highest in Double-A and the second-highest of the 120 affiliated minor league teams. Reading's roster includes four of MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospects, including RHP Francisco Morales (4), C Rodolfo Durán (19), LHP Ethan Lindow (24) and RHP James McArthur (29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Gerson Garabito makes his fourth start of the season. Last time out, he surrendered five runs, all earned, over 2.2 innings on Thursday against Bowie at The Diamond. He was with the Kansas City Royals organization from 2013-2019, reaching as high as Double-A. He spent 2019 pitching in the Texas League with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals, going 6-12 with a 3.77 ERA in 26 starts. Garabito's performance in 2019 earned him a selection as a Texas League Mid-Season All-Star. He signed as a minor league free agent with the Giants on November 20, 2020. **For more on Frisbee, see page two.**

FOR READING: Left-hander Taylor Lehman makes his second start and fourth overall appearance. He has twice gone as deep as 3.0 innings into an outing this year, reaching that mark on May 8 and 14 in his first two outings of the season. He last pitched on Thursday at Akron and allowed two runs in 1.0 inning of work. Lehman was drafted by the Miami Marlins in the 34th round in 2014 out of high school, but did not sign. After attending Penn State, Lehman signed as a free agent with the Phillies in 2018. He made 14 total appearances, including eight starts, between short-season Williamsport and Single-A Lakewood in 2019, going 2-3 with a 2.55 ERA.

STRONG ARMS: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank third in all of Double-A in ERA (3.00), which is second in the Double-A Northeast. The Richmond pitching staff also ranks tied for first in Double-A in saves (8), third-fewest hits (118), fourth in WHIP (1.14) and third in BAA (.197). Starting pitcher Matt Frisbee is first among qualified pitchers in WHIP (0.50).

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: The Flying Squirrels' relievers have the second-best bullpen ERA in all of Minor League Baseball at 2.12 on the season. The bullpen is tied for fifth in the minors and tied for first in Double-A with eight saves. Richmond relievers second-fewest runs (25) and have the second-best BAA (.154) in the minors. Patrick Ruotolo is tied for first in Double-A with four saves.

ANTI-THEFT SECURITY: The Richmond catchers have combined to throw out 67 percent of stolen base attempts, which leads all of Minor League Baseball. The Flying Squirrels have thrown out a total of 12 stolen base attempts this season, which is tied for the fourth-most in the minors and leads Double-A. Andres Angulo is leading all Double-A catchers in caught stealing percentage (min. 10 attempts) at 63.6 percent (7-for-11).

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 11-8 record is tied with the 2014 season for the second-best start in team history through 19 games, trailing only a 12-7 start in 2018.

HITTERS' HAVEN: From 2010-2019, Reading's FirstEnergy Stadium allowed home runs at a higher rate than any other park in the Eastern League. Over that stretch, the ballpark allowed a rate of 2.08 home runs per game (1,482 total homers). In comparison, The Diamond in Richmond has been the toughest park to homer in at 0.96 per game (677 total home runs). FirstEnergy Stadium was the second-highest park for scoring in that stretch at 9.34 runs per game. The Diamond was the lowest-scoring field in the circuit at 7.60 runs per game.

A BUNCH OF SELLOUTS: The Flying Squirrels have sold out their maximum capacity crowds at The Diamond for 10 of their 11 openings this year. For the first homestand, the Flying Squirrels drew the maximum allotted crowd of 2,943 for all five openings. In the current homestand, the maximum capacity is 3,448. After drawing 3,057 fans last Tuesday (89%), the Flying Squirrels have sold out their last five home games.

ALL OVER THE MAP: The Flying Squirrels roster contains 18 players from 11 different states across the United States: California (4), Georgia (4), Florida (2) and one player from North Carolina, Minnesota, Illinois, Massachusetts, New York, Missouri, Washington and Ohio. Ten players grew up in four countries and territories outside of the 50 states, including the Dominican Republic (5), Puerto Rico (2), Venezuela (2) and Colombia (1).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: Heliot Ramos (3), Tristan Beck (12), Sean Hjelle (13) and Jose Marte (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Four players, Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Beck (20) and Caleb Kilian (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.

GOING FOR GOLD: Flying Squirrels manager José Alguacil is taking an absence from his position in Richmond to manage the Venezuelan national team for the WBSC Baseball Americas Olympic Qualifier at Clover Park in St. Lucie, Fla. and The Ballpark of the Palm Beaches in West Palm Beach, Fla. Venezuela is playing in Group B with Canada, Colombia and Cuba. After scrimmage games against the Dominican Republic and the United States, Venezuela will play its first game of the Qualifier on May 31 against Cuba in West Palm Beach. The top two teams from each group will play in a super round on June 4 and 5, with the team holding the best record from that round earning a spot in the Olympics in Japan. Tony Diggs will manage the Flying Squirrels for this week's series in Reading. Diggs, who is the Giants' Minor League Field Coordinator, previously spent 16 seasons with the Milwaukee Brewers organization, including managing in the Arizona League from 2008 to 2012 and 2016, as well as with the Helena Brewers from 2013 to 2015. Catcher Andres Angulo will also be in Florida to play for his home country, Colombia, in the Qualifier.

MOVING UP: Left-handed pitcher Sam Long was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on Tuesday. He made four starts with the Flying Squirrels, going 0-1 with a 3.00 ERA. He had five strikeouts in each of his first three starts with Richmond before punching out seven over 4.0 scoreless innings on Saturday. Among qualified pitchers, Long ranked tied for 14th in the Double-A Northeast in ERA (3.00), tied for 11th in strikeouts (22), ninth in K/9 IP (13.2), eighth in K% (36.7%) 16th in BAA (.214) and 14th in WHIP (1.07).
